## Reinstatement and rectification works

### A'Beckett Street, Stewart Street, Franklin Street and Swanston Street

Monday 20 April – Wednesday 27 May 2026

Reinstatement and rectification works will be carried out in A'Beckett Street, Stewart Street, Franklin Street and Swanston Street between Monday 20 April – Wednesday 27 May 2026.



#### When we'll be working

- 7am – 4pm, Monday 20 April – Wednesday 27 May 2026.
- 1am – 5am, Tuesday 21 – Thursday 23 April 2026

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

#### Stewart Street works

- Monday 20 April – Wednesday 29 April 2026, 7am – 4pm

#### What we'll be doing

- Removing existing road surface
- Laying asphalt to form a new road surface
- Reinstating kerbing
- Removing pram crossings.

#### What to be aware of

- Profiling, asphaltting and kerbing works are expected to produce medium to high levels of noise and some vibrations
- To safely carry out these works, Stewart Street will be closed between 7am and 4pm
- Vehicles will be able to access A'Beckett Street and Franklin Street from Elizabeth Street and Swanston Street
- Stewart Street will be reopened overnight from 4pm to 7am for through access from Franklin Street to A'Beckett Street
- Footpath access will be maintained however footpath crossings will not be accessible
- Traffic controllers will be on site to assist with vehicle and pedestrian movements.

#### Swanston Street works, near A'Beckett Street

- Tuesday, 21 – Thursday 23 April 2026, 1am – 5am

#### What we'll be doing

- Concrete block modification.

#### What to be aware of

- These works are expected to produce medium levels of noise with intermittent high levels of noise
- Road closure on Swanston Street near A'Beckett Street
- Vehicles requiring access to A'Beckett Street via Swanston Street will be detoured via Little La Trobe Street and Elizabeth Street.

### A'Beckett Street and the corner of Stewart Street works

- Thursday 30 April – Tuesday 12 May 2026, 7am – 4pm
- Please note these works may commence earlier depending on the completion of works at Stewart Street.

#### What we'll be doing

- Removing footpath surface
- Installing new concrete drainage pits
- Laying asphalt to form a new footpath surface
- Reinstating kerbing.

#### What to be aware of

- Asphaltting and kerbing works are expected to produce medium levels of noise
- To safely carry out these works, the footpath on the southern side of A'Beckett Street between Swanston Street and Elizabeth Street will be closed between 7am and 4pm
- Pedestrians will be detoured over to the northern side of A'Beckett Street
- Access to businesses and properties will be maintained by the site team
- Traffic controllers will be on site to assist with pedestrian movements.

### A'Beckett Street works

- Wednesday 13 May – Friday 22 May 2026, 7am – 4pm
- Please note these works may commence earlier depending on the completion of works at A'Beckett Street and Stewart Street.

#### What we'll be doing

- Removing footpath surface
- Laying asphalt to form a new footpath surface
- Reinstating kerbing
- Foot path paver removal.

#### What to be aware of

- Asphaltting and kerbing works are expected to produce medium levels of noise
- To safely carry out these works, the footpath on the southern side of A'Beckett Street between Swanston Street and Elizabeth Street will be closed between 7am and 4pm
- Pedestrians will be detoured to the northern side of A'Beckett Street
- Access to businesses and properties will be maintained.
- Traffic controllers will be on site to assist with pedestrian movements.

### Franklin Street works

- Monday 25 May – Wednesday 27 May 2026, 7am – 4pm

- Please note these works may commence earlier depending on the completion of works at A'Beckett Street.

#### What we'll be doing

- Removing footpath surface
- Laying asphalt to form a new footpath surface
- Reinstating kerbing.

