

Construction update



Domain Precinct

June 2024

Works to construct the Metro Tunnel's Anzac Station are progressing. This update provides an outline of current and upcoming works in your area in June 2024.

Works snapshot: June

In May, we completed the asphaltting on St Kilda Road between Toorak Road and Bowen Lane, including the landscaping in the central median of St Kilda Road. Work on the forecourt of the Albert Road Reserve entrance is well advanced with paving laid around the new station entrance.

In June 2024 works within the Domain precinct will focus on rebuilding Domain Road, paving works around the eastern and western entrances to Anzac Station, as well as the demolition of temporary construction site at Edmund Herring Oval and reinstatement of the playing surface. Works will also commence on the landscaping and footpath reinstatement adjacent to Cobbers Sculpture in the Shrine of Remembrance grounds.

Later in 2024 works will focus on completing the South African Soldiers' Memorial reinstatement, reopening Domain Road, opening the Albert Road green link parkland and returning Edmund Herring Oval to the community. We'll also continue station construction, utility connections, kerbing works, separated bike lane installation adjacent to the Albert Road Reserve entrance, as well as landscaping and planting.

- Reinstatement works on Domain Road and construction of a new tram and bus stop
- Edmund Herring Oval site facilities demolition
- Station entrance construction
- Asphaltting, median works and construction of footpaths
- South African Soldiers' Memorial reinstatement
- Station fit out.

Domain Road construction and Edmund Herring Oval site facilities demolition

Between St Kilda Road and Domain Street

Ongoing - 2024

- Underground services installation along Domain Road will continue in June, using saw cutters, excavators, Non-Destructive Digging and hand tools
- Sections of the footpath construction will take place at night, where it impacts access to Melbourne Grammar School
- The removal of the construction site at Edmund Herring Oval will continue in June, this involves the demolition of the concrete base on Edmund Herring Oval
- These works will involve use of excavators with hammers and while further away, they will generate periods of high noise during standard construction hours



- The works will require the overnight closure of St Kilda Road southbound, with traffic detouring via Dorcas Street and Kings Way
- These asphaltting works are expected to generate medium levels of noise with minor profiling of the road and laying of asphalt
- More information will be provided closer to the date of these works
- Tree planting in the central median is also expected to commence in June.

St Kilda Road Southbound

Ongoing - Mid 2024

- In June, the left turn lane from St Kilda Road into Domain Road will be asphalted overnight. These works were scheduled for May but have been rescheduled to June

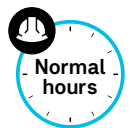


Path reinstatement to Shrine of Remembrance grounds

Adjacent to The Cobbers sculpture

June - July 2024

- Works have commenced on the construction of the legacy footpath connecting the St Kilda Road footpath to the Shrine of Remembrance grounds
- This will require the closure of the existing footpath connecting to The Cobbers sculpture and the Macpherson Robertson Fountain
- Pedestrian detours will be in place while the final legacy footpath is constructed
- These works will involve the use of excavators and asphaltting for the new footpath before the area is landscaped.

Ongoing - 2024

- During June works will continue on the station entrance forecourt, including concrete pours and the laying of bluestone pavers around the entrance
- Works are continuing on the reinstatement of the South African Soldiers' Memorial
- Works inside the station entrance will continue until 1am each night
- Hard landscaping works around the station entrance will continue in June, including installation of kerbs, footpaths, bike lane and retaining walls

Ongoing - 2024

- Major construction and finishing works have been completed on the Anzac Station platforms

- Final works are continuing on the Anzac Station concourse
- Internal fit out of the station continues 24-hours a day underground. This includes installing flooring, furniture, mechanical, electrical, plumbing fit out and painting.

