Concrete pump removal

Swanston Street

From Monday 3 June 2024

We wish to advise that works to remove a concrete pump and its associated infrastructure from Swanston Street will take place under a bike lane and footpath closure on Swanston Street.



When we'll be working

- 10pm to 6am Monday to Friday for five days, or until the work is complete

The timing of work may change depending on weather conditions.

What we'll be doing

- Closing the Swanston Street western footpath, adjacent to the La Trobe Street work site, and the bike lane between La Trobe and Little La Trobe streets, from 10pm to 6am during concrete pump removal works
- These works involve pump disconnection, pump and gantry removal, asphalt removal, resurfacing and kerb works
- These works involve the use of a mobile crane, trucks, elevated work platform, excavators, hand tools, power tools and rattle guns.

What to be aware of

- During the works, motorist access to Swanston Street will be maintained
- Access to business and residential buildings will be maintained at all times
- Some of these works are required to take place during the hours when trams are not running
- Some of these works will generate high levels of noise.

Where

- Swanston Street, between La Trobe and Little La Trobe streets.


