Asphalting and Kerb reinstatement works

Little La Trobe Street, Melbourne

Monday 30 March to Thursday 2 April 2026

Asphalting and kerb reinstatement will take place on Little La Trobe Street between Swanston Street and the Brady Hotel on Monday 30 March to Thursday 2 April 2026 between 7am and 6pm.



When we'll be working

- 7am to 6pm, Monday 30 March to Thursday 2 April 2026

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Removing the existing road surface
- Laying asphalt to form a new road surface
- Reinstating kerbing.

What to be aware of

- Profiling, asphalting and kerbing works are expected to produce medium to high levels of noise and some vibrations
- To safely carry out these works, the footpath on the southern side of Little La Trobe Street will be closed with pedestrians diverted to the northern side footpath

- Detours will be in place via A'Beckett and Elizabeth streets
- Little La Trobe Street will be reopen overnight from 6pm to 7am for through access from Swanston to Elizabeth Street
- Pedestrian access to the Brady Hotel and Scape will be maintained
- Traffic controllers will be on site to assist with vehicle movements via Elizabeth Street to Baskerville Lane and pedestrian movements.


