

Cheltenham works update

September 2026

Works are underway in Cheltenham to deliver Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) East for Melbourne and Victoria.

What we are doing

How we will manage our works

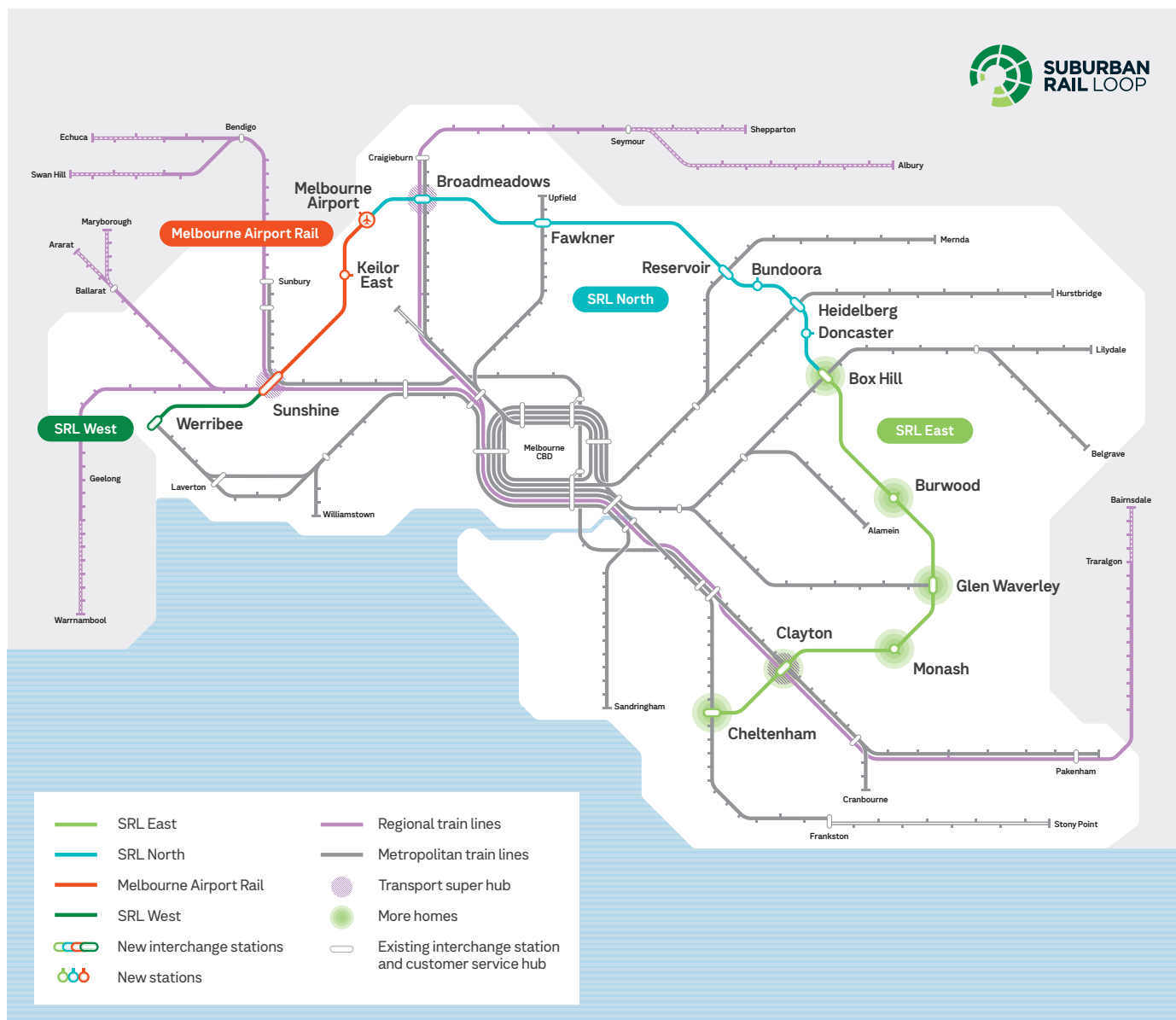
We will minimise the impacts to the community by:

- Covering trucks to minimise dust
- Monitoring noise, dust and vibration levels
- Hoarding to minimise noise, dust and light spill
- Safely removing hazardous materials in accordance with regulations
- Using water and dust suppressants
- Maintaining access to homes and businesses
- Maintaining access to existing amenities while works are underway at Sir William Fry Reserve, including the existing skate park, basketball court and playground.
