## BALLAN ROAD INTERSECTION UPGRADE

AUTUMN 2026



Major works are progressing to upgrade the intersection of Ballan, McGrath and Greens roads in Wyndham Vale.

By mid-2027, the roundabout will be transformed into a safer, signalised intersection designed to support the more than 30,000 vehicles that use this intersection every day.

We're currently focussed on building the northern side of the new intersection. Since January, we've:

- installed new drainage near McGrath Road north

- relocated street lighting to make way for the new intersection
- placed asphalt
- installed concrete barriers along Ballan Road to keep workers and the community safe
- demolished the original roundabout to make room to build the new intersection
- installed a temporary roundabout to maintain traffic flow on Ballan Road during construction
- excavated the road pavement and kerb on McGrath Road north at Ballan Road, and built new kerb.

As works progress, there will continue to be changes to the way you move around the area.

McGrath Road north remains closed at Ballan Road until later in 2026. To access McGrath Road north by car, continue to use the vehicle detour via Bolton Road or choose an alternative route earlier in your journey, such as via Heaths Road.

Thank you for your patience while we continue to work on this important project.

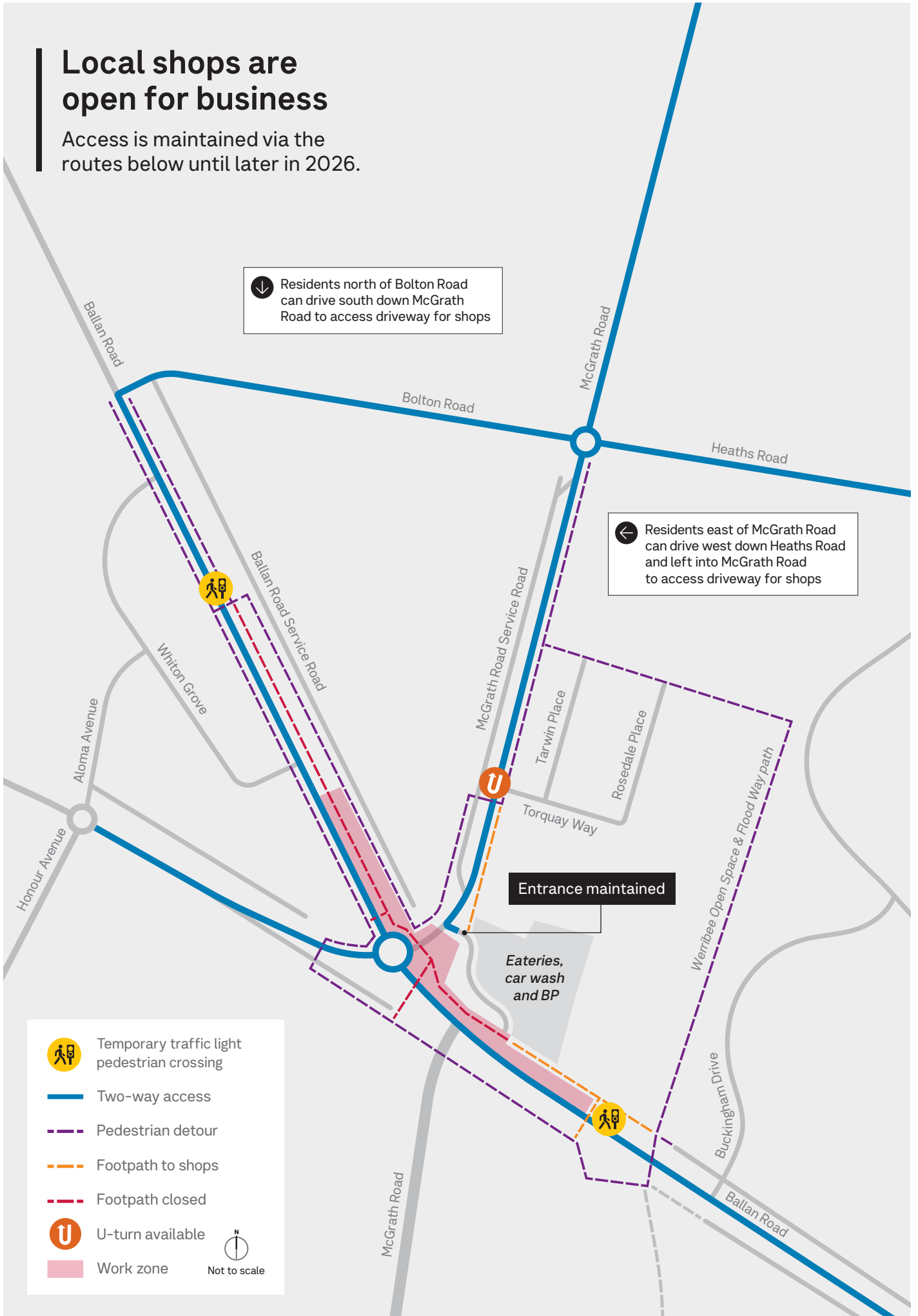


# Local shops are open for business

## Access to McGrath Road north shops has changed

You can now access the McGrath Road north shops, including the car and dog wash, eateries and service station, from the McGrath Road north shop driveway.

This entrance re-opened after being closed since late January while we completed underground works. The shop entrance on Ballan Road is now closed so we can continue building part of the new intersection near the existing driveway.

### Keep supporting your local shops

You can access them:

#### By car

- travel via McGrath Road north from Bolton Road or Heaths Road and enter via the re-opened driveway on McGrath Road north.

#### On foot

- walk along the McGrath Road north footpath and enter near Domino's.
- use the reopened footpath across the Werribee Open Space and Floodway and enter near KFC
- use the temporary push-button pedestrian crossing on Ballan Road.

A little sweetness, worth the detour. Open 7 days, day and night until 8pm.

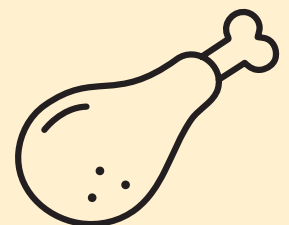
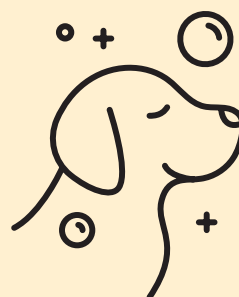
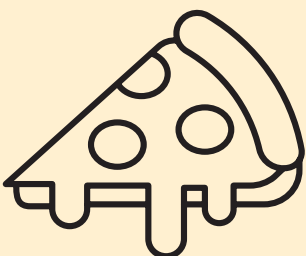
## KFC Wyndham Vale

## Future works

**From now until late 2026,** crews will continue working to complete the northern side of the intersection.

### From late 2026

We'll move the works area to the southern side of Ballan Road to begin stage 3. For this stage we will close Greens Road and McGrath Road south at Ballan Road while we build the southern side of the new intersection.

More details will be shared closer to the time.

### By mid-2027

The new intersection will be operational, including the new traffic lights, extra lanes and pedestrian crossings. There'll be minor finishing works around the intersection.
