










Princes Freeway Inbound at M80 Interchange

  - 350+ members of the public attending bus tours of the East zone.







8m-15m in length 136 precast units required Status: Seven completed



#### 9 EOU's (egress/exit out and under)

These 'staircases' are only in the outbound tunnel when there isn't an inbound tunnel running alongside it. These EOU's provide access to the maintenance tunnel in the event of an incident.

Road Deck completion status: Inbound: 79 percent Outbound: 93 percent











The timber structure will be built in pieces in New Zealand and shipped to Victoria.




