






#### **WGTP 'Discovery Day'**

- Large scale community celebration that acknowledges the patience of the local community who've experienced long term construction impacts West Gate Tunnel
- Day will offer free 2.5 km walks through parts of the tunnel from 10am to 5pm
- There will be a family friendly run between 7am and 9am with the registration fee donated to two local community organisations
- There will be a free community festival at Yarraville Gardens which will host a kid's zone, entertainment, stalls and food trucks, with a focus on local suppliers.



#### Early access for locals

- To thank the community for their patience, locals in areas that have been highly impacted by construction were provided with priority access codes
- These have gone to 58,000 households in suburbs such as Yarraville, Altona North, Seddon, Brooklyn and others.
- Locals will receive their codes between Monday 20 and Friday 25 October.
- Code is valid until 1 November.
- 50% of registrations are reserved for our local communities



#### **Event details – 2.5km walk**

Discovery Day will offer free walks through the tunnel, of approximately 2.5km

- The route will be accessible for prams and those with mobility requirements
- Approximately 6,000 people will be able to walk through per hour
- Animated light projections will be set up within the tunnel as an activation
- Community members will need to preregister for the walk timeslots
  - Locals will receive priority



# 8km run via Tunnel and infrastructure

We will have the option for 10,000 community members to register for a family friendly run, which would be held between 7am and 9am on the morning of Discovery Day:

- The run route will give attendees the option to run on the elevated roadway, ramps and through the tunnel before heading back towards Yarraville Gardens
- This activity would be subject to a \$58
  registration fee with the money to be donated to
  our local charity partners Community Bike Hub
  and West Welcome Wagon.









# Family friendly area at Yarraville Gardens

- Yarraville Gardens will be used as a community hub with family friendly activities from 7am to 6pm.
- The site will used as a public gathering space which will host a kid's zone, entertainment, stalls and food trucks, with a focus on local suppliers.
- From this area the community will also be able to see parts of the West Gate Tunnel project including the tunnel portal infrastructure and walking and cycling connection points.













#### **Northern Portal cladding**





#### **Hyde Street & Somerville Road intersection**
