- Graham Scott (GS) raised that they would like a workshop on Precinct Planning. SRLA noted that consultation is an important part throughout the entire phases of Precinct Planning. It will feature broader community consultation along with consultation with PRG members.
- GS queried whether the existing play equipment at Sinnott Street Reserve will be repurposed for use at the Sinnott Street Reserve replacement park. SRLA and LOR advised that the equipment is at its end of life, and brandnew equipment would be installed.
- MF electorate office asked when the next round of applications for the Community Projects Fund would open. SRLA advised that at this time a date has not been set yet. As soon as a date is known, it will be circulated to PRG members.
- John Wilson asked whether the name of the SRL station in Burwood has been worked through. SRLA remarked that there are naming guidelines that must be followed and it is a nuanced process.
