Asphalting and rail access works

Childers Street, Kensington

Tuesday 28 February to Saturday 11 March 2023

Works to realign Childers Street and construct new public spaces are progressing. As part of these works, new asphalt will be installed and a rail access point will be established starting in late-February.

What we are doing

Asphalt works

- Removing the existing asphalt on Childers Street and installing new asphalt and line marking
- Temporarily removing on-street parking and driveway access along Childers Street between Younghusband Lane and 13 Childers Street, to ensure new asphalt is cured efficiently
- Setting up a temporary pedestrian detour to South Kensington Station
- This activity will require the use of a small excavator, asphalt materials, delivery trucks, a small compaction roller and crews with hand tools.

Childers Street rail access works

- As previously notified in the February/March construction update, works to provide rail access on Childers Street will start in March
- Activities will include removing nine trees near the rail corridor and constructing a new rail access point by laying asphalt and crushed rock
- These works will involve a small excavator, a chainsaw, a small compaction roller, an asphalt machine and crews with hand tools.

When

Asphalt works and on-street parking closure

- Tuesday 28 February to Friday 3 March.

Temporary driveway closure for 11 and 13 Childers Street

 7am to 6pm, Tuesday 28 February to Friday 3 March.

Temporary pedestrian detour to South Kensington Station

- 7am Wednesday 1 March to 1pm Saturday 4 March.









What you should be aware of

- During this time, the location for rubbish bin collections may be impacted. We will move rubbish bins from properties at 1, 3, 5, 11 and 13 Childers streets on Wednesday night for collection and return the rubbish bins back to each property by Thursday evening. Please ensure that your bins are on the street and ready for collection by 5pm on Wednesday 1 March
- Every effort has been made to minimise tree removal. All removed trees have undergone a detailed arborist assessment. In total the project will plant 93 new trees around the station precinct
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and vibration
- A pedestrian detour to South Kensington Station will be in place while works are in place. Please allow 5 minutes to your journey when using South Kensington Station. Access to the station will be maintained. Refer to the map
- Traffic management will be in place near the works area to safely allow pedestrian and cyclist access
- To ensure the safety of pedestrian and cyclists, signage for cyclist to dismount will in place.
