- Applications closed on Monday 8 August at 3pm with a total of 42 applications.

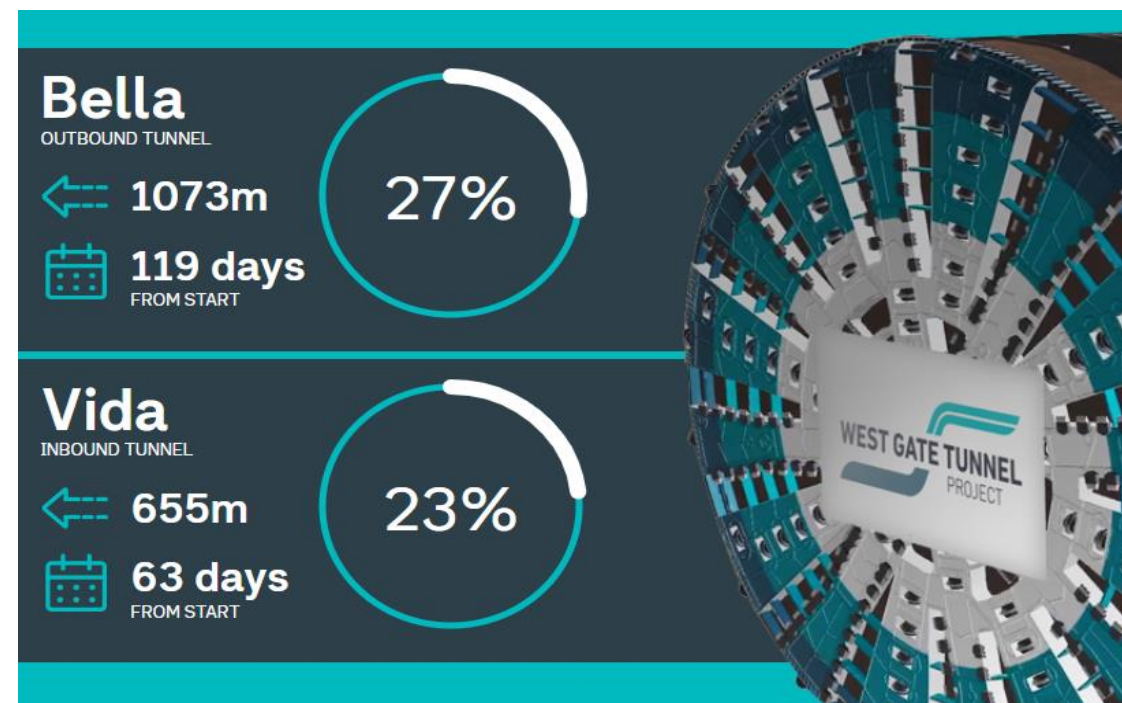

# West Community Engagement Update

## Notifications

- Backyard planting program

## Engagement

- Engagement with Grieve Parade business ahead of road works

## Closures

- Grieve Parade outbound exit ramp – closed 16 days, 9pm Friday 29 July to 5am Monday 15 August 2022
- Fogarty Avenue / The Avenue – Full 24/7 two-way closure – 11 August (night), 12 August & 13 August (night) & 23 August – 08 September (day & night), Shuttle Flow: 23 June – 31 August 2022 (Hockey Club to Wembley Ave),

# Backyard Planting Program

- The Backyard Planting Program launched on 25 July. Eligible local residents impacted by the project will receive tube stock or vouchers to a local nursery to enhance their backyards.
- Pop-up information dates:
  - Friday 12 August: Footscray Hockey Centre / Fogarty Ave
  - Monday 15 August: Railway Place / Millers St Reserve
  - Wednesday 17 August: Brooklyn Reserve
  - Wednesday 31 August: Info Centre

# Millers Road spring campaign

- **9-week campaign with 3 stages**
  - Stage 1: Millers Road inbound entry ramp & incident response area
  - Stage 2: Millers Road outbound entry ramp, inbound exit ramp & Paringa Road
  - Stage 3: Millers Road outbound entry ramp, inbound exit ramp, Paringa Road & Primula Avenue
- Required to finish significant works at Millers Road, including Paringa Road access reinstatement and new walking and cycling paths.
- Works will require various road and lane closures of Millers Road, freeway ramp closures at Millers Road and short-term closures of local roads including Primula and Paringa roads.

