

Works notice

Scrubber and acoustic shed removal at La Trobe Street site

August 2023

With excavation now complete at the La Trobe Street site of the new State Library Station, we are undertaking works to remove the scrubber unit and the acoustic shed which houses it.

What we are doing

- Removing the scrubber unit which has controlled air pollution during the excavation process
- Demobilising the acoustic shed located at the western end of the La Trobe Street site.

What to be aware of

- An overnight eastbound closure of La Trobe Street, between Elizabeth and Swanston streets, will commence at 10pm Tuesday 1 until 6am Wednesday 2 August 2023
- Motorists travelling eastbound on La Trobe Street will need to detour via Lonsdale Street
- Cyclists travelling eastbound on La Trobe Street will need to detour via Little Lonsdale Street
- Please refer to map overleaf for vehicle and bike detours
- In addition to the street closure, Baskerville Lane (the Aurora Apartments walkway directly adjacent to the work site) will also be closed from 10pm Tuesday 1 until 6am Wednesday 2 August 2023 to ensure pedestrian safety during the scrubber removal works
- Following the scrubber removal, approximately two weeks of shed removal works will commence
- Certain activities will occur outside normal construction hours and are expected to generate intermittent medium to high levels of noise

- Every effort will be made to schedule impactful activities during normal construction hours in an effort to minimise impact to nearby residents and businesses

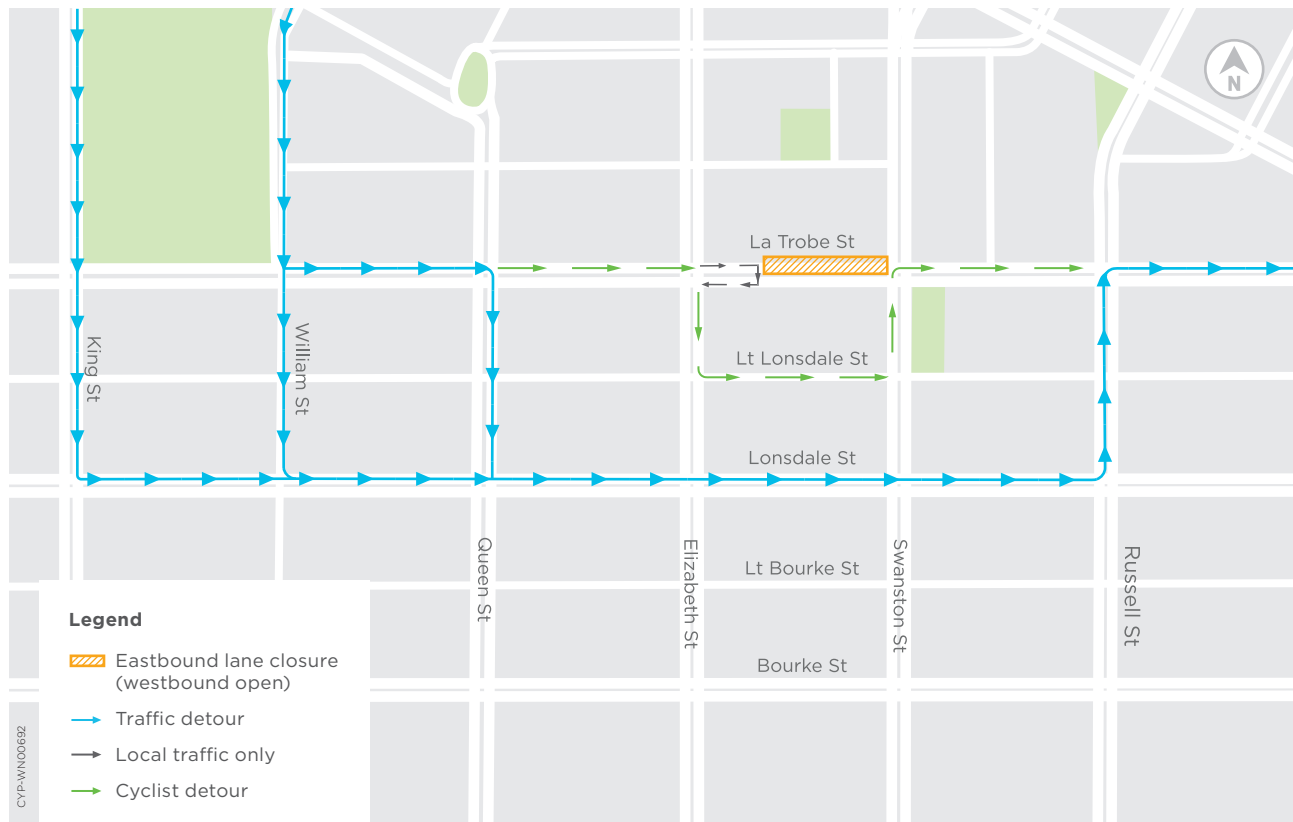
When
