Recent notifications

- Paringa Road reopening DL: Residents and businesses in the vicinity of Paringa Road were advised via an email, flyer and/or doorknock that access from Millers Road was to be restored from Wednesday, 9 November.
- Spring campaign completion DL: Residents in the vicinity of Millers Road spring campaign works were advised of the completion of works and what to expect with ongoing works in the area
- The Avenue underpass works notification: The Avenue underpass closed nightly from 6 – 16 December between Strong Street and the Hockey Club to resurface and reinstate the area underneath the freeway bridge. Notification distributed on 22 November 2022
- Millers Road interchange resurfacing DL reminder: Residents and businesses advised of resurfacing works between 12-22 December and subsequent freeway ramp, interchange and access to Millers Road from Primula Ave .

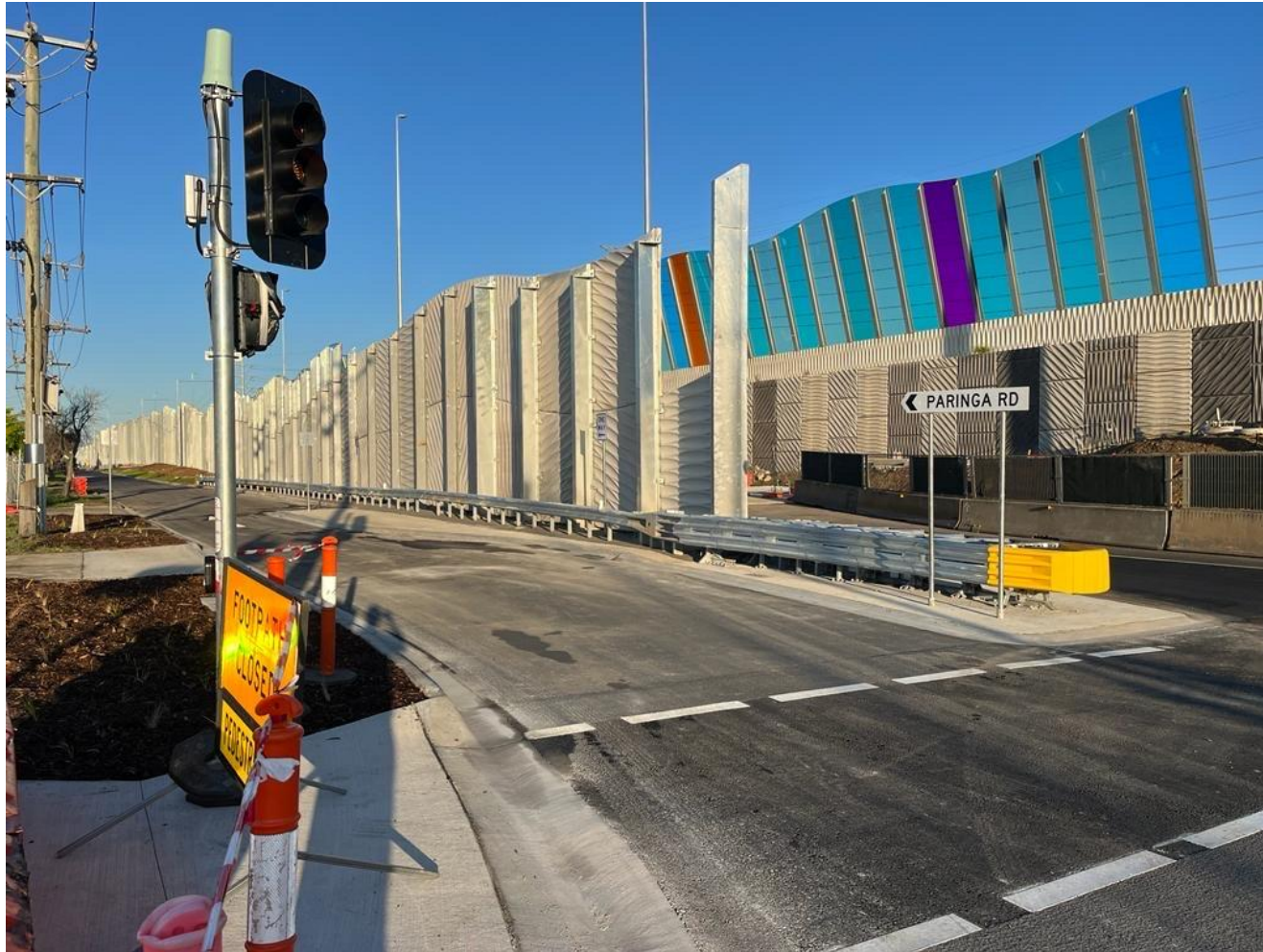
Stakeholder engagement

- Residents in the vicinity of Paringa Road were advised via an email, flyer and/or doorknock that access from Millers Road was restored on Wednesday 9 November.

Business engagement

- Businesses in the vicinity of Paringa Road were advised that access from Millers Road reopened on Wednesday 9 November.
- The project engaged with businesses near Simcock Avenue including Toll, Visy, Scienceworks, Grazeland and Connolly's Civic to confirm the second stage of utility works at Simcock Avenue and Booker Street. Works completed 2 December.

