

Works Notification

Site establishment and car park closure

Talmage Street, Albion

From mid-January to late 2021

Further to the recent Sunbury Line Upgrade construction update, we wish to remind you that there will be site establishment and car park closure activities in your area to support the construction of the new electrical substation in Albion.

What we are doing

Site establishment activities

- Establishing a project site compound including worker amenities, project staff car parking and a shipping container for the storage of construction materials. This site will be used to support the construction of the new Albion electrical substation
- Installing temporary fencing around the perimeter of the site
- Installing four ramps along Talmage Street to safely assist pedestrian movement through the area.

Temporary closure of the heritage substation private car park

- Temporarily closing the heritage substation private car park on Talmage Street for up to 12 months to allow for site establishment and construction works to take place
- A new, paved car park will be built in this location in late 2021, upon completion of the new Albion substation.

When

Site establishment works

- Mid-January to late January 2021.

Temporary closure of the heritage substation private car park

- Mid-January to late 2021.

Site use and construction activities

- Mid-January to late 2021
- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

What to be aware of

- There will be an increase in construction vehicles travelling on local roads to access Talmage Street. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist construction vehicle access and to help pedestrians and cyclists move through the area
- These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise and dust. The use of a water cart will be used to minimise the impact of dust.