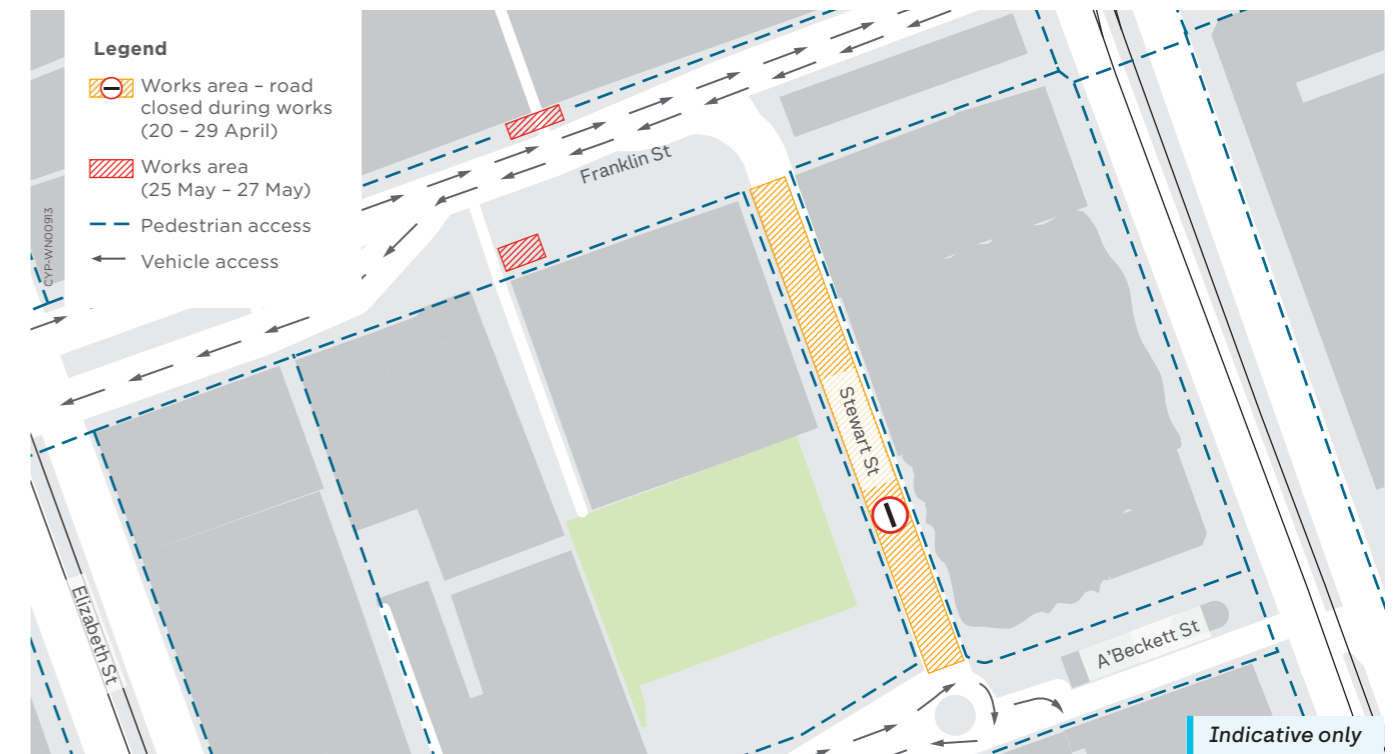
#### What to be aware of

- Traffic controllers will be on site to assist with pedestrian movements.