Paringa Road



- Access to Paringa Road from Millers Road reopened on Wednesday 9 November
- Project to meet same noise standard for nearby residential properties

Williamstown Road interchange

- Ongoing nightly closures of Williamstown Road to West Gate Freeway citybound ramp required to support the ongoing construction of the new Hyde Street ramps.
- Upcoming weekend closures of the Williamstown Road inbound exit ramp for gantry crane installation

The Avenue and Fogarty Avenue

- Resurfacing and reinstatement works at The Avenue underpass are ongoing until 16 December with the road closed between 7pm and 7am each night.
- Landscaping and site demobilisation in progress.
- Continuation of the new shared user path bridge over Williamstown Road.

- Moonee Ponds Creek Trail closure: Walking and cycling detour in place. Distributed on **21 November 2022**
- Lyons Street short-term closure for resurfacing works: Distributed on **8 November 2022**
- Dynon Road bridge closure: Bridge construction & closure of Dynon Road between the Citylink inbound exit ramp and Dryburgh Street, North Melbourne. Distributed on **8 November 2022**
- Dynon Road SUP detour: Distributed on **18 November 2022**
- Maribyrnong Street upcoming works: further car park closures and one way access. Distributed on **17 November 2022**
- Maribyrnong Street DL: distributed to businesses in the area to communicate changed traffic conditions to staff, customers and visitors. Distributed **28 November**

