

# Works notification

## Day/night works

### Water main construction works at Carron Street, North Balwyn and Estelle Street, Bulleen

We're moving close to 100 above and underground services such as power, water, gas, sewerage and telecommunications to make way for North East Link.

From **Tuesday 4 May** until **late 2021** we will be relocating two water mains to make way for the North East Link. This will involve using a micro Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) at Carron Street, Balwyn North.

#### What we'll be doing

These works include:

- Construction of a laydown area at Estelle Street.
- Installation of site fencing, traffic barriers and site amenities at Estelle Street.
- Construction of launch and retrieval shafts involving heavy machinery such as excavators, concrete mixers and tip trucks for soil removal.
- Boring works underneath the Freeway using a micro Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) to install the new water pipes.
- Trenching works for pipe laying near Carron Street and along Estelle Street.
- Reinstatement works including asphaltting and landscaping works following construction.

#### When are we working

##### Carron Street work zone

**Day works:** from **Tuesday 4 May** until **late 2021**

**Night works:** from **Thursday 6 May** until **late June**.

Night works include:

- Shaft excavation: 2 weeks
- Tunnelling works: 4 weeks
- Water pipe installation: 2 weeks

Working hours: **7am to 7pm**, Monday to Friday

**7am to 1pm**, Saturday

**7pm to 7am**, Sunday to Thursday

##### Estelle Street work zone

**Day works:** from **Tuesday 4 May** until **late 2021**

Working hours: **7am to 6pm**, Monday to Friday

**7am to 1pm**, Saturday

#### What to expect

During these works you may notice:

- Work crews in the area.
- Noise from machinery and equipment.
- Daytime truck movements with deliveries of materials and construction equipment.
- Traffic management in the area.
- A pedestrian and cyclist detour will be in place on Estelle Street to safely divert users around the works. Please refer to the map on the back for the details on the shared user path detour.

CPB Contractors are committed to minimising construction impacts for residents and the community and will implement the following mitigation measures where appropriate:

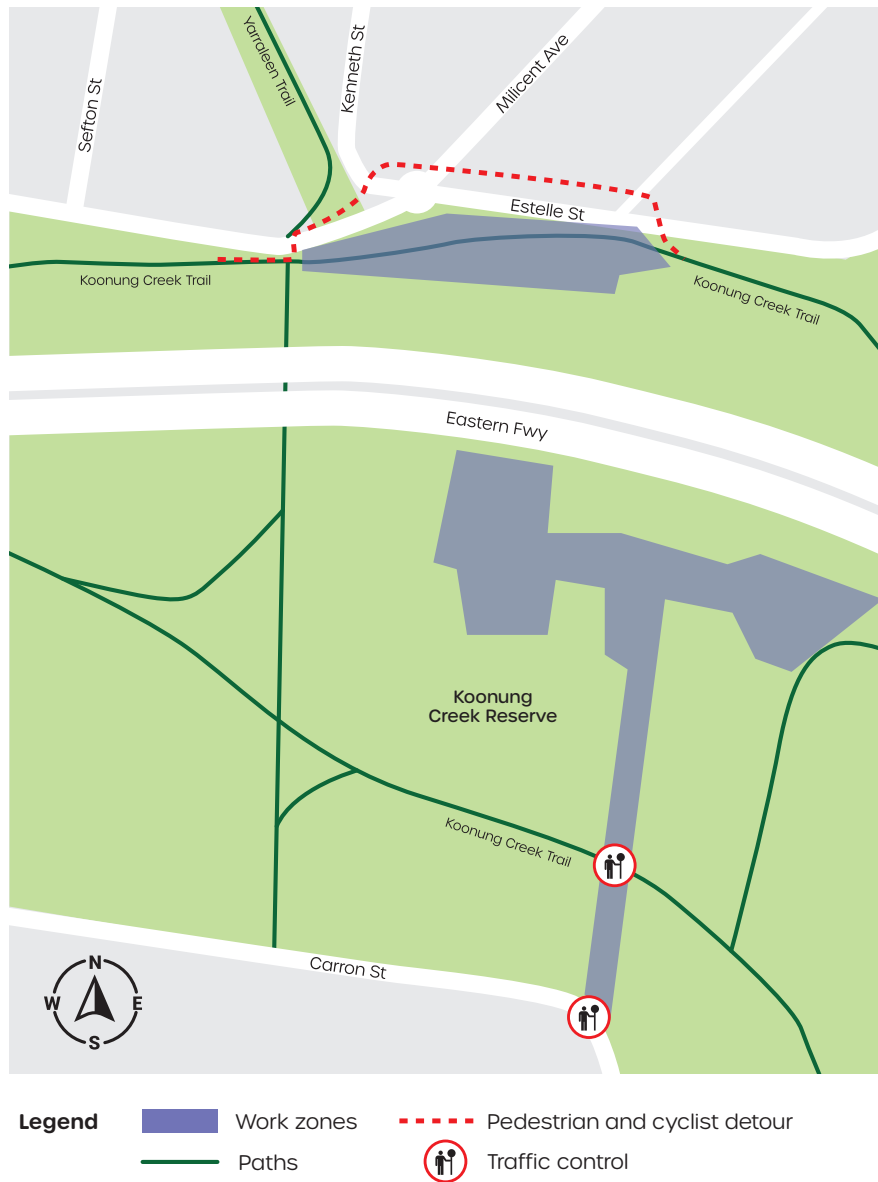
- Noise control equipment and sound blankets may be used on machinery and tools.
