


CONSTRUCTION UPDATE – PROJECT WIDE









STATE LIBRARY STATION

- Top-down construction works are continuing at the La Trobe and Little La Trobe Street sites
- Structure and lining works are continuing below ground as the team continue to install the permanent architectural elements of the future State Library Station
- TBM Joan arrived at the State Library Station precinct in late December 2020.





TOWN HALL STATION

- Excavation works within the northern and central sections of the City Square shaft are nearing completion
- Works to install a hand painted creative installation on the City Square acoustic shed recently commenced
- The first major concrete pour of the year (and the largest to date for the Town Hall Station precinct) will take place at the Flinders Quarter site in early February
- More than 30 metres beneath Swanston Street works are continuing for the construction of the underground station platform (ground beam installation works pictured).

ANZAC STATION

- Works to construct the Shrine of Remembrance station entrance are underway
- Excavation continues for the tram interchange station entrance, with the team now excavating beneath the suspended roof slab
- Concrete pours are ongoing to construct the concourse level slab. Six out of ten pours have been completed.










PERMANENT STRUCTURE WORKS

- Works on B1, B2 & B3 slabs are in progress, as the team close the tunnelling lifting windows
- Wall linings between B1 and the roof slab have commenced
- Structure works in the retail area have commenced
- Roof slab works are anticipated to commence from mid-February 2021.

PERMANENT STRUCTURE WORKS – ROOF SLAB

- Roof slab works will occur progressively from east to west
- Key considerations are maintaining access for other work areas e.g. north-east emergency exit area
- Works involve deck removal, steel fixing, concrete pours, backfill.









STATION FIT-OUT WORKS

- From late February 2021, fit out works at the Grattan Street east site will commence
- Fit-out works are required to make the station suitable for occupation
- Works will include primary architectural walls, services and plant
- Fit-out works will require increased deliveries of plant and material to site. Oversized deliveries will also be required.










SECONDARY BOXES

- Royal Parade station entrance:
 - Excavation is complete
 - Shotcrete and tension piles are ongoing
 - Structure works to follow
- Retail area:
 - Excavation is ongoing in at the west end
 - Structure works have commenced at the east end
- North-east emergency area:
 - Excavation and gantry crane rail removal
 - Strutting works to follow
 - Works will pause until roof slab construction adjacent has occurred.










TUNNEL VENTILATION SHAFT (TVS) EAST & GOODS LIFT

- Construction of the Leicester Street midblock pedestrian crossing has commenced
- Southern boundary changes to be undertaken following completion of the Leicester Street crossing
- Piling works have commenced and will continue for around three weeks.








TVS WEST & CHILLER PLANT

- Preparatory works for the TVS west and chiller plant are scheduled from late March
- This will require the closure of the Barry Street pedestrian crossing. A new crossing located approx. 50 metres south will be open
- Works will involve:
 - Preparatory & site establishment works
 - Piling
 - Excavation
 - Permanent structure

PREPARATORY WORKS

Works are required to enable construction of the future station entrance:

- Services works (relocation and removal of redundant services)
- Pedestrian crossing works (creation of ramps, crossings)
- Removal and relocation of street furniture
- Constructing a future site access point on Royal Parade.






STAGE 2 NORTH ENTRANCE WORKS

- Site establishment and preparatory works
- Piling
- Excavation to roof slab
- Roof slab construction
- Excavation under roof slab
- Structure works for walls and base slab.



ROOF SLAB CONSTRUCTION

- Nine out of 11 bays have been poured to date
- The tenth pour will occur during February/March
- The final pour (underneath the gantry crane shed) will occur around September/October









DRIVEN PILING (FOUNDATION REINFORCEMENT)

- 37 driven piles will be installed in the north east corner of the station box and one pile in the south east corner
- Piles will reinforce the station building foundation (where the building access points sit outside of the station box footprint)
- Driven piling to commence late February 2021
- Driven piling works will only be undertaken during normal construction hours (7am – 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am to 1pm Saturday)

SERVICES BUILDING CONSTRUCTION

- Work will commence on the new Arden Station services building in February 2021
- The services building will be located at the western end of the station box
- The building will house high voltage (HV) switch rooms, provide HV reticulation for the entire project, and serve as an emergency access point
- Initial works will include construction of concrete slabs, back of house stair access to platform and brick lined precast concrete façade panels
- Construction will take approximately six months

STATION ENTRANCE CONSTRUCTION

- Work will commence on the new Arden Station entrance in April 2021
- The station entrance will be located on Laurens Street (near the corner of Barwise Street)
- Construction will take approximately 12 months








OTE (OVER TRACK EXHAUST) AND PLATFORM CONSTRUCTION

- Construction of the station platform and OTE system (west box) commenced in January 2021
- The OTE forms part of the tunnel and station ventilation system
- Works in the west box will take approximately three months
- Works in the east box will commence mid year and take approximately three months. They will occur later to accommodate the retrieval and return of the TBMs.



