1.	Welcome and housekeeping The meeting opened at 4:06 pm. - Emily Box (EB) provided an Acknowledgement of Country, and a round of introductions was held. - John Mullahy (JM) noted the new Minister for the Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) and thanked the previous Minister for their work.	Chairs
2.	Project update – SRLA - SRLA provided an update on the procurement of the SRL East packages, including the scope and recent contract award of the Linewide Alliance. - SRLA provided an update on structure planning and the next stages.	SRLA
3.	Works update – Initial and Early Works - Laing O'Rourke (LOR) presented on upcoming works, including: - Final relocation and commissioning of utility services and associated road closures and planned power outage - Installation of lighting poles on Montclair Avenue and associated road closures - Reinstatement works until mid June. - LOR confirmed demobilisation is expected to occur in mid June and expressed appreciation for the collaboration and patience of PRG members, traders, residents and the community during the Initial and Early works package. 4.	Works update – Tunnels North main works - Terra Verde (TV) - TV provided an overview of recently completed and upcoming works, including: - Partial closures of Montclair Avenue, Glendale Street, and Coleman Parade - Closure of Montclair car park and upcoming closure of commuter car spaces on the northern side of Coleman Parade	TV

- Completed construction and commissioning of Myrtle Street west car park
- Demolition of buildings and creation of a piling platform at 46-50 Montclair Avenue
- Commencement of piling works from mid to late May as well as methodology and expected impacts
- Upcoming construction of a pedestrian and cycling path along Coleman Parade
- Ongoing construction of Myrtle Street east car park
- Station box excavation works scheduled for late Q3 2026
- Service relocation and decommissioning works along Myrtle Street and Glendale Street.
- TV showed timelapse footage of works undertaken to date in Glen Waverley that had taken place in the area.
- TV provided an overview of recently completed and upcoming engagement activities, including:
 - Participation in the Glen Waverley Lunar New Year festival, including distribution of business support vouchers
 - Ongoing pop-ups, door knocks, and one-on-one briefings with residents and businesses ahead of works and traffic changes
 - Engagement with WRSL
 - Tailored business support ahead of piling works
 - Other business support measures, including a workforce 'Spend and Win' program and use of local businesses for TV organisational events.
- TV shared how community/PRG feedback has influenced construction activities and engagement, including:
 - Optimising the staging of car park closures and openings to provide as many car spaces to the Glen Waverley as possible
 - Creating an alcove in the Montclair car park to support with trader waste collection
 - Community Crew undertaking clean-ups of the precinct
 - Greater collaboration between SRLA contractors
 - Minimising impacts through considered scheduling of works
 - Greater use of translated materials to reach CALD community members.

Discussion:

- JM queried whether capping beams are placed immediately after piles are completed.
 - TV responded that capping beam works will take place after all piles are installed around the station box.
- Eric Wegman (EW) asked whether piling works create spoil.
 - TV responded that piling works would require ongoing spoil removal, which will be moved from site via the project's designated haulage routes. TV noted that the project's secondary truck haulage route uses Snedden Drive and offered to provide further information to Vicinity Centres.
 - **ACTION:** TV to provide haulage route information to Vicinity Centres.
- JM raised the need for all contractors in Glen Waverley to coordinate works to minimise cumulative impacts on the Glen Waverley community. JM noted some community confusion regarding traffic arrangements over the Valentine's Day period. JM reiterated his desire that all contractors to continue working together to manage these impacts and coordinate communications.
- Emily Curcio (EC) raised that Vicinity Centres can provide a complimentary activation space at The Glen for TV to use.
 - TV responded that this is of great interest and that they would like to accept this offer.
- EW queried whether Minister Staikos was still the Minister for Consumer Affairs. JM advised that Minister Staikos now only held the Suburban Rail Loop and Housing and Building portfolios.

5.	Other business - EB confirmed previous minutes and actions. - JM shared that the Friends of the WRSL and Glen Waverley Bowls Club host weekly Friday social events and encouraged PRG members to attend. The meeting closed at 4:50 pm.	All
