Introduction:

- Engineering our City program - officially launched in April 2019
- The program has direct links to STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts and maths) subjects throughout the Victorian school curriculum



School Engagement Program Objectives

- Engage with schools in Melbourne's west most in need of support, using scales such as ICSEA (Index of Community Socio-Educational Advantage)
- Inclusively support young people from diverse backgrounds to develop their skills and knowledge

School Engagement Program

2019 – A year in review:

- **1,812** students engaged in the broader West Gate Kids program
- **914** students from **12 schools** participated in the ‘Engineering our City’ program across **Melbourne’s west most in need of support**
- **3,241** student engagement hours for all West Gate Kids programs
- **34** sessions of Engineering our City completed
- **30** West Gate Tunnel Project staff volunteered in the program
- Worked collaboratively with our partners in the **education and STEAM** space in order to enhance delivery and raise awareness of the program



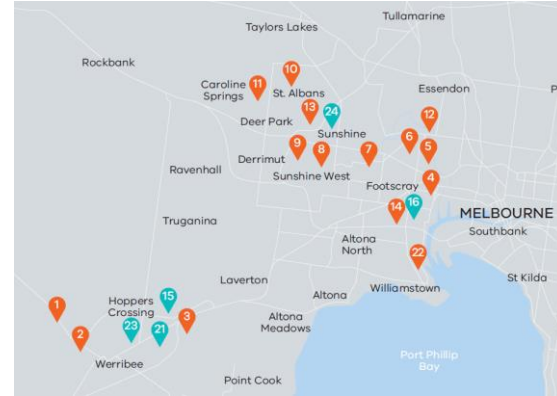
2020 – ‘Engineering our City’ program:

- Doubling the size of the program in 2020 to attend 30 schools
- Up to 3,000 students could take part in the sessions next year
- Specific focus on attending schools within the project boundary

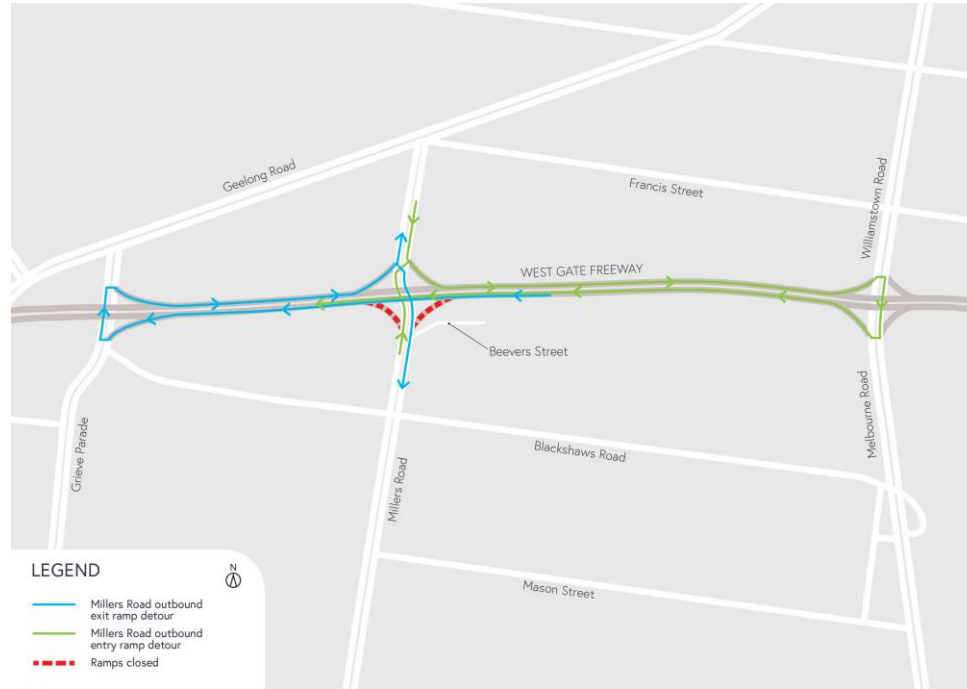

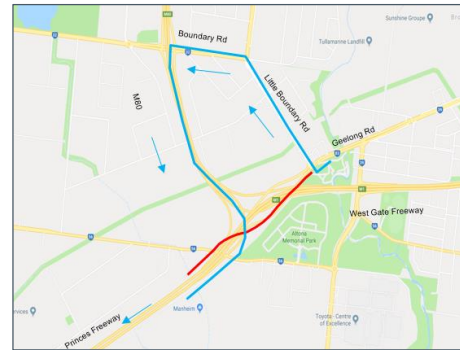
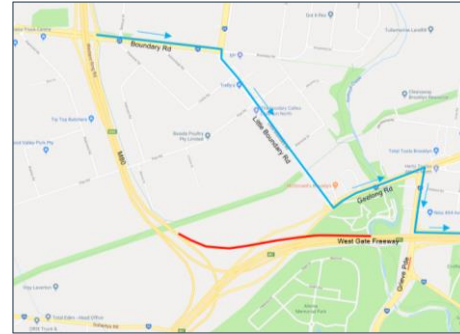


M80 interchange

Ramps will be completely closed between January to February 2020:

- the city-bound freeway connection from the M80 ring-road to the West Gate Freeway ramp
- the outbound ramp and bridge from Geelong Road to the Princess Freeway

We'll work around the clock, seven days a week to fit in as much work as possible and to minimise the duration of, and impacts on, residents, businesses and road users.

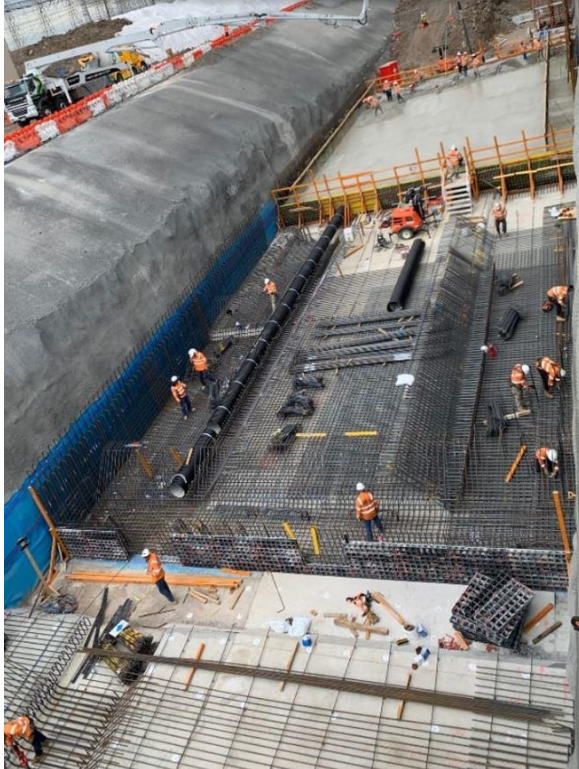