# East Community Engagement Update

## Notifications

- To businesses along Maribyrnong Street – Girder Laydown Area & Works
- For works to build the new cycling and walking bridge across Moonee Ponds Creek.

## Engagement

- Door knocked business along Maribyrnong Street around trees removal
- Engagement has started with businesses along Maribyrnong Street ahead of the occupation of the street and parking spots scheduled for September.

## Closures

- Maribyrnong River - Intermittent full river closures are occurring for July through to end of September, to ensure the safety of river users during construction of the onramp and offramp bridges.
- Footscray Road - Multiple full weekend carriageway, and weeknight overnight, closures in both directions between Market Gate entrance and Appleton Dock Road proposed between August and December 2022.



# Dynon Road

Works have commenced within the rail corridor underneath the Dynon Road Bridge, near North Melbourne station.

These works include the installation of precast concrete piers, which will form part of the new Shared User Path bridge to run separate to Dynon Road Bridge.



# Footscray Road



- Gantry changed direction on Wednesday 27 July and is heading back east along Footscray Road to construct the inbound carriageway
- Our gantry crane will place almost 1600 segments into place over a two-year period.
- Minister for Transport Infrastructure – the Hon. Jacinta Allan MP visit the East Zone to mark the Launching Gantry’s switch to the eastbound carriageway of the elevated Footscray Road.

