WGF outbound switch at M80 Interchange: completed 30 August








Primula Avenue / Millers Road exit ramp changes

- Detector loops have been installed under the road surface on Primula Avenue
- A car idling over the loops will trigger the signals on the inbound exit ramp to Millers Road
- Drivers leaving Primula Avenue should continue to exit safely, considering traffic on Millers Road





Noise wall installation








Noise wall installation continuing along the West Gate Freeway with 2169 of 3331 concrete panels installed and 418 of 2946 acrylic panels installed.



West Gate Freeway upcoming works

- Intensive program of works will begin Friday 17 September to Monday 18 October.
- Crews will work 24 hours a day, seven days a week, coinciding with the school holidays when traffic volumes are reduced.
- Over the month of work, it will deliver critical upgrades at Grieve Parade,
 Williamstown Road and the M80.
- These works are crucial in widening the West Gate freeway from 8 to 12 through lanes and building new on and off ramps to Hyde Street. Future West Gate Freeway



Ramp closure: Princes Freeway to





Geelong Road

Works

- Hydro blasting to demolish section of an old bridge that sits above this ramp
- If works are ahead of schedule, rebuild that section of bridge
- Pavement works to tie this ramp into Little Boundary Rd/Geelong Rd intersection
- Install guard rails and light poles

Detour

- Drivers will need to stay on the West Gate Freeway and detour via Millers Road and Geelong Road.
- Note: This will also affect the 945 Night Bus (Wyndham Vale to City)







Ramp closure: Grieve Parade to WGF citybound

Works

- Rebuilding the road at the top and bottom of the Grieve Parade ramp
- Installing stormwater pits and drainage pipes
- Installing traffic monitoring equipment beneath the road
- Demolishing the old guard rails
- Installing new barriers and railings

Detour

- Drivers need to detour at Millers Road via either Geelong Road or Blackshaws Road.
- Note: This will affect the 232 bus route when travelling from Altona North towards the city







No left hand turn onto Melbourne Road

Works

- · Building a new lane on the southern side
- Installing 300 metres of new drainage pipes which includes digging down 2.5 metres
- Installing new traffic and streetlight signals

Detour

 Drivers will need to stay on the West Gate Freeway and use the Millers Road exit and detour via Blackshaws Road.
