

MANAGING CONSTRUCTION NOISE AND VIBRATION

We're minimising construction impacts on local communities and the environment

We're building a second Murray River crossing to connect Echuca and Moama making it quicker and easier for you to travel across the Campaspe and Murray rivers.

As part of the largest transport infrastructure project in northern Victoria, Major Road Projects Victoria and Transport for NSW are working together to deliver the Echuca–Moama Bridge Project.

Managing noise

Noise from construction will vary, depending on the type of activity being undertaken. If you're close to our works, you may notice increased noise levels at times. Before we started major works, we engaged acoustic engineers who provided us with background noise levels. We've used this data to plan our construction activities.

We're minimising noise impacts during construction by:



Using quieter reversing alarms on our vehicles and machines



Maintaining our machines in good working order



Providing you with advance notice of any noisy or outof-hours work



Reducing noise and vibration impacts as

much as possible

We'll carry out most of our works

during the day:

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays ٠

There may be times when we need to work outside of these hours, but we'll let you know in advance if this needs to happen.

Managing vibration

Vibration may be caused by machinery such as excavators, graders, rollers and piling rigs. We've carefully planned all activities to ensure the safety of the community.

We'll be monitoring vibration to ensure impacts are kept to a minimum.

Monitoring construction noise and vibration

We've undertaken noise and vibration monitoring at key locations in Echuca and Moama prior to construction.

We use this information to help us continually monitor and manage any noise and vibration to ensure we're minimising impacts and complying with the relevant guidelines.