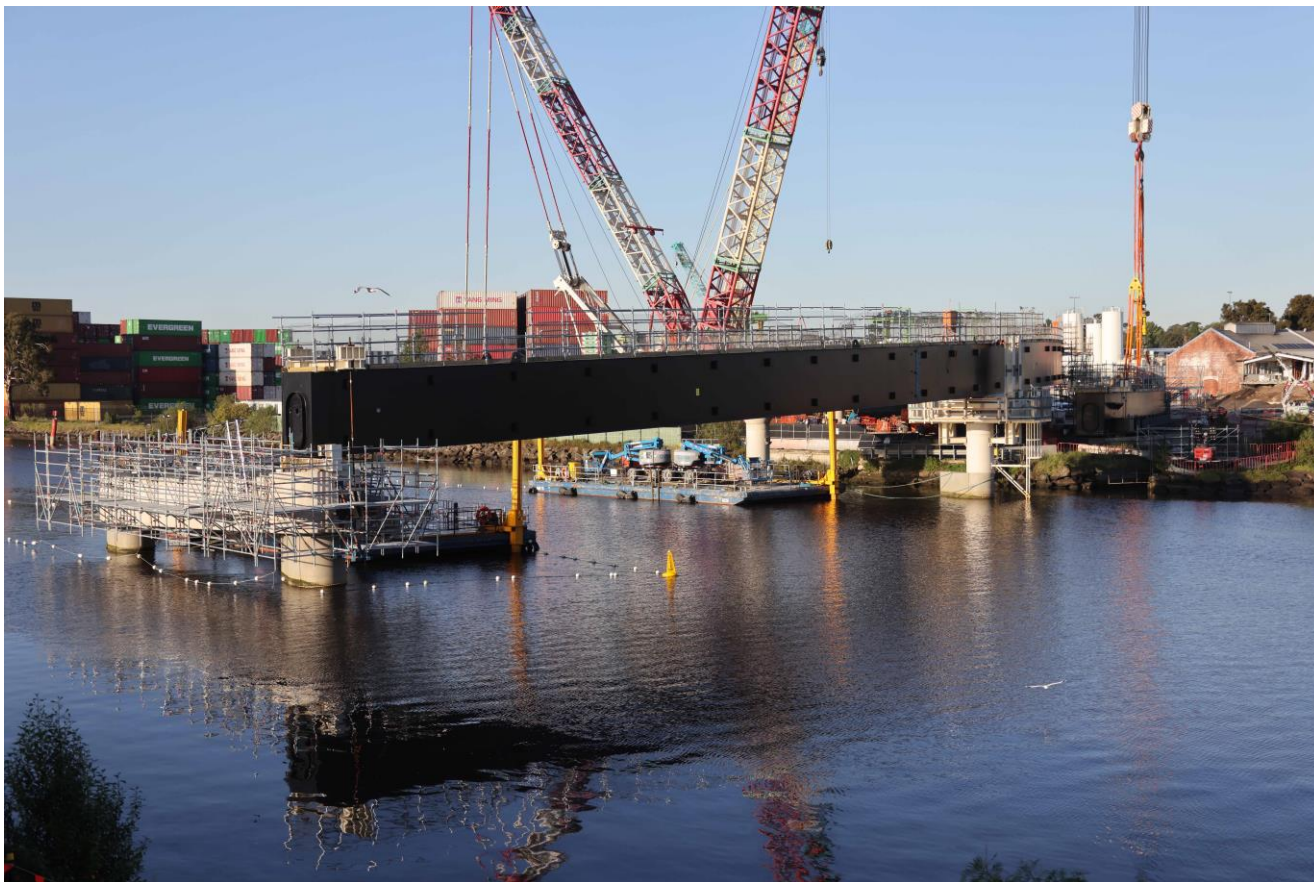
Stakeholder engagement

- Dynon Road noise complaints: Residents closest to the works have been offered respite including noise cancelling headphones, white noise machines and relocation. Six families have been relocated during particularly noisy works.

Business engagement

- Maribyrnong Street precinct businesses: Face to face engagement, letterboxed area, alternative parking option as required
- 107-109 Whitehall Street – Access discussion around access arrangements short- and long-term building demolition works
- The project emailed 143 stakeholders to confirm the upcoming closure of the entry and exit lanes of Linfox due to beam installation from Tuesday 15 November to Friday 18 November 2022, 9pm to 5am.

