

Works notification

Park Street east-bound lane closure

Park Street

6pm - 10pm, Tuesday 5 April 2022

Maintenance work is required on the traffic light detector loop system that sits beneath the asphalt at the intersection of Park Street and St Kilda Road. The detector loop manages traffic light timings at the intersection.

What we are doing

- Setting up traffic control on the corner of St Kilda Road and Park Street
- Closing both turn lanes from Park Street into St Kilda Road
- Closing Park Street east-bound between Wells Street and St Kilda Road
- Saw-cutting the road surface to expose the detector loop system and completing maintenance works
- Reinstating the road surface over the detector loop system.

What to be aware of

- On Tuesday 5 April from 6pm until 10pm, there will be no left turn into St Kilda Road from Park Street
- A traffic detour will be in place via Wells Street and Dorcas Street
- Access on Park Street west-bound will be unaffected

- While the works aren't anticipated to take a long time, saw-cutting the road surface to expose the detector loop system will generate some periods of high level noise
- Tram services will not be affected
- Due to the nature of works, these must be completed after the daytime peak. Noisy works will be scheduled as early in the shift as possible.

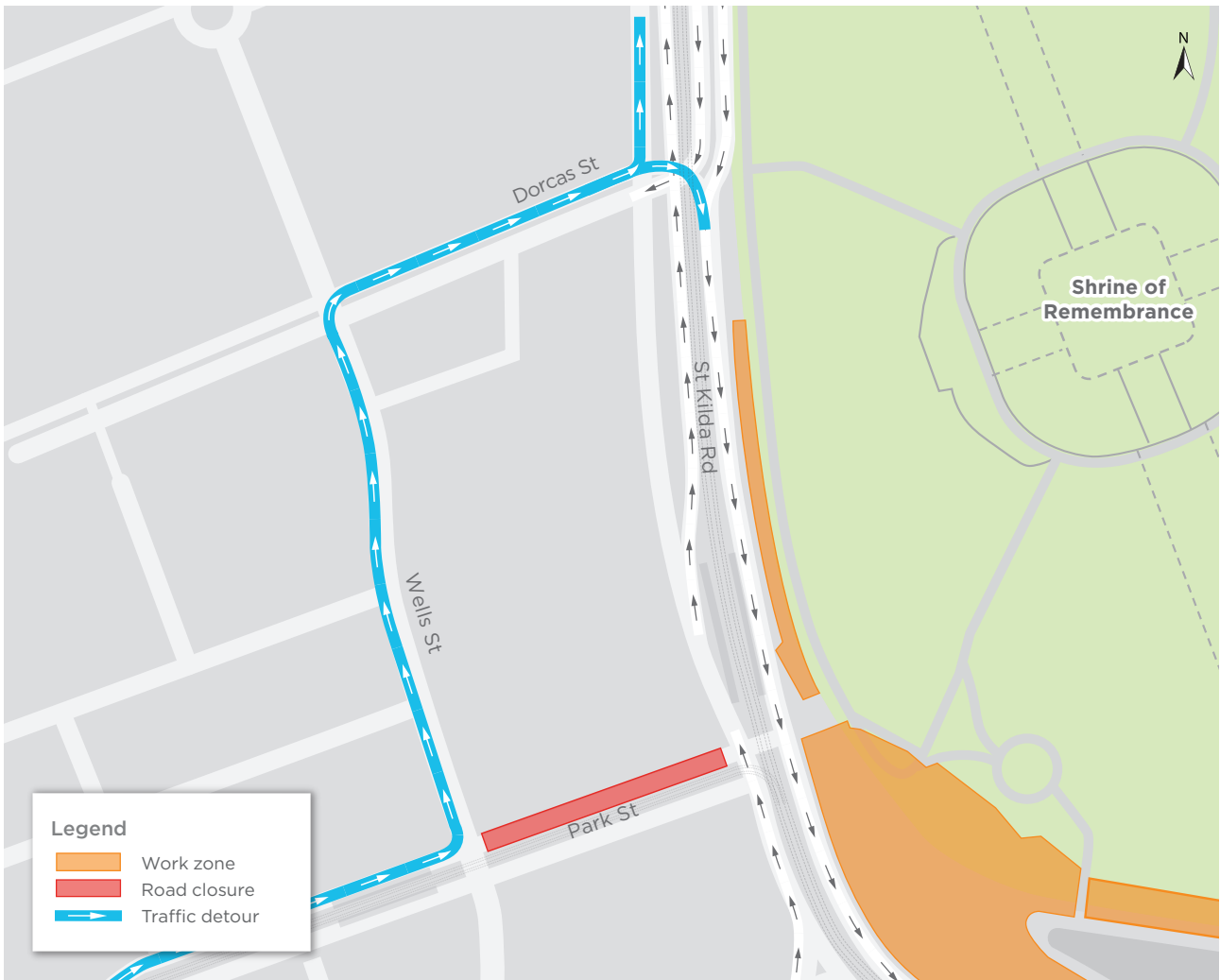
