


RAIL CORRIDOR WORKS

Scope of Works

- Track construction works to install a new track alignment and turnout into the future Metro Tunnel
- Combined Service Route (CSR) works
- Overhead Line Equipment (OHLE) adjustments
- Modifications to existing signalling structures and installation of signalling equipment.

Timing

- 24/7, from Friday 26 February to Monday 8 March
- Preparatory works within rail corridor (North Melbourne to Sunshine):
 - 12am to 4am, Monday 8 February to Friday 12 February
 - 12am to 4am, Monday 16 February to Friday 19 February
 - 12am, Friday 19 February to 4am, Monday 22 February.



RAIL CORRIDOR WORKS

Key Information

- Increased truck movements in February for material deliveries
- Peak truck movements during first 4 days of rail shutdown to allow for track removal works (up to 10 trucks per hour for these works)
- Traffic controllers positioned underneath Kensington Road rail bridge to ensure safe machinery movements across the bridge
- Periods of high-level noise during track works (including tamping/regulating works)
- Some vibration may be noticeable from track compaction works.




Upcoming Works

Building delivery

- Overnight building deliveries on 17-19 February and 24 February
- Buildings lifted onto steel platform during normal construction hours
- Full closure of Hobsons Road car park required


Civil Works (February to March)

- Removal of one tree on Hobsons Road: w/c 15 February
- Construction of access driveway on Hobsons Road
- Remove existing driveway access on Kensington Road
- Minor footpath works on south west corner of Kensington Road and Hobsons Road
- Localised footpath detours. Traffic controllers to assist movements
- Relocate DDA (accessibility parking bays) within Hobsons Road car park.



HOBSONS ROAD OFFSET CAR PARK UPDATE

- 20 public parking spaces currently available for public use
- Planning a full closure in March to commence drainage and access driveway/road works
- Project team reviewing staging of works from April to mid-2021
- Traffic team undertaking regular parking counts (weekdays and weekends)
- Provisions for additional workforce parking in place
- Use of shuttle buses during upcoming rail occupation works
- Childers Street parking expected to be available in mid-2021.



SER/CER works in March 2021

TUNNEL ENTRANCE CONSTRUCTION

Updates

- 24/6 works are expected to be completed in March 2021
- RIA to commence handover of the tunnel entrance decline structure to CYP in March, which will continue into April
- Access into the tunnel entrance to continue from a small section in the flood wall which will remain open
- CYP to commence tunnel entrance breakthrough works to connect the tunnel entrance to the egress building (next slide).




Eastbound tunnel entrance pile wall to be demolished

DECLINE STRUCTURE BREAKTHROUGH & CAPPING BEAM DEMOLITION

- Breakthrough of the western wall (below ground) of the egress building to connect the decline structure to the tunnels from mid-March 2021
 - Saw cutting to expose pile wall
 - Excavator-mounted jackhammer to break out concrete and pile reinforcement (approx. two weeks)
 - Egress building structure will provide some noise attenuation.
- Demolition of temporary capping beam on northern side of the egress building from mid-March 2021
 - Excavate earth to expose capping beam; install steel plate to protect gas main
 - Saw cut capping beam into ~25 large blocks; crane onto trucks
 - Methodology designed to minimise amount of breakback required
 - Requires full closure of Childers Street for approx. 2-3 weeks, including to some construction vehicles. Intermittent use of Tennyson Street will be required for occasional deliveries, and for removal of concrete blocks.
- All works will occur within normal construction hours only
- Both activities may be completed simultaneously.

TUNNEL INTERNAL STRUCTURES

- Pouring the flat form section (invert/floor) of the tunnel
- To be poured in approx. 100-metre-long-sections
- Pours to occur using custom-built, dual drive concrete agis
- Works to occur in the westbound tunnel between the Western Portal (Kensington) and Arden Station between mid-February and mid-March
- Works to occur in the eastbound tunnel between the Western Portal (Kensington) and Arden between mid-March and mid-April.

Kensington

February 2021

Major construction is continuing in Kensington at the site of the future western Metro Tunnel entrance. This update provides an outline of current and upcoming works in your area throughout February.

Construction stopped

In February works within the Kensington precinct will include:

- Egress building construction
- Tunnel entrance construction
- Signaling Equipment Room and Communications Equipment Room construction
- Cross passage construction
- Rail corridor works
- Public space works
- Ongoing survey and monitoring activities.

When are we working?



Normal construction hours

7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
7am to 5pm, Saturdays



Out of hours

Works Notification

Work and traffic update Kensington

February 2021

This notification provides an update on upcoming Metro Tunnel works and traffic management arrangements in place for businesses at the Lloyd Street Business Estate.

What we are doing

Rail corridor works along McLennan Drive and Balaclava Road

Commencing in February, there will be works occurring within the rail corridor, along McLennan Drive and Balaclava Road, to install new steel posts and bracing which will contain new signalling cables.

Due to the close proximity to the rail line, access to the work area will occur from McLennan Drive and Balaclava Drive.

This will require short term closures of up to 15 parking spaces along McLennan Drive and Balaclava Drive for approximately one week for each stage of works.

Work will involve the use of a non-destructive digging (NDD) truck to safely excavate holes for the new steel foundations, installing and connecting posts into the ground, and fixing steel bracing to the posts.

Access to the rail corridor will require the temporary removal of some fencing panels.

Some vegetation removal will be required. All vegetation removal will occur within the rail corridor and will not impact vegetation within the Lloyd Street Business Estate (LSBE).

When

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 5pm, Saturdays
- Commencing Monday, 8 February until Friday 19 March 2021

What to be aware of

Traffic

Balaclava Road, between McClure Road and McLennan Drive will temporarily be reduced to one lane to allow works in this area. Traffic controllers will be in place to assist with vehicle movements. Half-way service signals will be installed, with traffic controllers assisting with vehicle movements.

Sections of McLennan Drive will temporarily be reduced to one lane to allow works in this area. Half-way service signals will be installed, with traffic controllers assisting with vehicle movements.

Up to 15 parking spaces at any one time along McLennan Drive and Balaclava Road will temporarily be required for equipment to undertake these works. It is expected these parking spaces will be required for up to 3 weeks.

Noise

These works are expected to generate periods of high level noise while using an NDD truck. All other works are expected to generate low levels of noise.

LEGACY PARKING DESIGN


Investigate the addition of two car parks at the eastern end of Childers Street

- Results in the loss of raingardens in the same location
- Raingardens improve water quality prior to discharge into the Maribyrnong River
- Reinstatement of two car parks, will require the offset of raingardens to a comparative area.

Current investigation

- Investigate viable areas to replace lost raingardens
- RIA reviewing technical, planning and construction requirements to determine if a design change can be achieved.

An outcome is expected in late-February 2021




FLOOD WALL DESIGN UPDATE

- Stephen Banham appointed as selected designer in November 2020
- Additional community engagement period (Stephen and RIA) to seek insights into the local communities' connection to JJ Holland Park in December 2020
- Key insights:
 - The importance of JJ Holland park in providing green space in an inner urban area
 - Sporting and recreation
 - Diversity in the way the park is used and use of the park by a diverse range of people
 - A place for family and friends
 - Information gathered provided to Stephen to assist in finalising the creative design in addition to Stephen undertaking observations at JJ Holland Park.

Next Steps


- Stephen and RIA refining technical elements of the design




OTHER ITEMS?
