Construction for the Metro Tunnel's State Library Station is complete.

Works snapshot: October–November 2025

During October and November public realm was reinstated. This included rebuilding A'Beckett Street into its final configuration with A'Beckett Street reopening to the public.

Reinstatement works on Swanston Street were also completed.

Inside the station, final fittings were installed, and testing was carried out on important systems like lifts and escalators.

Changes to our monthly construction update

We'd like to thank you for your patience over the last several years while we completed the Metro Tunnel's State Library Station. As the Metro Tunnel Project is now complete, this will be the final construction update.

There are some works remaining as part of the Metro Tunnel Project, including works at Fed Square in the Town Hall Station precinct and minor works in the State Library Station precinct. The Metro Tunnel is now open

Trains are now running through the Metro Tunnel and stopping at all 5 Stations, adding extra services during the day on the Cranbourne, Pakenham and Sunbury lines.

On 1 February 2026, the Big Switch will introduce a new timetable across buses, trams, regional and metropolitan trains, and connect the Cranbourne, Pakenham and Sunbury lines with all services on these lines running through the Metro Tunnel.