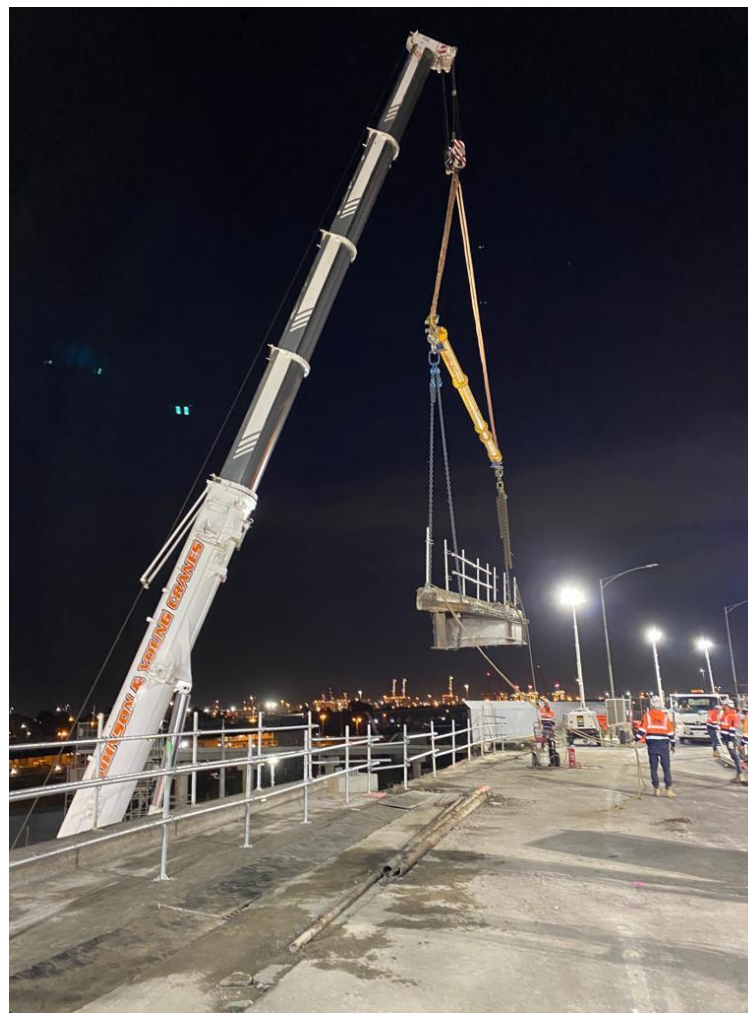

Dynon Road Bridge works (night works)

- From **10pm Saturday, 26 November to 7am Thursday, 22 December**, Dynon Road is closed in both directions from Dryburgh Street to the Dynon Road inbound exit ramp from CityLink.
- Crews are widening and strengthening the existing bridge as part of building new connections from the West Gate Tunnel to the city and CityLink.
- Team undertook early engagement with businesses and residents, offered relocation and respite and effectively handled enquiries in a timely manner

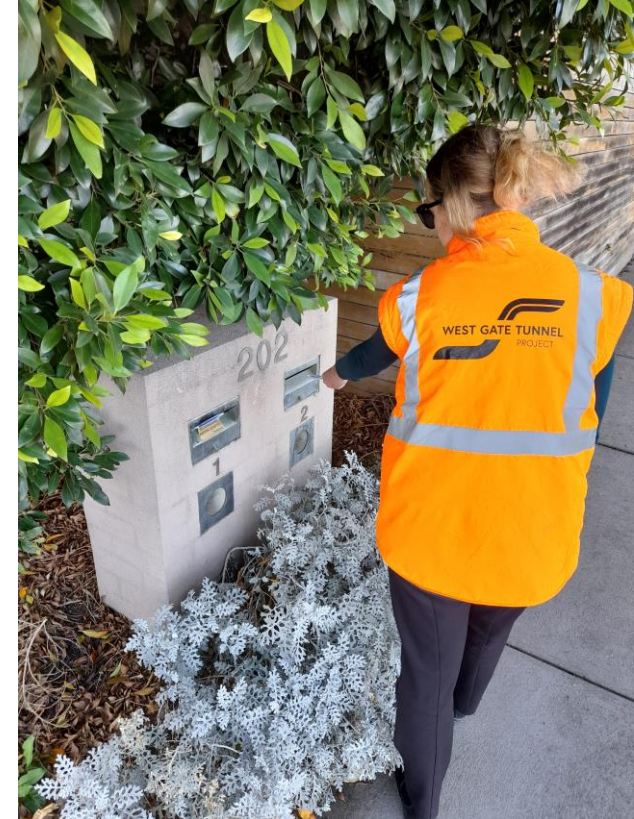
Tunnels community engagement update

Recent notifications

- DL distributed for gantry crane installation at the inbound portal at the beginning of December (including information on traffic management – Williamstown Road ramp closure).
- DLs distributed for routine well maintenance works at Earsdon Street, Hall Street, New Street, Norfolk Street, and Vockler Street.
- Two-week rolling notifications for TBM1 (Bella) at Cullen Court linked to the southern inbound portal.

