

Construction update



Domain Precinct

November 2024

Works to construct the Metro Tunnel's Anzac Station are nearing completion, with good progress on the finishing works above ground. This update provides an outline of current and upcoming works in your area in November 2024.

Works snapshot: November

In October, the Domain Road site was demobilised and the road was reopened to public vehicles for the first time since 2017.

Landscaping works also continued within the Albert Road Reserve.

In November, works within the Domain precinct will focus on the completion of landscaping works at the Albert Road Reserve and reinstatement works at Edmund Herring Oval.

In December and into 2025 works will focus on final rectification works and the reopening of areas to the public, as the main works are complete.

Domain Road and Edmund Herring Oval reinstatement

Ongoing – 2024

- The reinstatement of Edmund Herring Oval will continue in November
- Domain Road is now open to traffic, with minor rectification works still ongoing
- The eastbound lane of Domain Road, between St Kilda Road and Dallas Brooks Drive, will be closed on 7 November
- The westbound lane will be closed on 8 November
- These closures will be from 9am to 3pm
- A detour will be in place via Park Street, Toorak Road and St Kilda Road.

Ongoing – 2024

- During November, works will continue on landscaping around the station entrance within Albert Reserve
- Minor rectification works are ongoing within the station box.

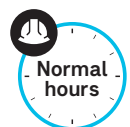


Ongoing – 2024

- Final hard landscaping works around the station entrance will continue in November, works will include installation of signage and final fitout of the station forecourt
- Minor rectification works are also ongoing in this area.

Station box construction and fit out

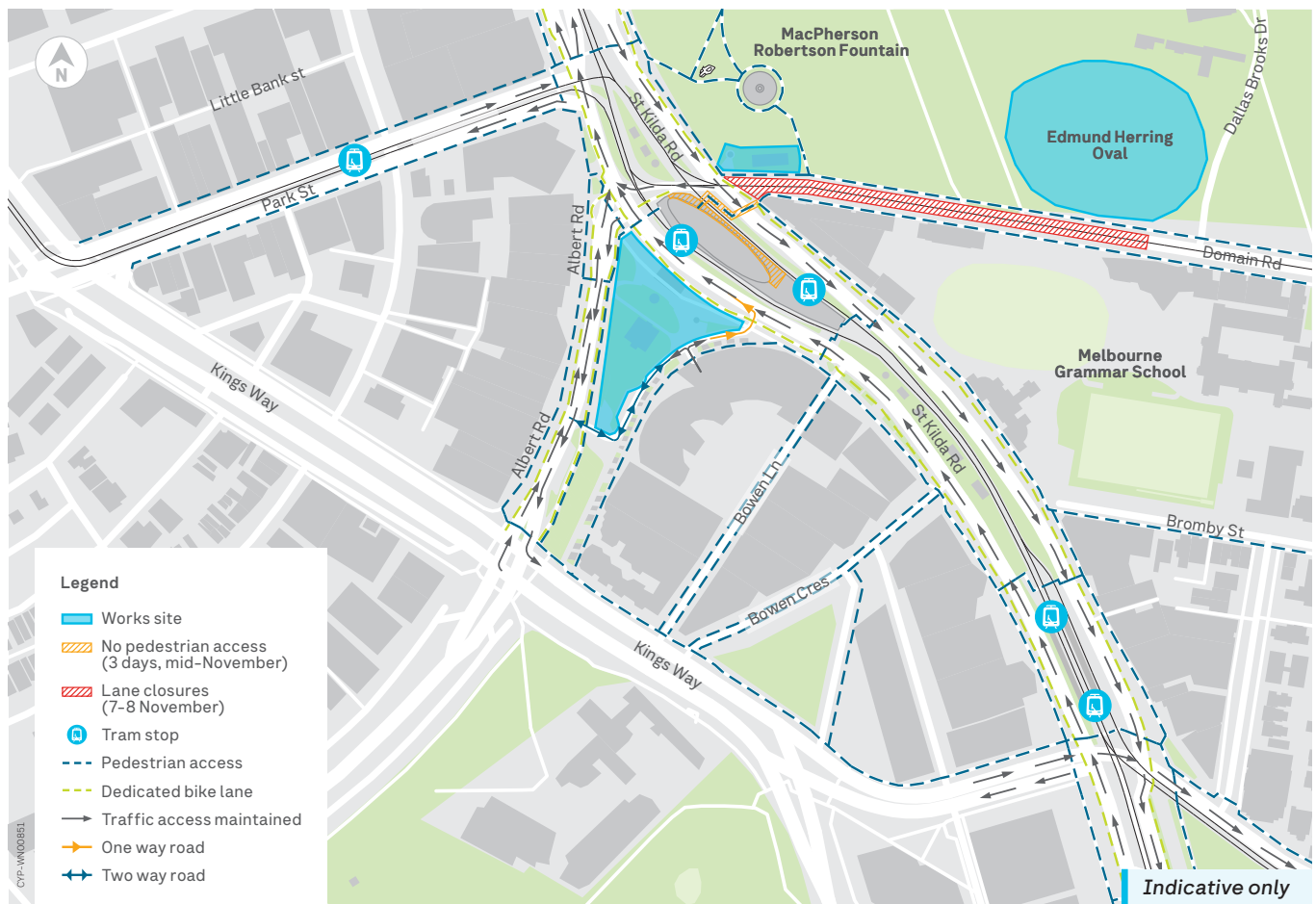
Concourse and platform level of station box



Ongoing

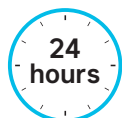
- Major construction and finishing works have been completed within Anzac Station
- Testing and commissioning works will continue within the station into 2025
- Minor rectification works are ongoing within the station box.

Tram interchange hoarding reduction

3 days in mid-November 2024



The existing hoarding at the Anzac Station stop is being reduced in mid-November to allow more space on the platform for passengers

- Works will continue outside of normal constriction to ensure materials can be safely removed when tram services have stopped
- Pedestrian access on the north-east section of the platform and the adjacent pedestrian crossing will be closed during these works
- Access to the tram stop via the southern and western crossings will be maintained
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise associated with hand tools
- Tram services will not be impacted by these works.

Changes to bus routes 603, 604 and 605

From 17 November 2024, passengers on bus routes 603, 604 and 605 will have new timetables and changes to bus routes.

To plan your journey, and view routes 603, 604 and 605 timetables, download the PTV app, visit **Journey planner** (<https://ptv.vic.gov.au/journey/>) or call **1800 800 007** to order a printed copy of your timetable.

When the Metro Tunnel opens in 2025, new routes 604 and 605 will connect bus, tram and train services at Anzac Station for the first time. This will allow passengers to connect with the train for quick access to Melbourne CBD, opening more travel opportunities.

Domain Road reopened

Domain Road was reopened to traffic, between St Kilda Road and Dallas Brooks Drive on 14 October.

This marks an exciting milestone for the Project and community, as the road had been closed since 2017 to enable the construction of Anzac Station and the twin tunnels.
