

Works notice

Water main installation works

Southeast corner of Elizabeth and Grattan streets, Parkville

20 April to late May 2023

As part of water main installation works taking place across the Parkville Station's Grattan Street east site, works are required on the southeast corner of Elizabeth and Grattan streets in April and May 2023.

What we are doing

- Establishing a site on the eastern Elizabeth Street footpath using temporary fencing
- Removing a section of the existing footpath using an excavator
- Installing the new water main infrastructure and connecting it to the existing network
- Reconstructing the section of footpath, which involves backfilling and asphaltting.

What to be aware of

- A minor pedestrian diversion will be in place on Elizabeth Street, west of the Doherty Institute
- Traffic control will be on site to manage the diversion during working hours
- Access to local buildings and businesses will be maintained at all times
- Emergency egress from The Doherty Institute will be maintained at all times
- The nearby southern Grattan Street footpath will remain open
- The Elizabeth Street southbound service lane, between Medical Road and Haymarket roundabout will be closed for up to two days in mid-May to complete the water main connection
- One loading bay on Elizabeth Street will be occupied during this period
- A 1-hour parking space further south on Elizabeth Street will be reallocated as a loading bay to offset this
- Traffic and cyclists will be diverted to the Royal Parade inner lane

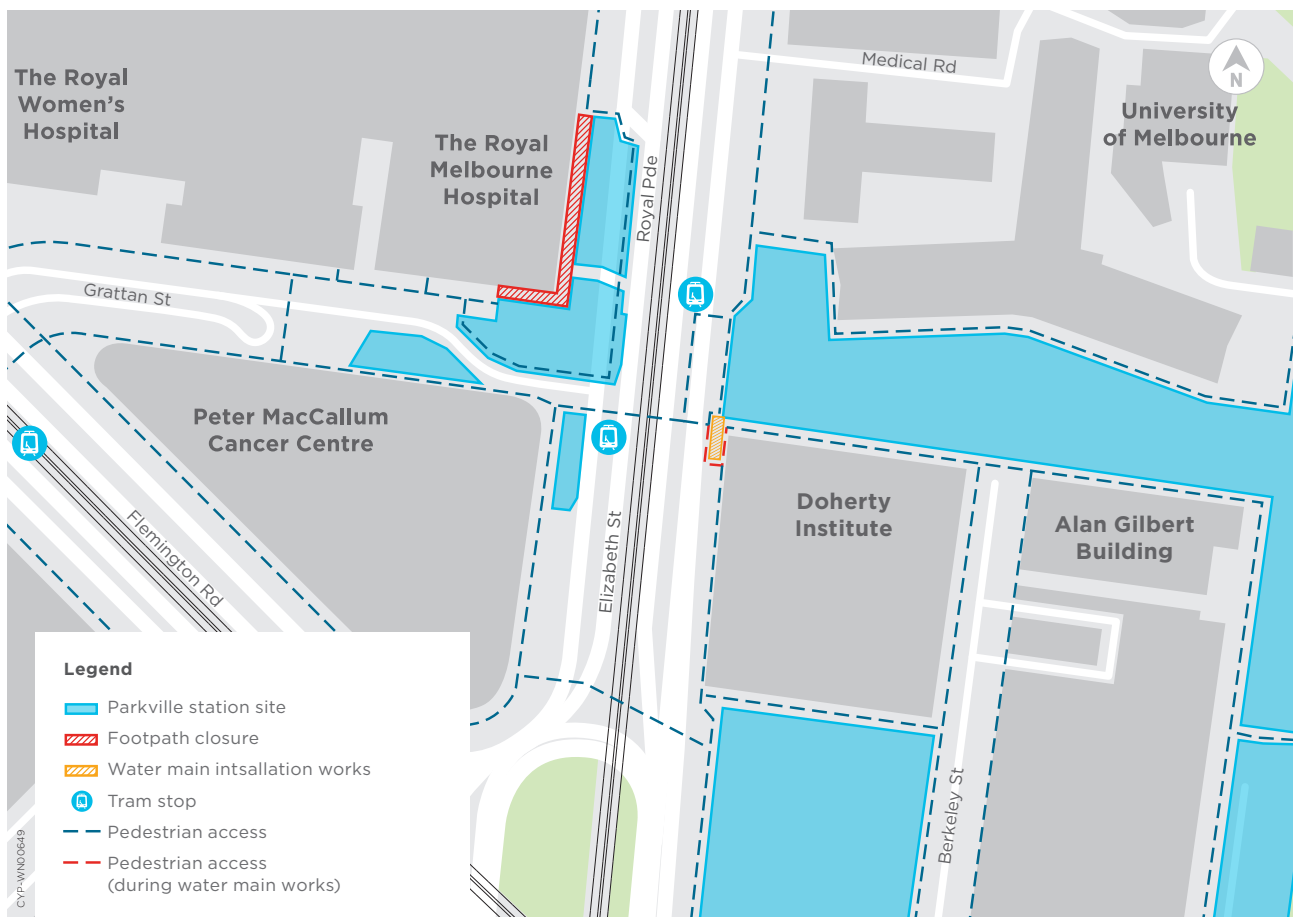
- These works are expected to generate periods of medium to high-level noise, depending on the work activity
- These works are weather dependent
- The traffic arrangement for these works is subject to change due to approvals by relevant authorities. Any significant changes will be communicated accordingly
- Water main installation works are ongoing across the Grattan Street east site. Separate notification will be provided for future water main works.

7am to 1pm, Saturdays.
