

Works notice



Overnight Asphaltting

St Kilda Road

February to March 2024

In February and March we will continue to asphalt St Kilda Road to make it two lanes in each direction through the Metro Tunnel Project area.



When we'll be working

To minimise disruption to traffic on St Kilda Road, works will take place overnight, **8pm to 6am**

- Northbound lanes: **8pm Monday 5 February to 6am Saturday 10 February 2024**
- Northbound lanes: **8pm Tuesday 13 February to 6am Saturday 17 February 2024**
- Northbound and southbound lanes: **8pm Monday 19 February to 6am Saturday 24 February 2024**
- Southbound lanes: **8pm Monday 4 March to 6am Thursday 7 March 2024**

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Closing the northbound lanes of St Kilda Road between Bowen Crescent and Albert Road overnight to complete:
 - Installation of two conduits prior to the final asphalt layer being applied
 - Excavating the two conduit pits using Non-Destructive Digging (NDD) trucks
 - Asphaltting the northbound lanes of St Kilda Road between Bowen Crescent and Albert Road
- Asphaltting the northbound lanes of St Kilda Road between Bowen Crescent and Albert Road:
 - Asphaltting the southbound lanes of St Kilda Road between Park Street and Bowen Lane
- Removing traffic barriers and line marking.
- These works are expected to generate periods of medium levels of noise associated with the laying of asphalt and excavation of pits with Non-Destructive Digging trucks
- During works on the northbound lanes, access and egress for the St Kilda Road driveway of 400 St Kilda Road (Botanica) will be primarily via Bowen Crescent, with Bowen Lane as an alternative route (See map)
- Residents will be advised separately when the Bowen Lane detour is in use
- Traffic controllers will be in place to assist with this traffic movement
- Please expect periods overnight to have long delays.

What to be aware of

- The two conduit excavation areas will require periods of high level noise associated with the use of excavators with hammers for areas known to contain rock
- Hammering works will be scheduled earlier in the evening to minimise disruption
- Detours will be in place during the closure of St Kilda Road, with access around the works via Kings Way. (See map)

Where

- Asphaltting works will be taking place at multiple locations over the course of the works
- Hammering for conduit excavation will take place early in the evening of the Monday 5 and Tuesday 6 of February
- Excavation of pits using NDD trucks will take place in the week commencing Tuesday 13 February
- Due to the nature of these works, progress may be impacted by weather conditions.

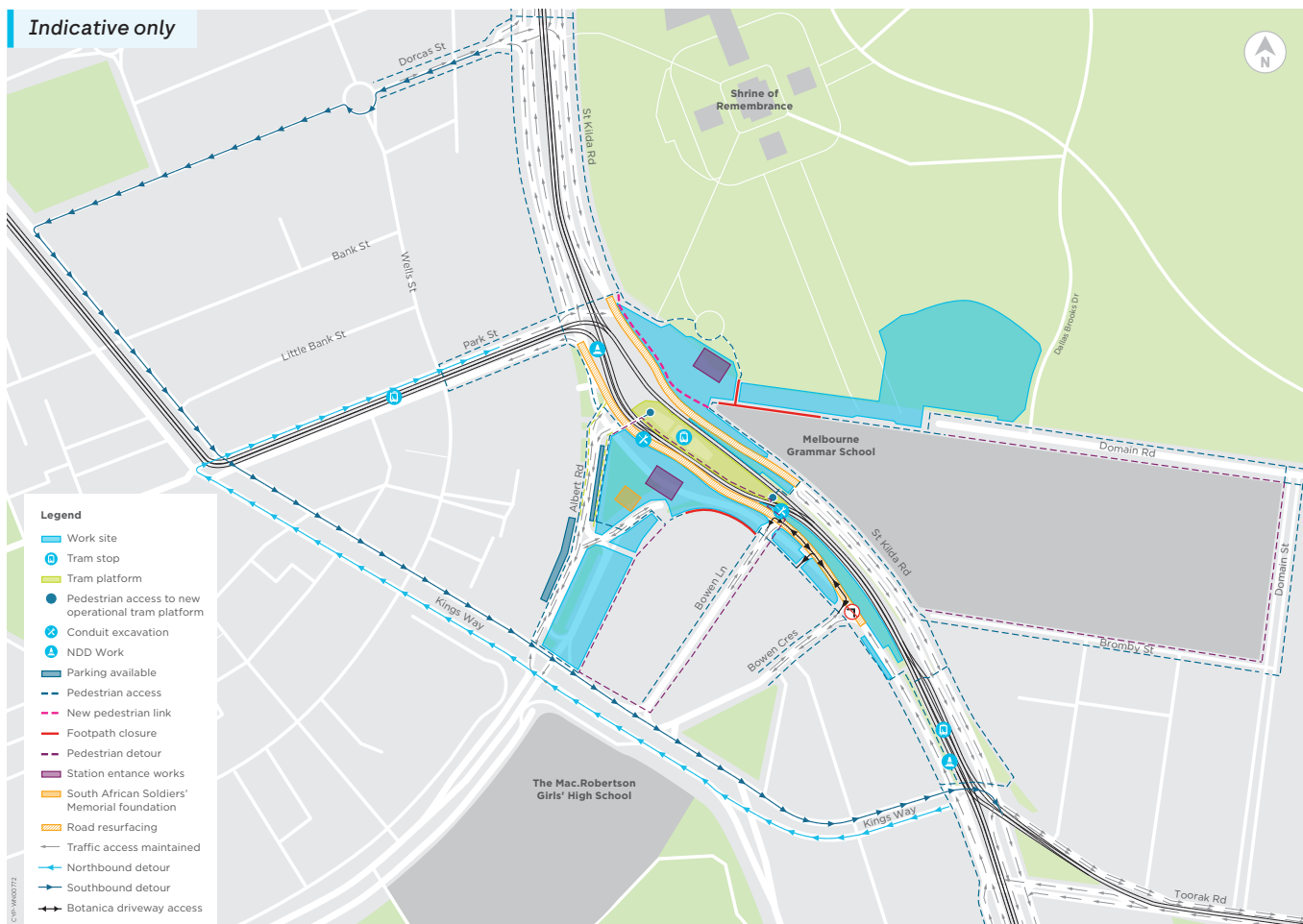
