



CSQ Structure Sequence




- Place Ground Floor from south to north
 - 1m 1.5m thick
 - Intricate Cast-in lattice structure & exposed concrete soffit
 - Placed over 4 months
 - Start August
 - Complete October/November



CSQ Tower Crane Retrieval



- Tower Crane South Dismantle end Q4 2023
- •Dismantled by Northern Tower Crane, via Flinders Lane
- Tower Crane North Dismantle start Q1 2024
- Dismantled by 250t Mobile Crane, similar spot to TCN install July 2022
- •Reviewing opportunity for less disruptive retrieval currently
- Tower Crane footings removed during Civil & Landscape Period



CSQ Mockridge Fountain & Canopy Installation



- Mockridge Fountain Install Q1 2024
 - Insitu Structure with Precast Water Feature
 - Significant Retention of Collins St. footpath required
 - 4M Deep Excavation next to Collins Street Footpath (pictured)
- Canopy Install Q1 2024
 - Install post 5-bank escalator install
 - Install with mobile crane from City Square Ground Floor Slab


