

Heatherton and Clarinda works update

October 2025

Works are underway in Heatherton and Clarinda to deliver Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) East for Melbourne and Victoria.

What we are doing

Train stabling facility, Heatherton

- Building the eastern tunnel entrance (ETE) and western tunnel entrance (WTE)
- Building a permanent network support facility (NSF)
- Moving underground and above ground services.

Tunnel boring machine (TBM) launch site, Clarinda

- Building the Clarinda tunnel access structures (TAS)
- Connecting underground services.

Old Dandenong Road, Heatherton	 Ongoing to late October 2025	— Moving and connecting underground and above services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> — Intermittent northbound lane and road closures for up to two weeks between Kingston Road and Madden Road from late September to late October — Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust
TBM launch site, Clarinda	 Ongoing to late 2025	— Building the Clarinda TBM launch site, including civil works, concrete slab construction, diaphragm wall construction, piling and ground improvement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> — Changed traffic conditions on Peace Road and Victory Road — Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust — Increased truck movements day and night

Impacts

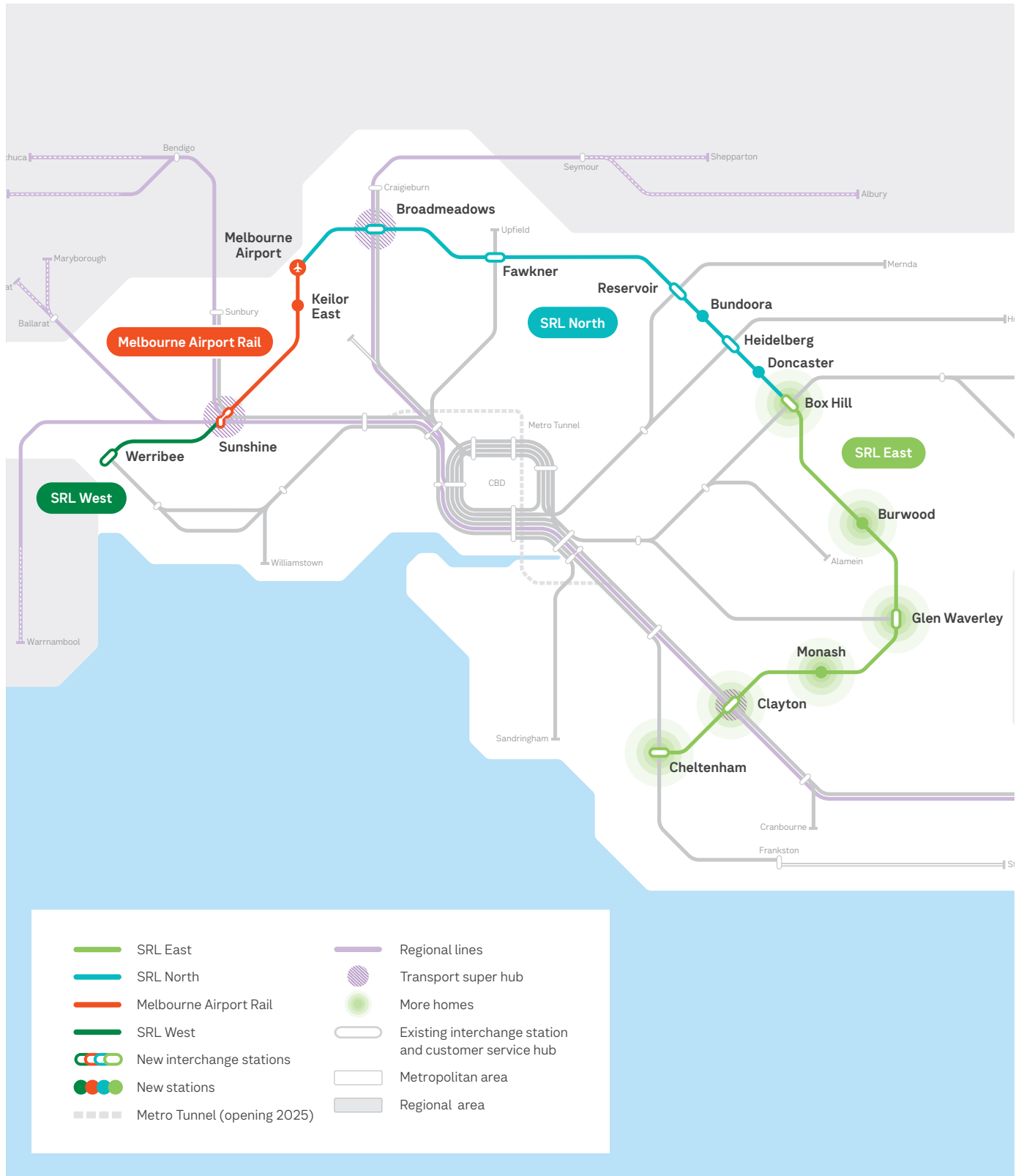
As with all major infrastructure projects, surrounding communities may experience some impacts during construction. The Project supports businesses and residents to continue to live, work, study and shop in their community.

- Covering trucks to minimise dust
- Monitoring noise, dust and vibration levels
- Using noise blankets and hoarding to minimise noise, dust and light spill
- Safely removing hazardous materials in accordance with regulations
- Using water and dust suppressants
- Maintaining access to homes and businesses.
