


Our 'mini tunnel boring machine' has arrived at our tunnelling hub site in Yarraville.

It will dig a diversion to the North Yarra Main Sewer, relocating it so we can build the West Gate Tunnel.

Although this TBM is 3 metres in diameter, it's still considered 'mini'.


The two big TBMs we'll use to dig the actual West Gate Tunnel are more than five times bigger, at 15.6 metres in diameter!





Sunday 15 – Thursday 19 July (five nights)


- Removing gantries and light poles
- 160 crew to remove 139 assets
 - Night 1 and 2: Full closure both directions, Williamstown Rd to Millers Rd
 - Night 3: Full closure both directions, Millers Rd to M80 interchange
 - Night 4: Inbound full closure Williamstown Rd to Millers Rd, outbound lane closures
 - Night 5: Inbound full closure Millers Rd to M80 interchange, outbound lane closures

Noise wall works starting from August 2018





Fogarty Avenue works

Late July for approximately 12 months

- Providing space for tunnel portal and new Williamstown exit-ramp
- New stormwater drain along Fogarty Avenue
- Relocating 66KV overhead power lines underground
- Staged works to minimise disruptions
- Traffic changes will be required
- Neighbourhood pop-up at Yarraville Glory Soccer Club this Saturday 21 July, 9am – 12.30pm




Federation Trail detour



Sheet piling

- Piles are being driven down into the ground
- Approximately 500 have been completed





Bored piles

- CFA and bored piling
- Secant wall piling 45% completed
- Tension piles 75% completed
- Look ahead:
 - Break back piles and install capping beams
 - Start bulk excavation



North Yarra Main Sewer

- Whitehall Street traffic management has been implemented
- Micro-TBM has arrived on site
- Excavation on site has begun to break up the existing road median to install the piling pad
- Look ahead:
 - Piling machine setup on Whitehall Street site
 - Install piles
 - Break back piles and install capping beams





HV Substation

- Base and walls have been installed and grouted
- Roof deck has been poured and is now curing

- Look ahead:
 - Building fit out including doors and windows

Site compounds

- Required for our construction teams and storage of equipment and materials
- Site sheds will be installed to provide facilities for construction team




 Fencing will be installed to ensure safety of users in that area, including vehicles, cyclists, pedestrians and workers

Noise

117 Environmental Performance Requirements (EPRs) resulting from a comprehensive Environmental Effects process

19 noise and vibration related EPRs including:

- Traffic noise limits (NVP1)
- Traffic noise reduction at open space (NVP2)
- Maintenance of noise mitigation measures (NVP3)
- Traffic noise reduction at Millers Road north of WGF (NVP4)
- Construction of noise barriers (NVP5)
- Traffic noise monitoring (NVP6)
- Construction noise, vibration management and monitoring (NVP7)
- Construction noise targets (NVP8)



AIR QUALITY MONITORING

Air quality monitoring

- Seven air quality related EPRs
- Five air quality monitors currently in place along
- A sixth monitoring station has been chosen
 - Situated on Millers Road
 - Working through approvals
 - EPA approved location

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR EMPLOYMENT AND LOCAL BUSINESSES

Employment and learning opportunities

- Over 500 jobs for apprentices, trainees and graduates
- 400 jobs dedicated to people from the west
- Up to 150 jobs set aside for former auto workers
- Targeted recruitment of disadvantaged groups and ongoing workplace support during their employment
- CPBJH partnership with Victoria University Polytechnic



Local business opportunities

Workforce trader directory being launched to encourage staff to 'buy local'.

Buying Australian goods and services:

- 93 percent of goods and services will be purchased from Australia/NZ suppliers, except for the specialist tunnel boring equipment
- 92 percent of steel used milled in Australia/NZ
- A strategy will be developed and implemented to ensure that goods and services are sourced from social enterprises and Aboriginal businesses
- Our Local Industry Development Plan will set out all targets in design and construction of tunnels, roadworks, elevated structures and lane use management systems.
