

Monthly construction update

Domain precinct

July 2023

Works to construct the Metro Tunnel's Anzac Station are progressing. This update provides an outline of current and upcoming works in your area in July.

In July, works will continue on legacy public realm elements including the construction of the Albert Road linear park, St Kilda Road's medians, kerbs and bike lanes.

Construction snapshot

Construction works within the Anzac Station precinct during July 2023 include:

- Kerb and footpath works
- Station entrance construction
- Albert Road construction
- Bowen Lane to Bowen Crescent utility connections
- St Kilda Road median works
- Station box construction and fit out
- Tram infrastructure works.

Works in your area

Kerb and footpath work

St Kilda Road, between Park Street and Albert Road Ongoing until Mid-July 2023

- Finishing works will continue in July on the bluestone footpath between Park Street and Albert Road. A pedestrian detour will be in place for the duration of these works
- Pedestrian access, including access to the Hallmark Building and Domain Hill apartments, will be maintained during these works
- From Monday 24 July until Friday 28 July, the new street lighting will be installed on the northern corner of Albert Road and St Kilda Road. These works must take place at night while St Kilda Road is closed and trams aren't running
- All other works will be carried out during standard construction hours.

Station entrance construction - Albert Road Reserve

Albert Road Reserve and Albert Road Ongoing – 2024



- Waterproofing of the entrance is now complete. Works to construct the elevators and escalators continue
- Steel tying and concrete pours will continue in July. There will be some works taking place out of hours that are expected to cause light and noise. You can also expect light from the light towers to ensure the crews can work safely at night. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light by using hand tools and directing lights away from residential properties where possible
- For one night in July, the concrete barriers along the St Kilda Road side of the site will be adjusted. This work must take place at night while St Kilda Road is closed.

Albert Road construction

Albert Road

Ongoing - 2024



- Completing construction on the final alignment of Albert Road between Kings Way and St Kilda Road. This includes construction for the final drainage, kerb, roadway, separated bike lanes and linear park
- Pedestrian and vehicle movements will change at times in July. Please follow signage and direction from traffic controllers
- Works will be carried out during standard construction hours. However some night works, such as barrier removal and line marking, will take place to prepare for the next stage of works.

Bowen Lane to Bowen Crescent utility connections

St Kilda Road

Ongoing - August 2023

- Fit out and completion works of the chiller structure will continue in July
- The 'delayed strip pour' is now complete. Works to construct the southern access hatch are underway
- In July, works will continue to install and commission the final gas, water and electricity connections underneath St Kilda Road and Bowen Lane
- There will be pedestrian diversions around the site. Access to buildings on St Kilda Road will be maintained
- In July, pedestrian access to St Kilda Road from Bowen Lane will be closed for up to a week
- There will be 24 hour works from 11 to 25 July on the corner of Bowen Crescent and St Kilda Road as we trench across to connect utilities. These works must take place at night while the St Kilda Road northbound lane is closed.

St Kilda Road median works - North

St Kilda Road, between Park Street and Dorcas Street

Ongoing throughout 2023

- Final works to the kerb, roadway and pedestrian crossing at the north-west corner of Park Street and St Kilda Road, in front of 380 St Kilda Road will continue until mid-July. Once completed, pedestrian access will be reopened at the Park Street crossing
- Works will continue on the installation of drainage, road surface and construction of the new concrete bike separators in this area
- There will be some overnight works required to reopen the road such as barrier moving and line marking.


St Kilda Road median works - South

St Kilda Road, between Bowen Crescent and Toorak Road *Ongoing throughout 2023*



- Construction on the inner southbound carriageway of St Kilda Road will continue in July
- Works to construct the new separated bike lanes on the northbound lane of St Kilda Road, between Toorak Road and Bowen Crescent, will commence on 11 July. This will require the permanent removal of parking along this section of St Kilda Road. These works involve non-destructive digging, saw cutting, excavation and installation of conduits
- The second stage of parking removal on the southbound side of St Kilda Road will be in effect from mid-July to allow construction of the drainage and separated bike lanes
- In July, one tree will be removed in the median in front of the Royce Hotel
- Works to set up the construction areas will take place at night to minimise traffic impacts. These works include asphalting, placing barriers and line marking.

Station entrance construction – Shrine of Remembrance

Domain Road

Ongoing

- Works have commenced on the internal fit out of the station entrance
- Works under the station roof will continue overnight.

