

# Construction update



## Domain Precinct

April 2024

Works to construct the Metro Tunnel's Anzac Station are progressing. This update provides an outline of current and upcoming works in your area in April 2024.

### Works snapshot: April

In March, we built new lanes around the Anzac Station Tram Stop and completed large sections of final asphaltting along sections of St Kilda Road, returning the road to two lanes each direction.

In April 2024 works within the Domain precinct will focus on rebuilding Domain Road and on final road works along St Kilda Road. We'll also continue building the ultimate footpath between Bowen Lane and Albert Road. Additionally, we'll continue reinstatement of the South African Soldiers' Memorial, construction on Albert Road and on hard landscaping around the station entrances on either side of St Kilda Road.

Later in 2024 works will focus on completing the South African Soldiers' Memorial reinstatement, reopening Domain Road, opening the Albert Road green link parkland and returning Edmund Herring Oval to the community. We'll also continue station construction, utility connections, kerbing works, separated bike lane installations as well as landscaping and planting.

- Construction of the tram track connection between St Kilda Road and Domain Road
- Domain Road construction
- Edmund Herring Oval site facilities demolition
- Station entrance construction
- Asphaltting, median works and construction of footpaths
- South African Soldiers' Memorial reinstatement
- Station fit out.

## Upcoming works in your area

### St Kilda Road southbound closure

St Kilda Road, between  
Dorcas Street and Toorak Road



8pm Sunday 7 April – 6am Saturday 13 April

- Following the substantial completion of the asphaltting along St Kilda Road, works will commence in April to construct tram tracks from St Kilda Road into Domain Road
- The connection of these tram tracks will require a week-long closure of the southbound lane of St Kilda Road (away from city) and involve overnight works
- Pedestrian, traffic and bicycle detours will be in place
- Tram services will not be affected by the works
- These works will take place from 8pm Sunday 7 April to 6am Saturday 13 April 2024

### Domain Road construction and Edmund Herring Oval site facilities demolition

Between St Kilda Road and  
Domain Street



Ongoing – 2024

- Demolition of the redundant tram tracks and road was completed in March
- Underground services installation along Domain Road will continue in April, using saw cutters, excavators, Non-Destructive Digging and hand tools

- Sections of the roadway construction will take place at night, these works are further up Domain Road and unlikely to generate significant noise for local residents
- As these works continue, the pedestrian footpath connection between St Kilda Road and Domain Road will remain closed until early April. You can detour around the works via Bromby Street and Domain Street (See map)
- The removal of the construction site at Edmund Herring Oval will also commence in April, this will involve the removal of the substation and site sheds, before the concrete hardstand is demolished.

### St Kilda Road median works

Southbound between Park Street  
and Toorak Road



Ongoing – Mid 2024

- In April the installation of services and landscaping will continue in the median islands on St Kilda Road
- These works include planting and soft landscaping adjacent to the tram stop.

Northbound between  
Bowen Crescent and Bowen Lane



Ongoing – Mid 2024

- In April, works will continue on the drainage installation adjacent to the ventilation structures and chiller plant
- Landscaping and final kerb works will also take place through this section before the area is ready for tree planting

- Backfilling and temporary fencing removal immediately adjacent to the tram tracks will take place out of hours after the last tram has passed
- Once these areas are complete, the concrete barriers will be removed, with asphaltting works taking place along this section, as well as works on St Kilda Road to repair a damaged kerb
- These works will require an overnight closure of the northbound lanes of St Kilda Road
- Once these works are complete parking will be installed along St Kilda Road between Bowen Crescent and Bowen Lane
- More information will be provided closer to the date of these works.

- Pedestrian detours will be in place while the final legacy footpath is constructed
- These works will involve the use of excavators and asphaltting for the new footpath before the area is landscaped.

## Path reinstatement to Shrine of Remembrance grounds

### Adjacent to the Cobbers monument

April – June 2024



- In April, works will commence on the construction of the legacy footpath connecting the St Kilda Road footpath to the Shrine of Remembrance grounds
- This will require the closure of the existing footpath connecting to the Cobbers monument and the Macpherson Robertson Fountain