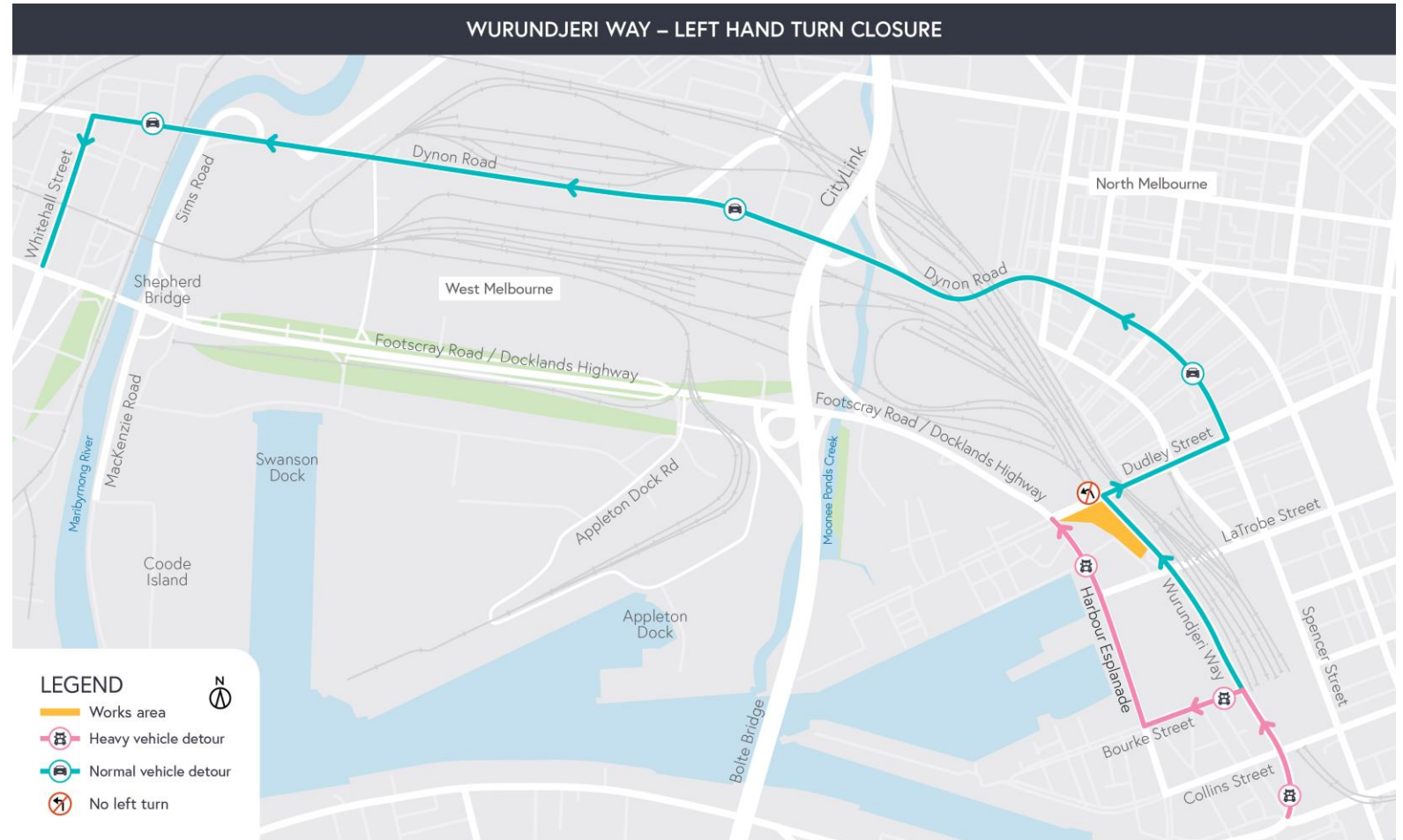
# Moonee Ponds Creek

- From August 2022 we are starting work to build the new cycling and walking bridge across Moonee Ponds Creek.
- A temporary work sites will be established on each side of the bridge, allowing us to widen lanes and build the new bridge.
- Temporary work sites will include cranes, storage facilities, work sheds and machinery. This required some tree and vegetation removal in the area.
- Once works are complete, replanting will be conducted taking on board feedback we have received from local community groups.



