Paringa Road closure

Sections of Paringa Road between Chambers Road and Millers Road will be closed from **Tuesday 13 September until late-October 2022** as part of our spring roadworks near Millers Road.

Driveways on Paringa Road will not be accessible at times during this road closure.

On council rubbish collection days, residents will need to place bins on the nearest side streets of, Lee Street, Bond Street and Langshaw Street, for collection.

The road closure is required so we can carry out completion works in this area, including the removal and demolition of temporary noise walls, continue the installation of freeway technology systems and permanent noise walls, install new kerbing, place new asphalt on the road, complete landscaping and complete other rectification works.

The Millers Road intersection works are continuing as per the notification on 8 August 2022 and include 24/7 works.

We recognise the impact that these ongoing works may have, and we appreciate your patience as we continue to construct the West Gate Tunnel Project.




What you can expect:
