

CAMERONS LANE INTERCHANGE AND MINTON STREET PLANNING STUDY



OCTOBER 2024

We're planning for a potential Camerons Lane Interchange at the Hume Freeway and undertaking a planning study for potential upgrades to Minton Street and Beveridge Road.

Overview

We're planning for a potential interchange at Camerons Lane and the Hume Freeway in Beveridge. The interchange would provide a direct connection from the Hume Freeway to the Beveridge Intermodal Freight Terminal, cater for the growing population and improve freeway access and safety.

We're also undertaking a planning study focused on Minton Street and Beveridge Road to determine if upgrades are needed to support the growth of the area and cater for future land use.

Status

A business case for the potential Camerons Lane Interchange is currently being developed.

Our planning work on behalf of the Australian Government will help to inform government decision-making.

To help inform the business case and planning study, we're completing traffic modelling, constructability assessments, economic modelling, community engagement and environmental investigations.

This work will allow us to understand potential environmental impacts, develop design options, and confirm scope and costs of different options.

Our planning is building on the previous development work undertaken by the Department of Transport and Planning (VicRoads). We're reviewing the technical studies and designs previously developed, and are using these to inform our planning. We're also considering any recent changes in the area, including population growth.
