Construction update



- Final defect rectification works are almost complete
- Train testing and commissioning activities are ongoing
- Station infrastructure will remain fenced off until Day 1
- Site office will be removed in 2025, before Day 1 operations
- CYP has handed all other sections of land back to VicTrack



Laurens Street pedestrian crossing



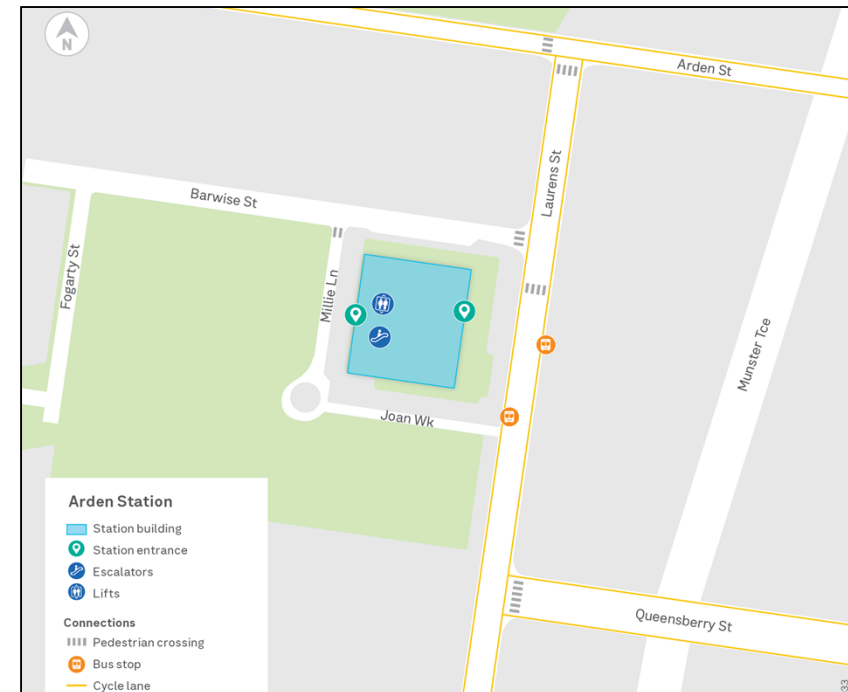
- The Laurens Street pedestrian crossing has now been signalised
- All permanent traffic signals in the precinct are now in operation



Internal road names



- Two new internal lanes bordering the Arden Station entrance were given the working names Laurens and Station lanes
- Lanes will be used for station operations such as deliveries, maintenance, emergency services and by pedestrians
- New road names must adhere to Geographical Names Victoria's naming principles, include not duplicating or sounding similar to roads within 5kms, not putting public safety at risk and not discriminating or causing offense.
- The roads have been named **Millie Lane** and **Joan Walk**
- Named after MTP tunnel boring machines, which were named after significant women:
 - Millie Peacock, Victoria's first female MP
 - Joan Kirner, Victoria's first female Premier
- Names were gazetted in August 2024.

North Melbourne Intake Substation



- Installation of fencing adjacent to Moonee Ponds Creek shared path is now complete
- Majority of planting has been completed, with additional species to be planted in future seasons

Construction update



- The permanent power connection for traffic and street lights at Grattan Street East is complete
- The power connection for traffic and street lights at Grattan Street West is pending authority processes and documentation approval
- Station fit-out, minor finishing works, defect rectification, and handback processes are ongoing
- Train testing and commissioning activities are ongoing.

Barry Street and University Square reinstatement works



- Works have commenced to reinstate Barry Street and the northern section of University Square
- These works will include excavation and utilities, tie-in to existing surfaces, kerbs, paving, construction of retaining and terrace walls, ramps, stairs, and tree planter boxes
- These works will occur both day and night
- The works are anticipated to be completed later this year.