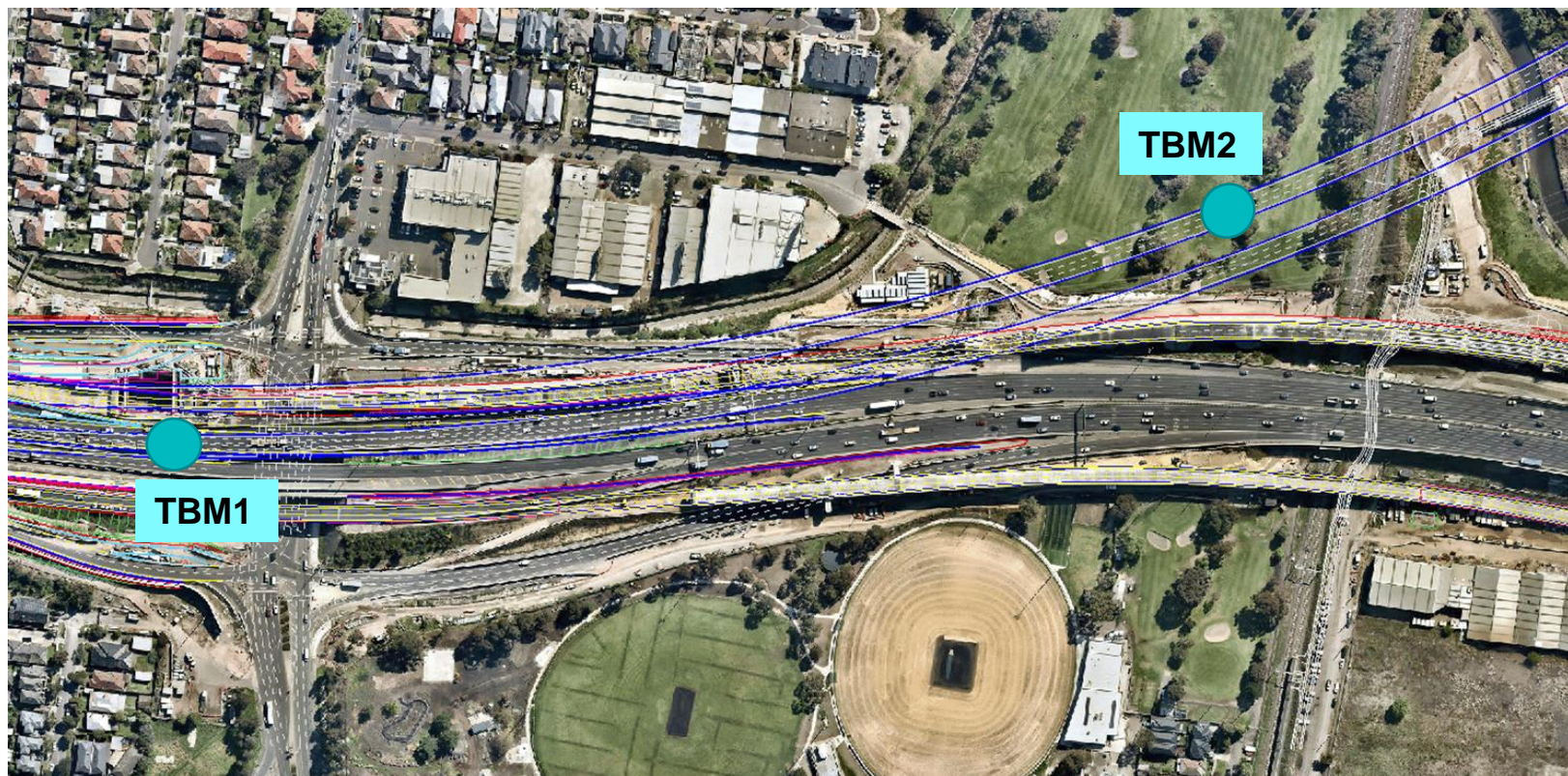
Recent stakeholder/business engagement

- Engagement with businesses along Youell Street and Cowper Street regarding parking of WGTP staff.



