Temporary detour for William Street speed hump repainting works

William Street, South Yarra

Thursday 5 October 2023

As part of works to reinstate the surrounding infrastructure and roads in South Yarra, a temporary detour will be in place while we repaint the William Street speed hump.

What we are doing

- Repainting the speed hump between 16 William Street and 21 William Street
- These works will involve crews with hand tools.

When

- 7am to 5pm, Thursday 5 October.

What you should be aware of

- A temporary detour for local traffic will be in place via Toorak Road, Chapel Street and Arthur Street while we repaint the speed hump
- Vehicle and footpath access to and from residential properties will be maintained at all times
- Traffic management including traffic controllers and road signage will be available to help facilitate pedestrian and vehicle access to properties
- These works are expected to generate low levels
 of poise.

Construction on surrounding infrastructure and roads

Major construction of key structures for the Metro Tunnel's tunnel entrance in South Yarra is nearing completion, with construction works underway to complete the surrounding infrastructure and roads.

Finishing works will continue on Arthur and Osborne streets.

Information about these works will be provided closer to the date.


