

# Works notice

## Overnight works to renew surface Kings Way and Albert Road intersection

**6pm Sunday 12 November to 6am Friday 17 November**

As part of the finishing works for the Metro Tunnel Project, the Kings Way and Albert Road intersection road surface and Albert Road lanes will be resurfaced. To minimise disruption to traffic at this critical intersection, works on Kings Way will take place overnight from Sunday 12 November to Friday 17 November when there is less traffic. Works on Albert Road will take place 24-hours a day.

### What we are doing

- Closing the eastbound lane of Albert Road 24-hours a day for the duration of these works between Kings Way and 50 Albert Road
- Closing the westbound lane of Albert Road from 6pm to 6am each night from Sunday 12 November to Wednesday 15 November
- Setting up a works area on the eastbound lane of Albert Road to support construction works
- Setting up traffic management from 6pm each night of works to close three lanes of traffic at a time on Kings Way
- Removing the existing road surface and laying new asphalt by using profilers, pavers, compaction rollers, Non-Destructive Digging (NDD), line marking machines
- Reopening all lanes along Kings Way at 5am each morning after works
- Working from 6pm to 6am, Sunday night until 6am Friday mornings

### What to be aware of

- Kings Way will be reduced to one lane heading away from the city between Park Street and Bowen Lane
- Albert Road eastbound lanes will be closed for the duration of these works at Kings Way and all access will be via St Kilda Road. Detours will be in place via Kings Way and St Kilda Road
- Albert Road eastbound and westbound lanes will be closed overnight at Kings Way and all access will be via St Kilda Road. Detours will be in place via Kings Way and St Kilda Road
- Local access to driveways and deliveries to business will be maintained at all times under the assistance of traffic controllers
- Pedestrian detours will be in place overnight at the Kings Way intersection. Pedestrians can move through the area with the assistance of traffic controllers
- At times, the parking on the northern side of Albert Road between Kings Way and 50 Albert Road will be unavailable
- These works are expected to generate periods of high levels of noise associated with removal of the existing road surface
- The works take place over five nights, from 6pm to 6am Sunday night to Friday morning.

### When

- Works along Albert Road will take place 24 hours a day from 6pm Sunday 12 November to 6am Friday 17 November
- Works along Kings Way will take place nightly from 6pm Sunday 12 November to 6am Friday 17 November
- Due to the nature of these works, progress may be impacted by weather conditions. We will let you know of any impacts to works and changes in times or dates

### How we're resurfacing the Kings Way and Albert Road intersection

The Kings Way and Albert Road intersection is a critical intersection in Melbourne's Road network, with 100,000 vehicles using the intersection each day. As part of the Metro Tunnel Project, we are renewing the road surface at this intersection to ensure smoother journeys for Melbourne's motorists.

In order to renew the road surface, crews will remove the existing surface using a profiler machine to scrape back the top layer of asphalt - these works can be noisy and you can expect higher levels of noise while the profiler machine is in use. Once the existing surface is removed crews will lay the new surface using asphaltting machines and rollers, and line mark to finish the road.

These works will take place along sections of the intersection, until the intersection has been resurfaced. To minimise disruption to the road network the works must take place at night, 6pm to 6am, Sunday nights to Friday mornings when there is less traffic.

### Resurfacing of key intersections in the area - St Kilda Road and Toorak Road intersection, late November to early December

As part of the finishing works for the Metro Tunnel Project we're also resurfacing the St Kilda Road and Toorak Road intersection in late November to early December 2023.