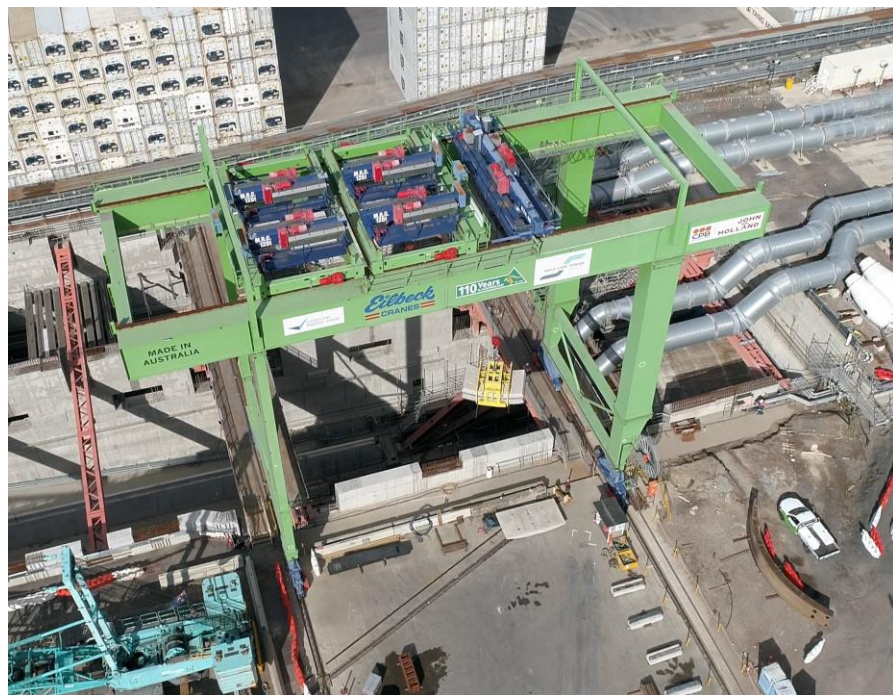

Tunnelling progress



- Bella, the TBM boring the 4km outbound tunnel, has bored 2,340m and installed 975 rings as at 4 December. Bella is now boring under the West Gate Freeway.
- Vida, the TBM boring the 2.8km inbound tunnel, has bored 1,941m and installed 809 rings as of 4 December. Vida is now under Westgate Golf Course.

West Gate Freeway tunnel portals



This 400t gantry crane has been installed at the inbound portal to lift TBM 2 (Vida) out of the pit for demobilisation.



This is an image of the southern outbound portal as it would appear in 2025 after the ventilation structure and eel net are constructed, including landscaping.

This is one of Vida's sisters breaking through a rock headwall in Norway. Similar ground conditions can also be found at the inbound portal.



