

Works notice

Childers Street reopening Kensington

Thursday 16 March 2023

Childers Street will reopen to all traffic from 5pm Thursday 16 March 2023. Once the road is reopened, overheight vehicle detours via Tennyson Street will no longer be in place. Finishing works will continue until mid-2023.

What we are doing

Childers Street reopening

- Completing the remaining reinstatement works of Childers Street including line marking
- Reopening Childers Street from 5pm Thursday 16 March 2023
- Removing the existing boom gates on Tennyson Street and reinstating the temporary truncation to close vehicle access to Childers Street via Tennyson Street. A permanent truncation will be implemented at a later date
- Works will involve the use of a small excavator, a small crane and crews with handheld tools.

Pocket park and forecourt area finishing works

- Finishing works of the pocket park including soft landscaping and other maintenance works within the park
- Installing remaining sitting area, bicycle hoops and other hard landscaping around the works area
- Progressing the construction of the South Kensington Station canopy
- Works will involve the use of a small excavator, a small crane and crews with handheld tools.

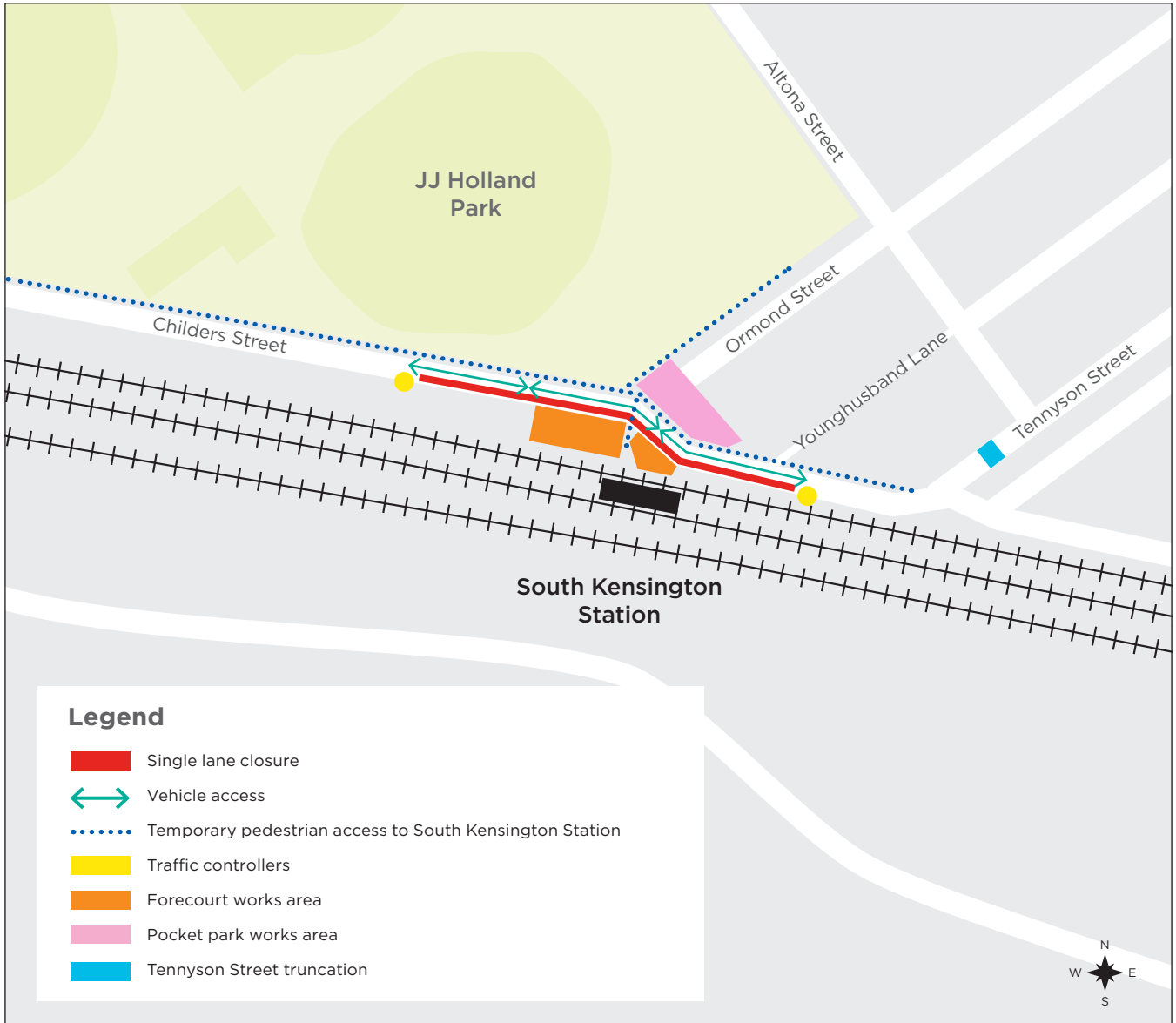
- From 5pm Thursday 16 March 2023.

Pocket park and forecourt area finishing works

- Ongoing until mid-2023.

What you should be aware of

- From Thursday 16 March, Childers Street will reopen and overheight vehicle access to the Lloyd Street Business Estate will be reinstated via Childers Street
- The current overheight vehicle detours via Tennyson Street will no longer be in place
- The existing boom gates on Tennyson Street will be removed, and the truncation reinstated
- Access to residential properties on Childers Street via Kensington Road will be reinstated
- A single lane closure will be in place on Childers Street to support ongoing station forecourt works
- Traffic management will be in place near the works area to allow vehicle and cyclist movements
- These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise and vibration
- The opening of the pocket park and forecourt area will be announced at a later date.
