STATION NAMING COMPETITION UPDATE




- 27 August to 22 October 2017

Domain	9,700





STATION NAMING COMPETITION

















METRO TUNNEL SPOIL HAULAGE ROUTE














PROPOSED PROGRAM DATES FOR PORT PHILLIP ARCADE DEMOLITION


- Soft internal demolition between 8 December 2017 15 January 2018
- Install public protection on Cocker Alley, Royston Place, Scott Alley,
 Flinders Street between 19 December 2017 15 January 2018
- Demolish canopy on Flinders Street (night) from 9 to 15 January 2018
- Roof demolition from 16 January to 31 January 2018
- Hard demolition of Port Phillip Arcade (to ground level) from 1 February to 7 March 2018




Preparing the CBD for the future