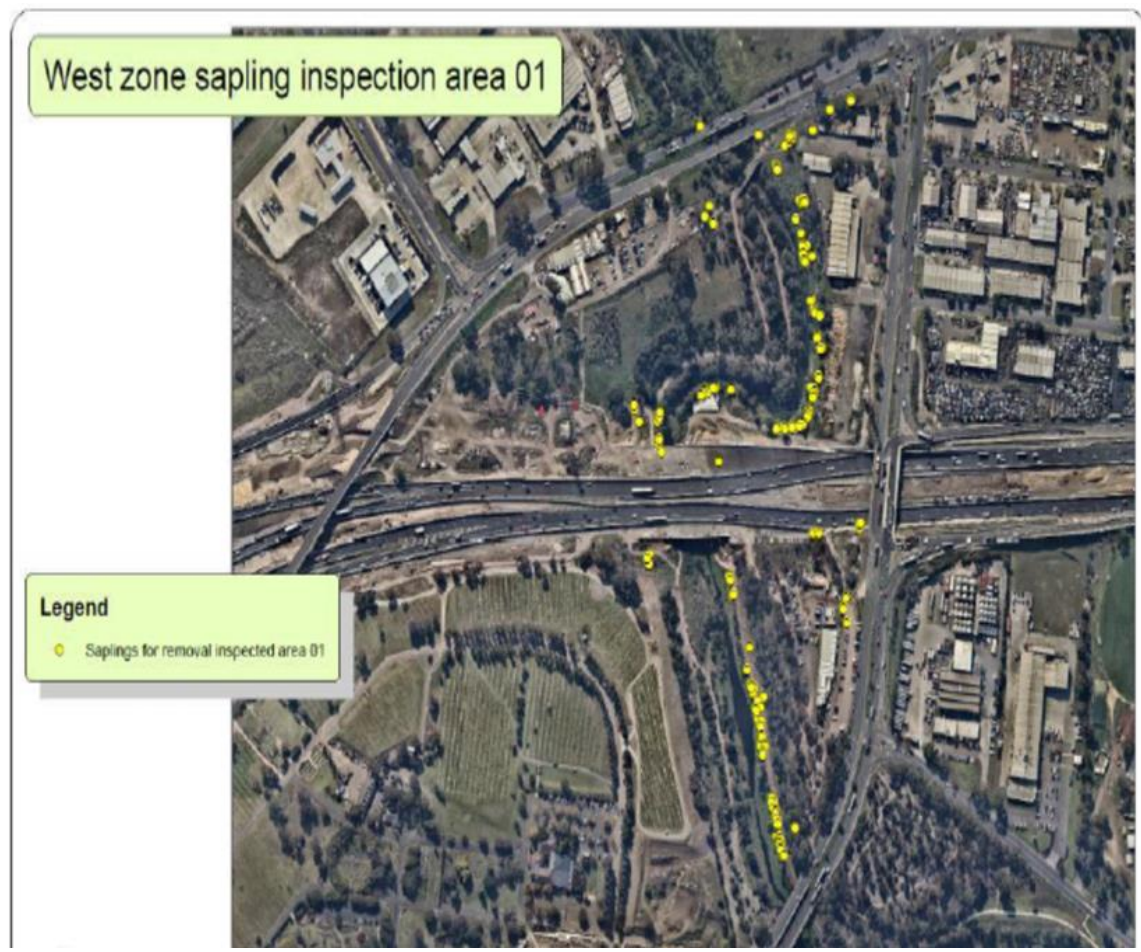

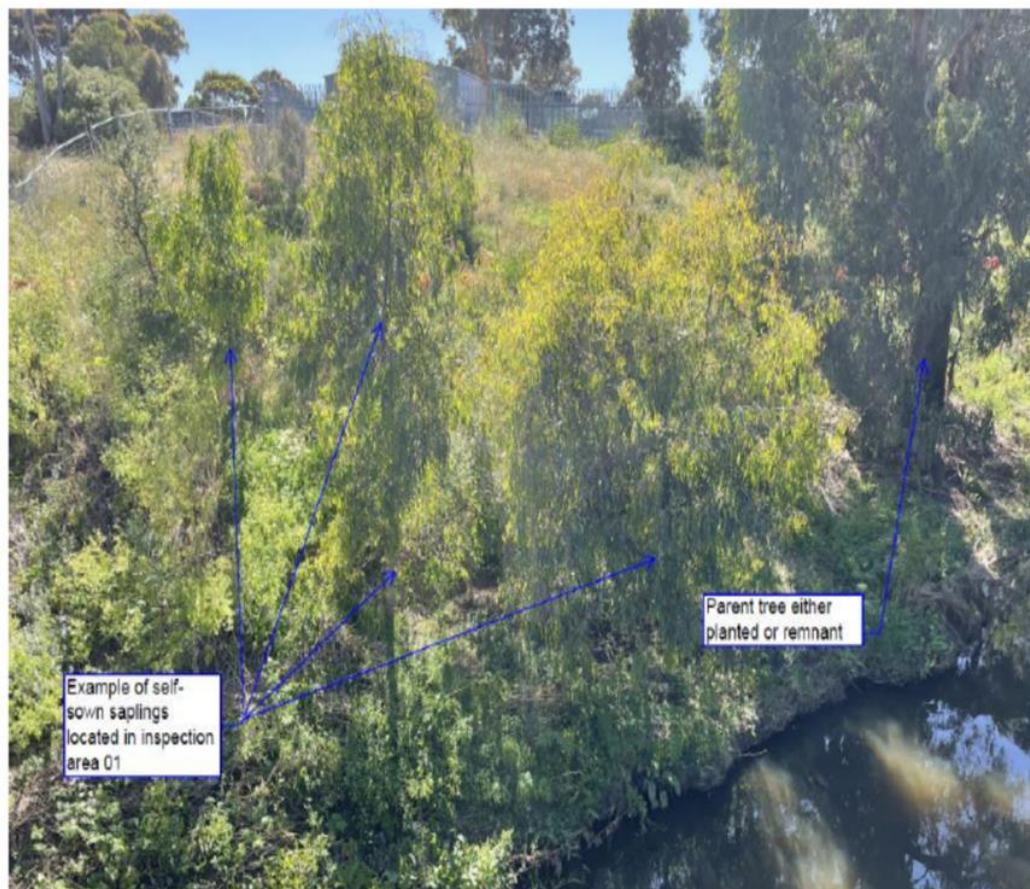
