

# Works notice



## Out of hours works

### Joseph Road, Footscray

Monday 29 June to 31 July 2026

As part of completion works for the Metro Tunnel Project, workers will require 24-hour access into the rail corridor via Joseph Road to deliver materials to work sites while trains are not running.



#### When we'll be working

##### Equipment and material deliveries:

- We'll be working from **7am to 6pm, Monday 29 June to Friday 31 July 2026**

##### Rail corridor access and works:

- We'll be working **24/7 from 11pm, Tuesday 7 July to 4am Monday 13 July 2026**

We'll let you know of any changes to timing of works ahead of time.

Please note works may be rescheduled due to inclement weather.

#### What we'll be doing

- Delivering rail equipment and materials to the laydown area at Joseph Road during normal working hours
- Delivering rail equipment and materials via the Joseph Road rail access point to work sites along the rail corridor between North Melbourne and Footscray stations during 24-hour rail corridor works
- 24-hour rail corridor works including removing redundant rail infrastructure and assets and installing rail infrastructure including drainage and cables routes.

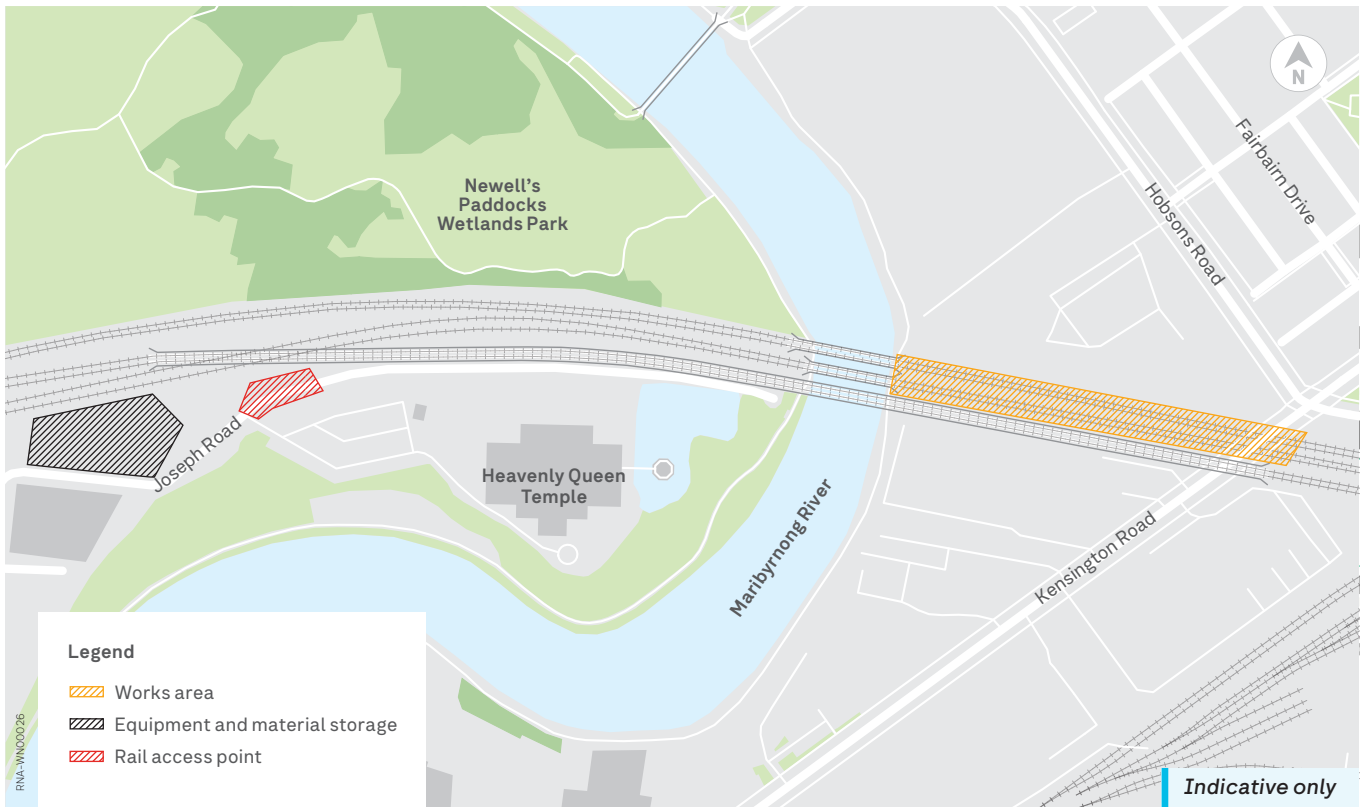
#### What to be aware of

- For the safety of rail users and our workers, these activities can only be performed when trains are not running
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise
- Lighting towers are required while we complete night works. Where possible, we will use battery powered lights and position to face away from residential properties
- There will be an increase in construction vehicles using the rail access point on Joseph Road. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist with vehicle, pedestrian movements around the area
- Access to residential properties will not be impacted.