Tram infrastructure works

Toorak Road to Dorcas Street

24 July - 29 July 2023

- In July, lights will be installed on the poles in the tram corridor
- These works will require the use of a crane to place new lights and hand tools to install
- These works must take place at night while trams are not running.

Station box construction and fit out

Concourse and platform level of station box

Ongoing



- Commissioning of the lifts and elevators is underway.
 Overnight works are also taking place to test the newly installed platform screen doors
- Flooring installation and wall painting continue
- Mechanical, electrical and plumbing works continue in the southern and northern ends of the station box
- Plant and HV equipment continue to be installed in back-of-house rooms
- Work will continue on the installation of architectural features and lighting on both the platform and concourse levels
- Precast elements for the platform, exhaust ductwork and station fit out will continue to be delivered and lowered into the station box from 7am until 10pm weekdays, and from 7am until 6pm on Saturdays, using the crane near Domain Road
- Works on the tram stop shelter continue in July, during these works Myki top up is unavailable.

Traffic and transport impacts

Oversized deliveries

 While most deliveries to the Anzac Station site will occur during normal hours, some deliveries to and from site that are classified as 'oversized' will be required outside of normal working hours and overnight. Whenever oversized deliveries are expected overnight, crews will be reminded of noise requirements on site.

St Kilda Road median - North

- St Kilda Road traffic will remain in the inner carriageway between Park and Dorcas Streets until mid-July
- Kerbside parking on the outer northbound carriageway is temporarily closed in this section to facilitate the construction of the separated bike lanes.

North-west corner of St Kilda Road and Park Street

- Works on the north-west corner of St Kilda Road and Park Street in front of 380 St Kilda Road require the closure of Park Street eastbound. During this closure, access to the outer carriageway (service lane) will be via a temporary two-way arrangement from Dorcas Street
- Egress from the service lane will be limited to a left turn onto Dorcas Street
- City bound bicycle traffic will be diverted into the inner carriageway
- The pedestrian crossing over Park Street will be closed during these works, with pedestrians detoured to cross Park Street at the Wells Street intersection
- The pedestrian crossing over St Kilda Road at Park Street will also be closed during these works, with the nearest crossing point at Dorcas Street
- These changes are expected to be in place until mid-July.

St Kilda Road median - South

- We're completing construction of St Kilda Road medians south of Bowen Crescent. To build to the final drainage alignment and separated bike paths, from 11 July we'll remove parking on:
 - St Kilda Road, from Bromby Street to Toorak Road
 - St Kilda Road, from Toorak Road to Bowen Crescent

- To facilitate these works, we will close the slow lane in July with some traffic changes in effect from Arthur Street
- The right turn from St Kilda Road onto Kings Way remains closed
- There will be some changes to the St Kilda Road pedestrian crossing at Toorak Road to complete works in this section. Traffic controllers will be in place while any detours are in effect.

Albert Road construction

- Parking on the southern side of Albert Road has been permanently removed
- Albert Road is currently one way from Kings Way to St Kilda Road, which will be in place until mid-August
- In August, Albert Road will close at the northern end onto St Kilda Road to allow for the construction of the road surface. More information will be provided closer to the date.

Park Street to Albert Road

 A temporary pedestrian detour will remain in place while footpath works are underway in this section. Access to buildings will be maintained.

St Kilda Road - Northbound closure

 The northbound lane of St Kilda Road will be closed between 8pm to 5am each night for two weeks in July. Local access will be maintained via detour routes through local roads. We'll provide you with more information closer to our date of works.

Bowen Lane

- Utility works require a closure of Bowen Lane for up to three months. Pedestrian detours are in place
- For up to one week in July, pedestrian access from Bowen Lane to St Kilda Road will be unavailable.

Kings Way - left (slow) lane closure

- The one-month closure of the southbound left (slow) lane of Kings Way between Dorcas Street and Toorak Road will be in place until mid-July. This left (slow) lane closure will enable the construction of the new kerb adjacent to Kings Way. Access and egress from Albert Road to Kings Way will be maintained during the works
- Traffic signage will be in place ahead of the closure.

Permanent parking changes -St Kilda Road

- As part of the Development Plan for Anzac Station, we're building new kerbside bike lanes that separate drivers and cyclists to make St Kilda Road safer, and improve cycling connections to Kings Way and beyond.
- To build these kerbside bike lanes and legacy drainage we're permanently removing on-street parking, between Bromby Street and Toorak Road and Toorak Road and Bowen Crescent, from 10 July 2023.
- Please also expect some changes to traffic, access and disruption while we work. We'll keep you updated of specific changes closer to our date of works.


