Works are underway in Burwood to deliver Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) East for Melbourne and Victoria.

What we are doing

 **Day works** 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 7am to 1pm, Saturday

 **24 hour works** Monday to Sunday



Tunnel boring machine (TBM) assembly

The TBMs are being launched from Burwood, first tunnelling towards Glen Waverley and then towards Box Hill.

The TBM parts have arrived in Melbourne by ship and have been transported to Burwood, where they are on site and ready for assembly.

How we will manage our works

We will minimise impacts to the community by:

- Maintaining access to businesses and homes
- Transporting materials from site in covered trucks to minimise dust
- Installing road safety and detour signage
- Building acoustic sheds to minimise noise and dust from construction activities
- Monitoring noise, dust and vibration levels
- Using water and dust suppressants.
