Site Investigations

Werribee

Thursday 14 July to Friday 29 July

Site investigations are taking place to help inform planning and design for Stage One of Geelong Fast Rail.

What we are doing

Essential geotechnical investigations will take place on the western side of Werribee River, alongside the rail corridor to obtain detailed information on existing ground conditions.

These investigations will include:

- Non-destructive digging (NDD) which involves using a vacuum truck to excavate carefully into the ground
- Drilling a borehole to collect samples and assess ground conditions
- Reinstating the drilling area after the works.

What to be aware of

- There will be no impact on local roads, and low impacts to walkways as part of these works
- There will be periods of medium-level noise associated with these works
- A site compound will be set up to enable works to be carried out safely
- Signage will be in place to assist with access and wayfinding.

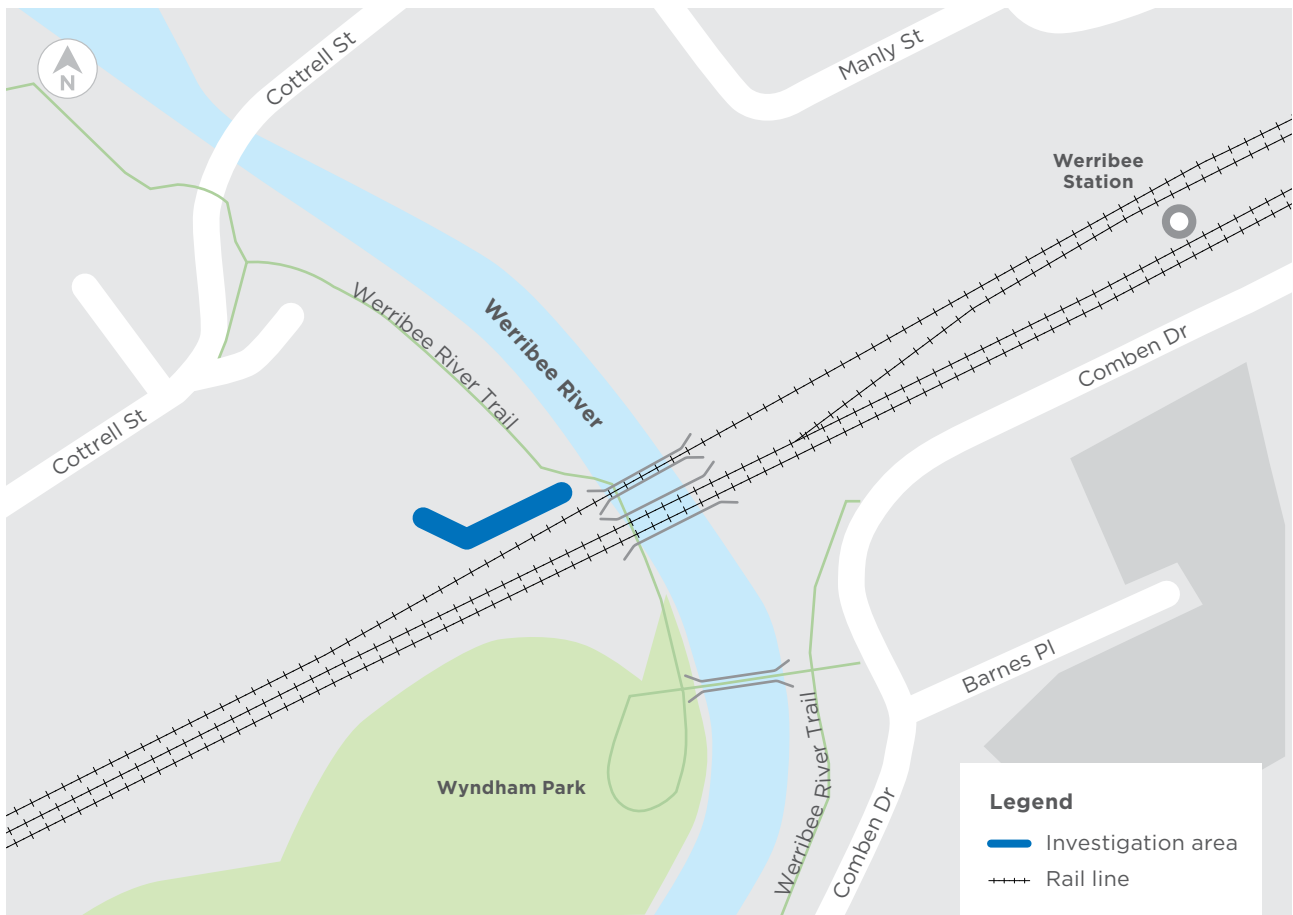
Geelong Fast Rail

Geelong Fast Rail will deliver faster services between Geelong and Melbourne's CBD with a travel time of around 50 minutes enabled through a major investment to the Werribee corridor.

The Werribee corridor has been selected as the route to deliver faster services for Geelong, as it is the shortest and most direct rail path between Geelong and Melbourne.

Construction is expected to commence in 2023, subject to relevant Victorian and Federal planning, environmental and other government approvals.

Hours of work:

Works will be undertaken from 7 am to 5 pm, Monday to Friday, and take up to 12 business days.


The timing of these works is subject to weather and ground conditions.
