## Town Hall Place — building above Town Hall Station





Before the Metro Tunnel opens in 2025, Lendlease will start building a multi-level development – often referred to as an over station development (OSD) – above the new Town Hall Station.


This development, called 'Town Hall Place', will offer a range of tenancies and new public meeting places, and will provide train passengers access into Town Hall Station below.

## Key points about Town Hall Place

- Town Hall Place will be located above the Metro Tunnel's underground Town Hall Station at 5-25 Swanston Street. It will front onto both Swanston and Flinders streets.
- It will be developed and built by construction company Lendlease.
- Town Hall Place is a separate construction project to the Metro Tunnel Project and is subject to its own planning process and approvals.
- Town Hall Place will be
  10-storeys high, similar in height to its neighbouring buildings.

- Town Hall Place will be a mixed-use building with new laneways, arcades, retail outlets, hospitality businesses, office spaces and public meeting places.
- When finished, it will have five entrances including off Swanston Street, Flinders Street, Cocker Alley and Scott Alley.
- The Metro Tunnel Project will handover the site to Lendlease, prior to the opening of the Metro Tunnel in 2025.
- Lendlease expects to complete construction of Town Hall Place in the second half of 2026.
- This means construction will continue at the site after the Metro Tunnel opens.