## Station entrances construction

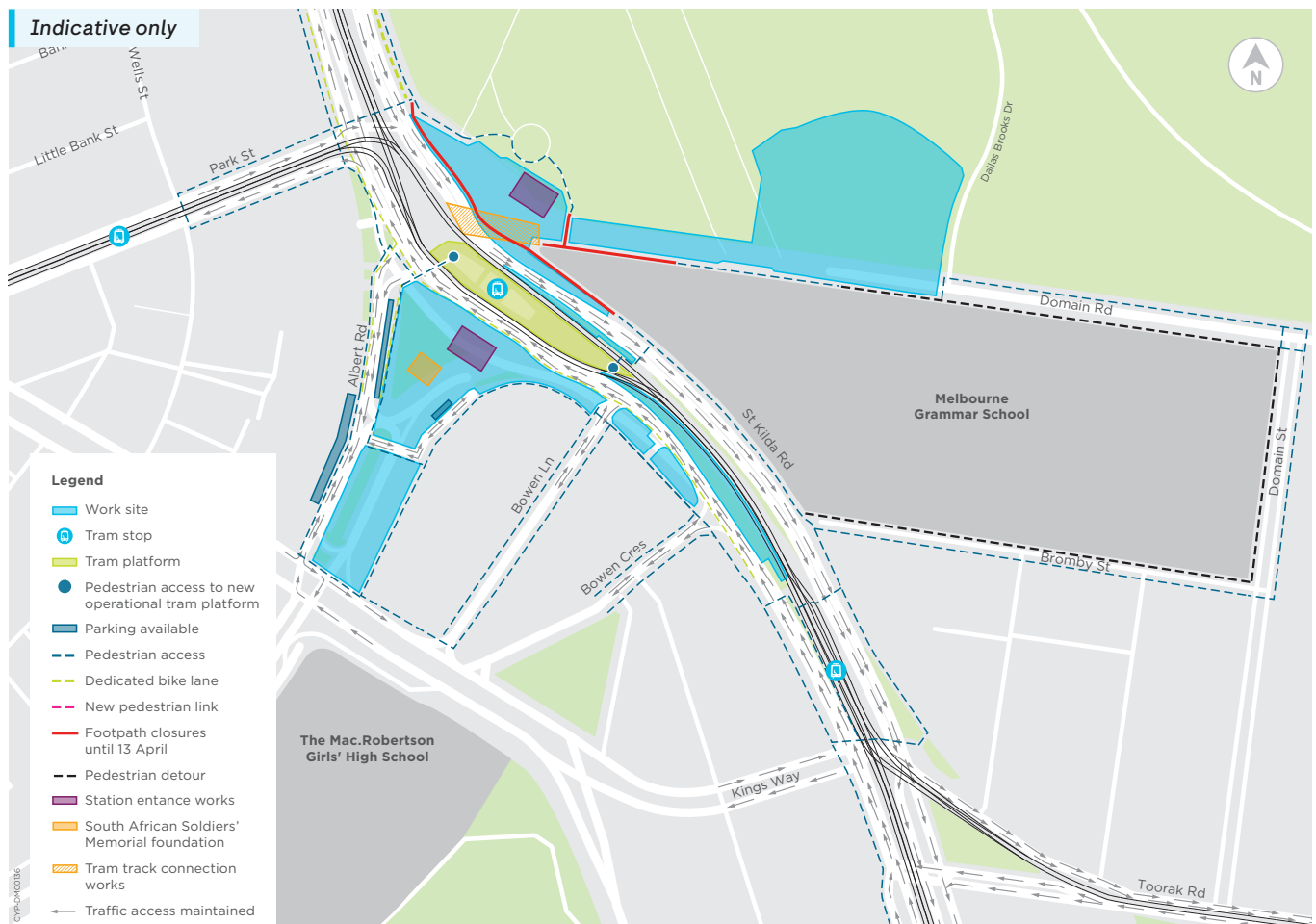
### Albert Road Reserve, west entrance



Ongoing – 2024

- Installation and commissioning of the lifts was completed in March
- During April works will continue on the station entrance forecourt, including concrete pours and the laying of bluestone pavers around the entrance
- Works are continuing on the reinstatement of the South African Soldiers' Memorial
- Works inside the station entrance will continue until 1am each night
- Hard landscaping works around the station entrance will continue in April, including installation of kerbs, footpaths, bike lane and retaining walls.

## Shrine of Remembrance, east entrance

Ongoing – 2024

- Hard landscaping works around the station entrance will continue in April, works will include installation of kerbs, footpaths, retaining walls and garden beds
- Works inside the station entrance will continue until 1am each night



## Station box construction and fit out

### Concourse and platform level of station box

Ongoing – 2025

- Major construction and finishing works have been completed on the Anzac Station platforms
- Final works are continuing on the Anzac Station concourse
- Internal fit out of the station continues 24-hours a day underground. This includes installing flooring, furniture, mechanical, electrical, plumbing fit out and painting.



## Intermittent construction barrier removal and set up

St Kilda Road and Albert Road

Ongoing – 2025

- As we complete works across the project, barrier removal and line marking will take place to return these areas to the public or to set up new construction areas for finishing works
- To minimise disruption to traffic these works must take place at night when there is less traffic and will require intermittent night time closures of St Kilda Road
- These works involve small cranes to load the construction barriers onto or off trucks, traffic management, light towers, spotters with whistles for the safety of works, asphaltting and line marking machines
- Notification will be provided closer to the works commencing.



## Traffic and transport impacts April 2024

### Oversized deliveries

- While most deliveries to the Anzac Station site will occur during normal hours, some deliveries to and from site that are classified as 'oversized' will be required outside of normal working hours and overnight. Whenever oversized deliveries are expected overnight, crews will be reminded of noise requirements on site.

### Albert Road

- There will be some changes to cycling arrangements along Albert Road while the final cycling lanes are completed.

### St Kilda Road – Southbound

- From **8pm Sunday 7 April to 6am Saturday 13 April 2024**, there will be a 24-hour a day, one-week closure of the southbound lanes of St Kilda Road between Dorcas Street and Toorak Road to allow the construction of the tram tracks connecting into Domain Road. Detours will be in place for traffic, cyclists and pedestrians.
- To reduce impacts to traffic these works will be timed to coincide with the school holidays, and local business access will be maintained
- The St Kilda Road footpath connecting to the Shrine of Remembrance grounds, The Cobbers sculpture and the Macpherson Robertson Fountain will be closed in April to build the legacy footpath.

### St Kilda Road – Northbound

- There will be overnight closures of St Kilda Road northbound in April to remove barriers, asphalt, repair kerbs and linemark
- Further detail will be provided closer to the works commencing.

### Park Street

- The east / west pedestrian crossing at the Park Street and St Kilda Road intersection to the Shrine of Remembrance grounds will close at times in April.

### Domain Road

- The pedestrian path connecting Domain Road to St Kilda Road is currently closed and will reopen in early April.