Segments of the OTE system installed in the station west box










INTAKE SUBSTATION CONSTRUCTION

- Foundation structure complete
- Building works to commence February 2021
- Under creek bore works (66kV in from the West Melbourne Terminal Station to ISS) scheduled for April 2021)
- Under track bore works (22kV out from the ISS to Arden Station) scheduled for late 2021





LAURENS STREET REALIGNMENT

- Laurens Street, between Queensberry and Arden streets, will be realigned in late February/early March to support construction of the new station entrance. Works will include:
 - Installing a pedestrian crossing on Laurens Street, south of Queensberry Street
 - Closing the western footpath on Laurens Street (between Arden and Queensberry streets)
 - Closing on-street parking spaces on both sides of Laurens Street, from Arden Street to just south of Queensberry Street
 - Installing concrete barriers on the western side of Laurens Street to delineate the site footprint
 - Realigning traffic and bicycle lanes around the concrete barriers
 - Reducing the speed limit on Laurens Street to 40 km/h

MECHANICAL, ELECTRICAL, PLUMBING (MEP)

Over the next two years, works at Arden Station will include:

- Installation of large transformers, electrical switchboards, general light and power and cabling
- Installation of large tunnel ventilation systems, mechanical ventilation and air conditioning systems
- Station drainage systems, hot and cold water services, and water treatment plants
- Installation of fire protection and detection services, including hydrants, hose reels, sprinklers, smoke detectors and gas discharge systems
- Installation of security systems, including CCTV and access control
- Installation of signalling equipment.







WHAT'S HAPPENING AT ARDEN STATION

Out of hours works (Arden Station site)

- 6pm –10pm (evening works), Monday to Friday
 - Primary structure construction (including concrete pours), as required
 - Strut removal, as required
- 10pm 7am (night works), Monday to Friday
 - Over-size equipment deliveries to and from site and use of a crawler crane to unload deliveries
 - After 6pm, construction vehicles will enter and exit via Arden Street wherever possible
- 24 hours, seven days a week
 - Tunnelling, slurry treatment plant, grout pump and segment facility operation
 - Trucks transporting excavated material from site
 - Cross passage construction between Arden and Parkville
- 7am 6pm, Saturday
 - Localised closure of Laurens Street, between Queensberry and Arden streets for one day (late February/early March)
 - Installation of concrete barriers and line marking associated with Laurens Street realignment

TBM PROGRESS

TBM Joan

- Broke through at Parkville Station 27 August 2020
- Relaunched from Parkville Station 15 October 2020
- Broke through at State Library Station 20 December 2021
- Scheduled to relaunch from State Library Station end February 2021

TBM Meg

- Broke through at Parkville Station 19 September 2020
- Relaunched from Parkville Station 4 November 2020
- Has currently completed approximately 870m (of 970m)









CROSS PASSAGE CONSTRUCTION

- Cross passage 5 (Lothian Street) excavation and waterproofing complete. FRP lining works ongoing
- Cross passage 6 (Hotham Gardens) excavation and waterproofing complete. FRP lining works ongoing
- Cross passage 7 (corner of Errol and O'Shanassy streets) – excavation complete.
 Waterproofing ongoing
- Cross passage 8 (Villiers Street) excavation complete. Waterproofing to commence early February
- Cross passage 9 (Flemington Road) excavation complete. Waterproofing ongoing
- Cross passage 10 (Church Street) break in and excavation commenced
- Cross passage 11 (Canada Lane) break in and excavation programmed to commence early February



TUNNEL INTERNAL STRUCTURES

Tunnel invert construction

- 100m sections of invert poured per day
- Pours to occur using custom-built, "dual drive" concrete agis
- Works to occur in the westbound tunnel between the Western Portal (Kensington) and Arden Station between mid-February and mid-March
- Works to occur in the eastbound tunnel between the Western Portal (Kensington) and Arden between mid-March and mid-April










LAURENS ST – NORTH MELBOURNE TIMELINE