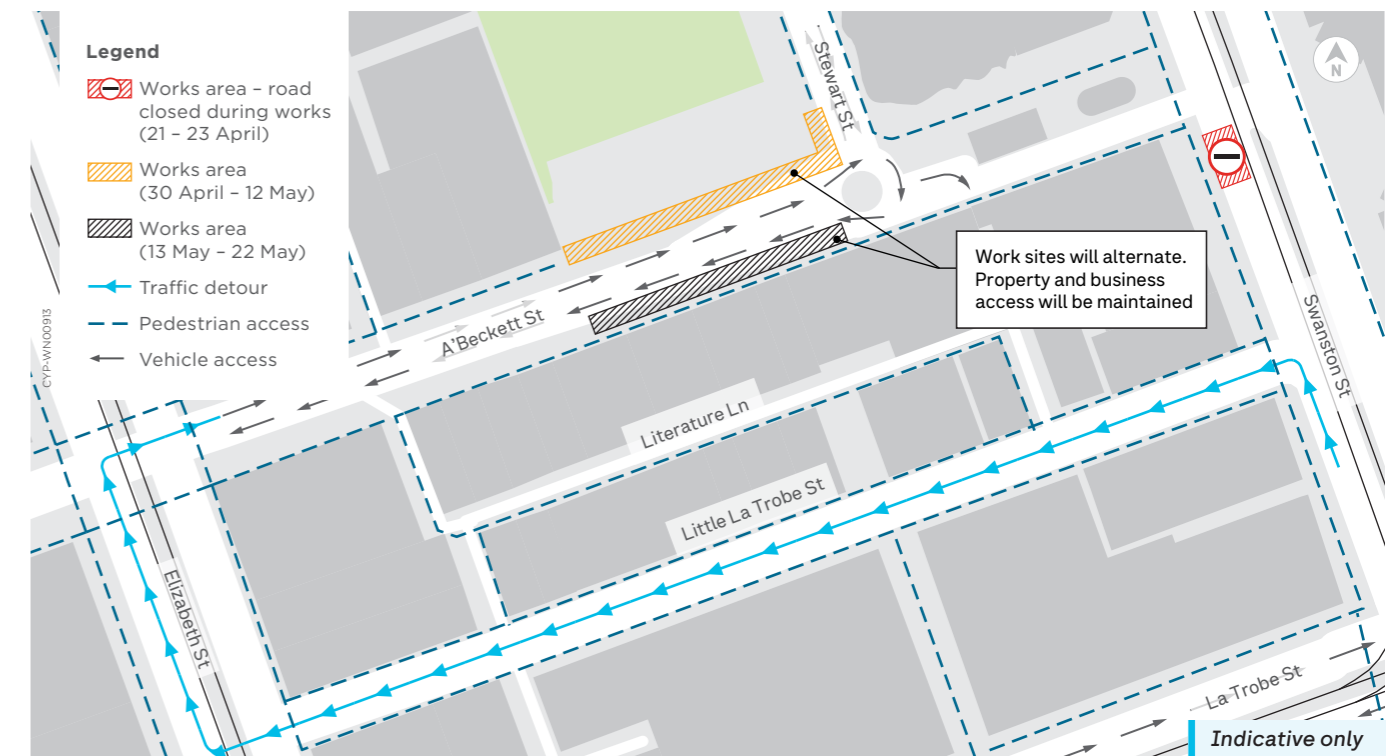

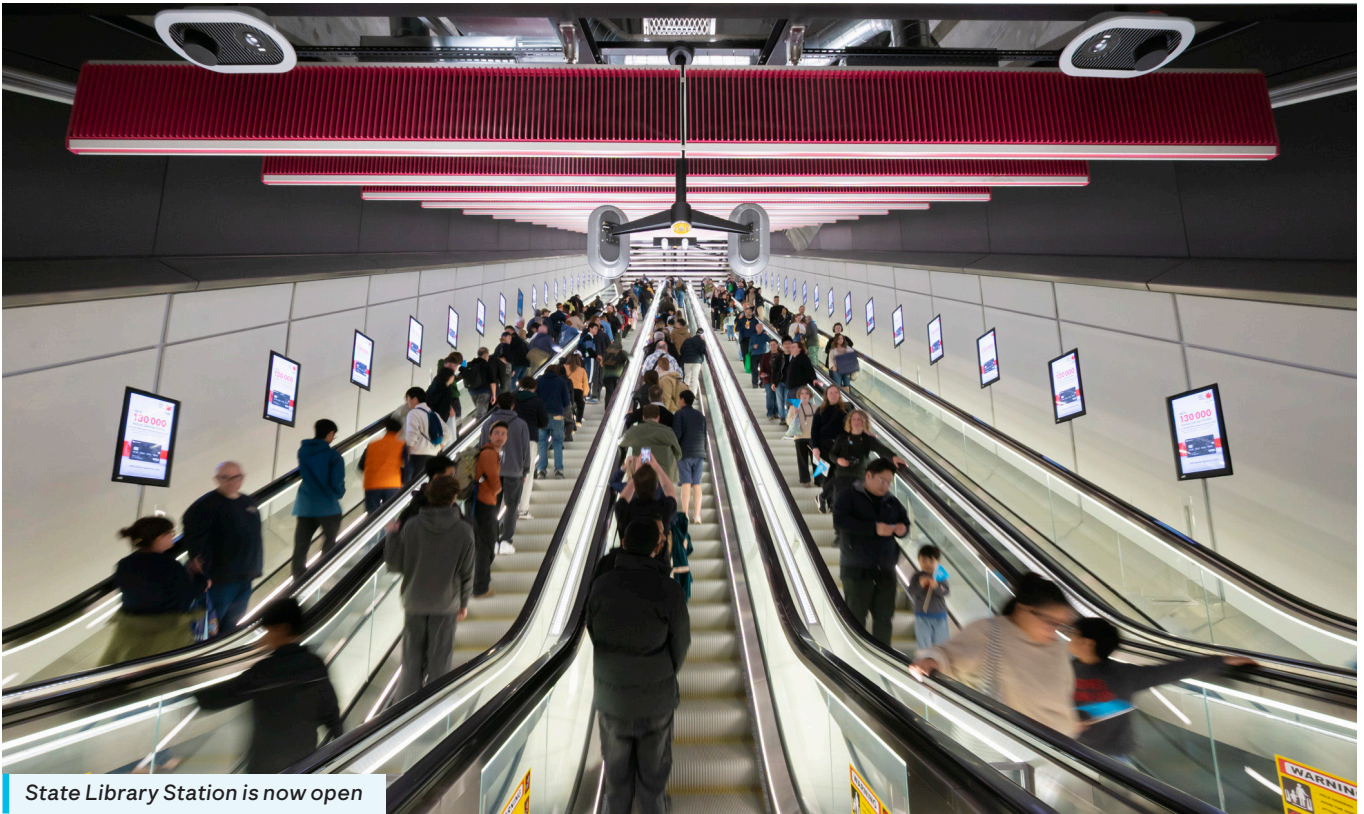