# Wurundjeri Way Extension

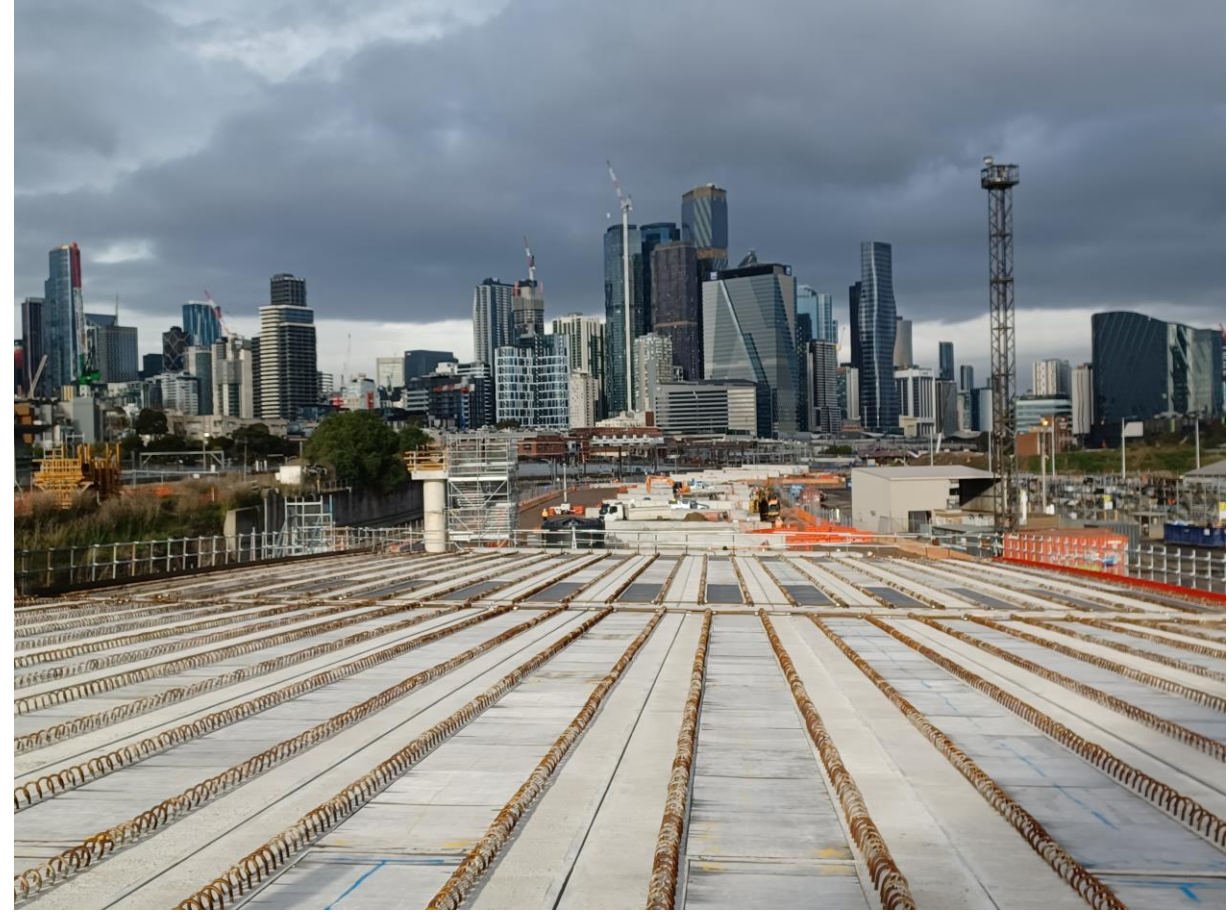
- Starting 18 August

- Over 175 notifications have been distributed advising of Vida approaching.

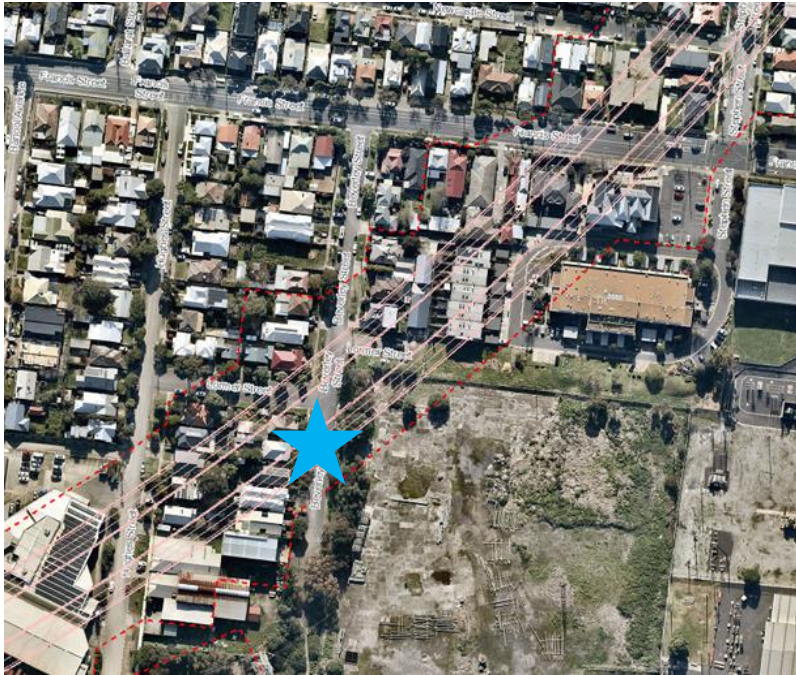
## Engagement

- 31 letterbox drops have been completed in the last two weeks.
- Installed noise and vibration monitors in 5 properties along the tunnel alignment.
- One location slightly exceeding 'disruptive' noise levels.
- Noise levels have been very close to the modelling completed prior to tunnelling.
- 16 tunnelling related enquiries through the call centre over the last month.



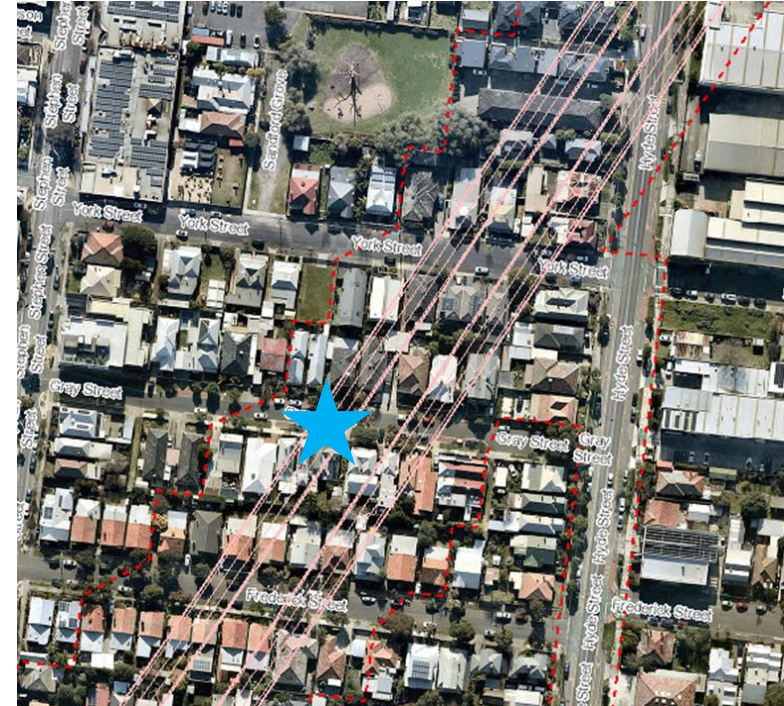
# Tunnelling progress

## BELLA



- Bella has bored approx 1300 metres of tunnel and is in the vicinity of Beverley Street and running according to schedule.