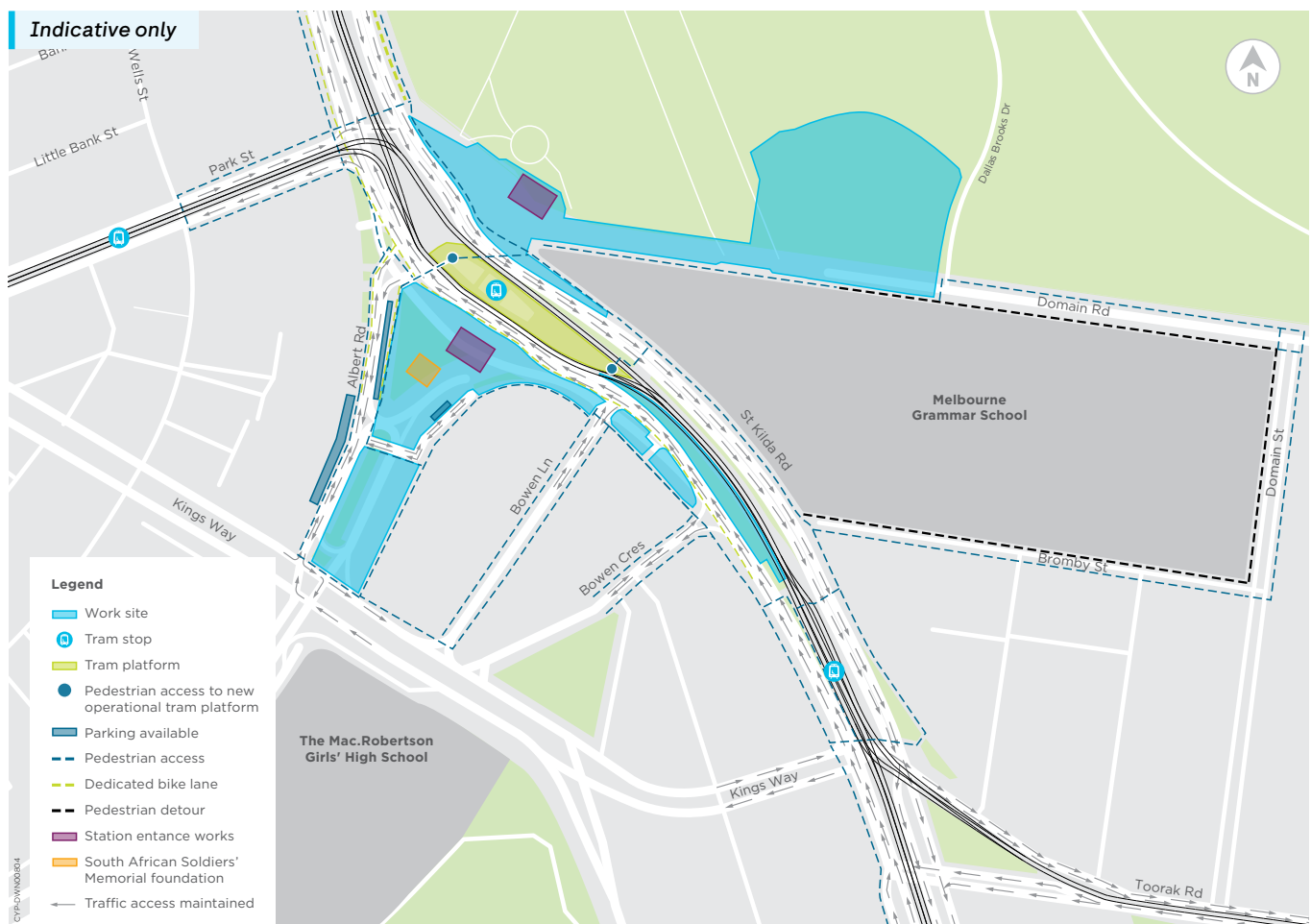

- Major construction and finishing works have been completed on the Anzac Station platforms

Intermittent construction barrier removal and set up

St Kilda Road and Albert Road



Ongoing - 2025

- As we complete works areas across the project area, barrier removal and line marking will take place to return these areas to the public or to set up new construction areas for finishing works
- To minimise disruption to traffic these works must take place at night when there is less traffic and will require intermittent night time closures of St Kilda Road
- These works involve small cranes to load the construction barriers onto or off trucks, traffic management, light towers, spotters with whistles for the safety of works, asphaltting and line marking machines

Traffic and transport impacts June 2024

Oversized deliveries

- While most deliveries to the Anzac Station site will occur during normal hours, some deliveries to and from site that are classified as 'oversized' will be required outside of normal working hours and overnight. Whenever oversized deliveries are expected overnight, crews will be reminded of noise requirements on site.

Shrine of Remembrance pedestrian access

- The St Kilda Road footpath leading to the Cobbers sculpture and the Macpherson Robertson Fountain will be closed in June to build the legacy footpath. A pedestrian detour will be in place during these works.

St Kilda Road – Northbound

- There will overnight closures of St Kilda Road northbound in June to remove barriers, asphalt and linemark
- Further detail will be provided closer to the works commencing.
