# Important information

## Underpass entrance works and overnight intersection closure

Evans Street, Sunbury

**27 to 30 September 2022**

Major construction is continuing on the Gap Road Level Crossing Removal Project. We wish to advise of upcoming road works at the intersection of Evans and Station streets.

### What we are doing

- Conducting works on the Evans Street intersection and on the east entrance to the new road underpass
- Resurfacing sections of the road near the intersection
- Removing the top layer and asphaltting to level the road and provide a sleek finish
- Line marking
- Installing new traffic signaling technology
- Repositioning two light poles on Evans Street
- Works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and vibration, with intermittent periods of high-level noise.

### What to be aware of

- From 7pm to 6am each night, the Evans and Station streets intersection will be closed to vehicles and cyclists. Detours will be in place
- From 6am each day the intersection will reopen and through traffic will be maintained
- Please follow signage and direction from traffic controllers as you move through the area.

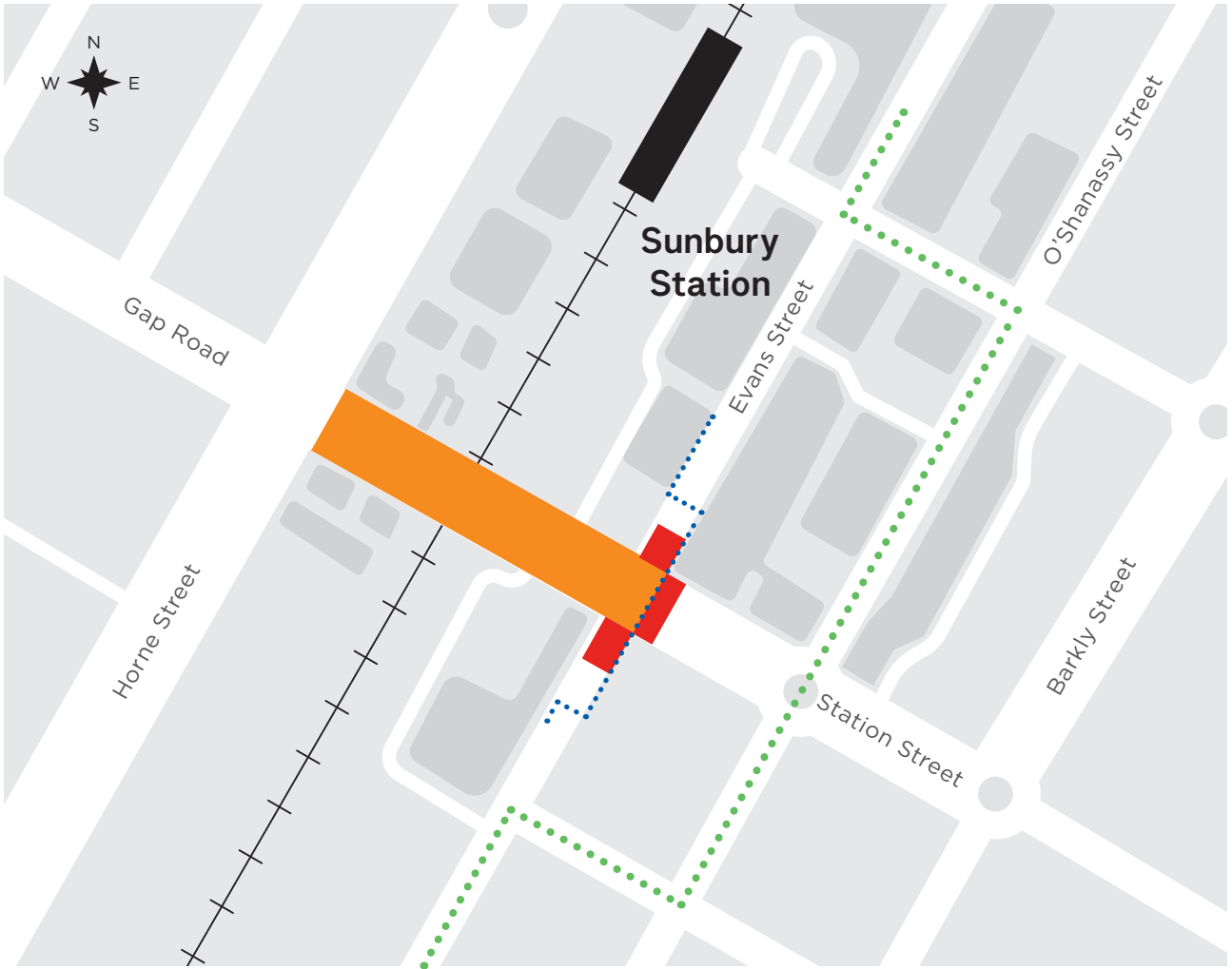
#### Full intersection closure and overnight works