## VIDA



- Vida has bored over 850 metres of tunnel, currently under Yarraville residential properties and running according to schedule.

- End Construction Southern Portal: Q1 2025

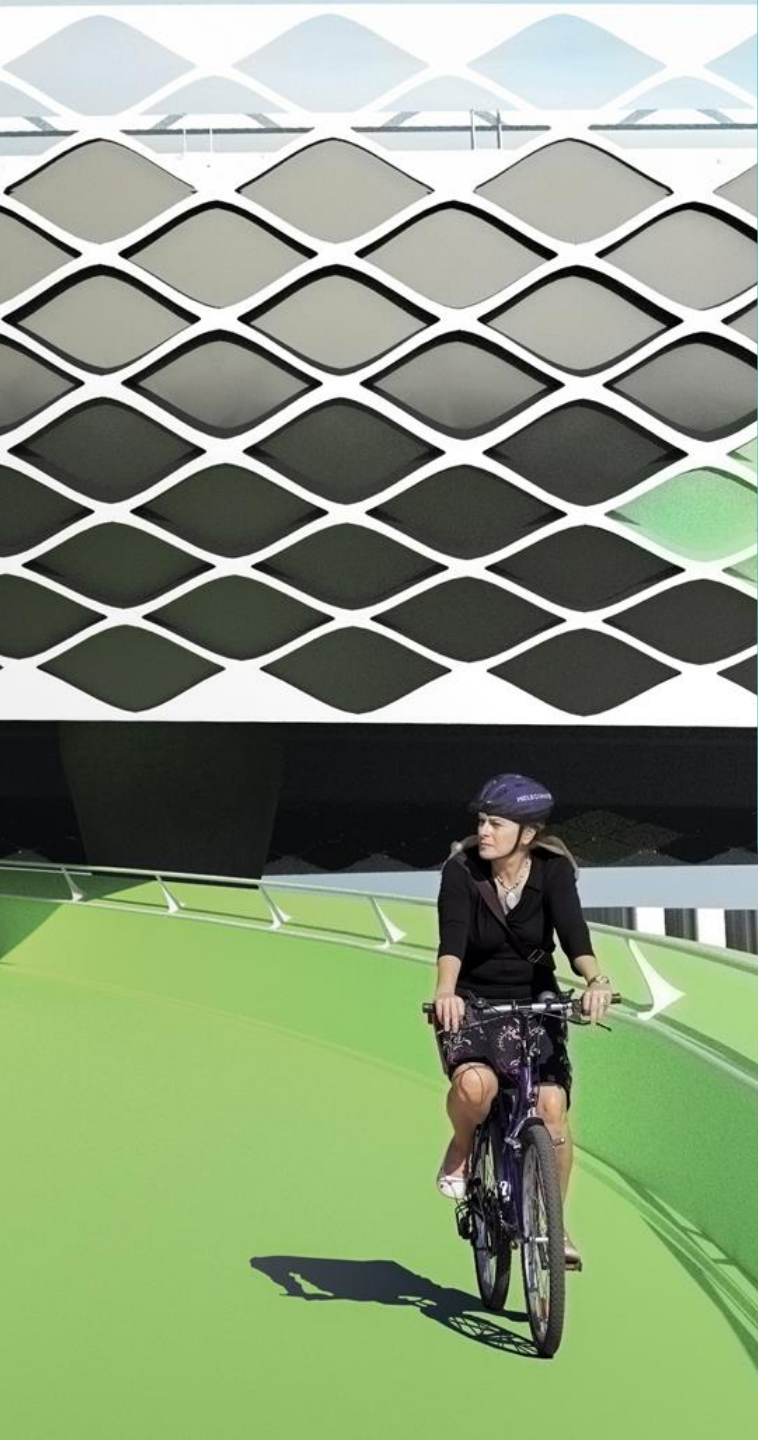
