Concrete slab removal near the rail corridor

Queens Avenue, Springvale

Monday 23 February – Friday 7 March

Concrete removal works will be undertaken next to the rail corridor on Queens Avenue between Regent Avenue and Princess Avenue.



When we'll be working

- **Monday 23 February – Friday 7 March 2026**
- These works will take place during the day, Monday – Friday between **7am – 6pm**

Please note works may be rescheduled depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Removing a concrete slab next to the rail corridor on Queens Avenue between Regent Avenue and Princess Avenue
- Breaking up the concrete and removing the concrete via a truck
- This will require the use of an excavator, a demolition saw and hand tools
- The truck and excavator will be located on the roadside reserve
- Hand tools will be used during the works.

What to be aware of

- Traffic controllers will be used as required, for short periods, to assist with vehicle and equipment movements onto the roadside reserve on Queens Avenue between Regent Avenue and Princess Avenue
- There will be intermittent stop and hold arrangements for pedestrians and drivers on Djerring Trail and Queens Avenue
- Access to all local properties will be fully maintained during these works
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise with intermittent periods of high levels of noise.




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
